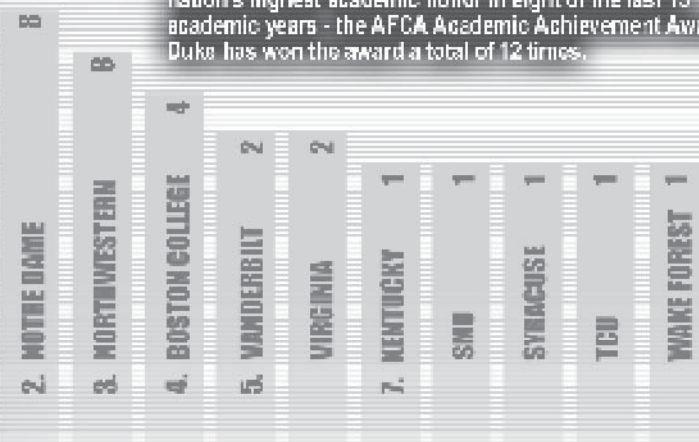


AFCA Academic Achievement Award
