SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Duke (21-9, 15-5 ACC) surpassed 20 wins for the 27th time in the program's 46-year history with a 21-9 overall record in 2016 ... The Blue Devils have topped 20 wins in 10 of the past 12 seasons ... In 18 campaigns under head coach **Jolene Nagel**, the Blue Devils have won 20 or more matches 14 times ... In addition, Duke finished tied for third in the ACC standings ... One of the most consistent ACC programs, since 2001 the Blue Devils have finished in the top three in the league standings in 13 of the past 16 years.

DEVILISH DEFENSE

Duke ended the 2016 season as one of the nation's top defensive teams ... The Blue Devils ranked fourth among NCAA DI programs in digs per set (18.31) and were one of just five teams to average over 18.00 digs per frame for the season ... In addition, Duke ranked fourth in the ACC in opponent hitting percentage (.179) and sixth in blocks per set (2.37) ... The Blue Devils held 17 of their 30 opponents to a hitting percentage under .200 ... Duke also allowed just two opponents (Loyola Marymount and NC State) to post a clip above .300 all season ... Five Blue Devils -- libero **Sasha Karelov** (5.42), setter **Cindy Marina** (2.68), outside hitter **Jamie Stivers** (2.60), defensive specialist **Nicole Elattrache** (2.59) and defensive specialist **Chloe DiPasquale** (2.57) -- averaged over 2.50 digs per set ... Duke also led the ACC in digs per frame for the fourth consecutive season.

Seven Blue Devils topped 100 kills for the season: middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** (387), middle blocker **Leah Meyer** (316), outside hitter **Jessi Bartholomew** (219), rightside hitter **Samantha Amos** (205), outside hitter **Jamie Stivers** (183), outside hitter **Anna Kropf** (129) and setter **Cindy Marina** (110) ... Duke has led the league in both kills per set and assists per frame in three of the past four seasons.

Tucker led the Blue Devils with a career-best 387 kills while Meyer also topped on 300 kills with 216 this season ... Both Blue Devils ranked in the top 10 in the ACC in hitting percentage ... Tucker's career-best .358 clip was good for third in the league, while Meyer's .333 mark ranked eighth.

tempts during that span, good for a .395 hitting percentage ... For the season, Tucker hit over .300 in 12 of those matches, including seven with a clip over .400 ... On the year, she knocked down 10 or more kills 24 times in 2016 and topped .300 hitting 18 times.

TUCKER REACHES 1,000 CAREER KILLS

Senior middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** established herself as one of the top middle blockers in program history as the Prairie Village, Kan., native became the 24th Blue Devil to reach 1,000 career kills with a 17-kill performance Oct. 17 versus Virginia ... For her career, Tucker totaled, 1,186 kills to go along with 401 blocks ... She also was the ninth Blue Devil with 400 career blocks ... Tucker ranked tied for fifth in program history with a .319 career hitting percentage ... She was the sixth player in program history with 1,000 kills, 400 blocks and a career hitting percentage over .300, joining Jourdan Norman, Krista Dill, Jen Rohrig, Christiana Gray and Adrian Nichol ... Tucker finished her collegiate career ranked 14th in kills, eighth in blocks and fifth in hitting percentage ... In 2016, Tucker garnered First Team All-ACC as well as AVCA All-East Coast Region accolades.

MEYER IN THE MIDDLE

For the season, First Team All-ACC and AVCA All-East Coast Region pick **Leah Meyer** led the Blue Devils with 139 blocks ... She ranked sixth in the ACC and 35th nationally with a 1.31 blocks-per-set average ... For her career, Meyer has averaged 1.18 blocks per set, good for fourth all-time at Duke ... In 2016, Meyer posted at least four blocks in 18 matches, including her first career double-double Sept. 24 at Virginia ... Meyer totaled 12 kills and 11 blocks versus UVA to record the first double-double for a Duke middle blocker since Christiana Gray in 2012 ... She was also a threat on offense, totaling 316 kills while ranking eighth in the ACC in hitting percentage (.333).

KARELOV NAMED ACC DEFENSIVE POTY

Duke's starting libero each of the past three seasons, 2016 ACC Defensive Player of the Year **Sasha Karelov** once again anchored the Duke back row in 2016, leading the conference with 634 digs and a 5.42 digs-per-set average that also rated eighth nationally ... The Raleigh, N.C., native picked up 20 or more digs on 15 occasions, including a program record 44 digs Sept. 30 at Notre Dame ... For her career, Karelov became the third player in school history to reach 2,000 career digs, joining Ali McCurdy and Jenny Shull ... She averaged 4.52 digs per set for her career, good for fourth in the Duke record books and 10th in ACC history ... In addition, her 2,023 career digs ranked third in school history and ninth in ACC history ... Karelov also received First Team All-ACC and AVCA All-East Coast Region citations in 2016.

Freshman setter **Cindy Marina** orchestrated Duke's 5-1 system all season, leading the league and ranking 20th nationally with an 11.11 assists-per-set average ... Marina was also stellar defensively, ranking second on the team behind libero **Sasha Karelov** in digs (313) and digs per set (2.68) ... She had a team-best 17 double-doubles and 27 service aces this season as well ... Marina, senior middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** and senior libero **Sasha Karelov** were the only Blue Devils to play in every set this season ... Prior to her arrival at Duke, Marina joined the Albanian National Team June 3-5 in Twardogora, Poland and again June 17-19 for the 2016 CEV Volleyball European League in Durres, Albania this past summer.

Senior libero **Sasha Karelov**, sophomore middle blocker **Leah Meyer** and senior middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** earned AVCA All-East Coast Region honors while freshman setter **Cindy Marina** was tabbed honorable mention as announced by the organization Dec. 6 ... Tucker made her second straight appearance on

the all-region squad ... Karelov, an honorable mention pick in 2014 and 2015, and Meyer both earned their first all-region nods.

ACC HONORS FIVE BLUE DEVILS

Senior libero **Sasha Karelov** earned ACC Defensive Player of the Year distinction and joined senior middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** and sophomore middle blocker **Leah Meyer** on the All-ACC first team as announced by the league office Nov. 28 ... In addition, setter **Cindy Marina** and rightside hitter **Samantha Amos** garnered ACC All-Freshman Team accolades ... The ACC Defensive Player of the Year and first team All-ACC citations are the first for Karelov, who collected second team all-league honors in each of the past two seasons ... Tucker made her second appearance on the All-ACC first team while Meyer picked up the first all-conference honor of her career after collecting ACC All-Freshman Team honors in 2015 ... Duke and North Carolina were the only two squads with three first team All-ACC selections in 2016.

TUCKER, MARINA EARN ACC WEEKLY HONORS

Senior middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** and freshman setter **Cindy Marina** earned ACC Player and Freshman of the Week honors, respectively, Monday, Nov. 14 ... The duo led Duke to road ACC sweeps at Virginia Tech and Pitt, guiding the Blue Devils to their sixth straight win and 20th of the season ... Tucker was nothing short of dominant in the two matches, averaging 4.00 kills per set while hitting .468 and totaling 1.50 blocks per frame ... Marina totaled 68 assists over the weekend, averaging 11.33 assists per set to raise her ACC-leading average to 11.05 assists per frame.

AMOS NAMED ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Freshman rightside hitter **Samantha Amos** earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors Nov. 7 after helping Duke to wins over Louisville and Notre Dame ... Amos hammered a career-best 15 kills in three sets versus the Cardinals before bettering that performance with 16 kills against the Fighting Irish ... For the season, Amos has totaled 10-plus kills eight times and four more blocks on nine occasions ... She ranks third on the team in kills per set (2.41) and second in blocks per frame (1.03).

DUO TABBED PRESEASON ALL-ACC

Libero **Sasha Karelov** and middle blocker **Jordan Tucker** garnered 2016 Preseason All-ACC recognition as announced by the league Aug. 5 ... Duke's starting libero the past two seasons, Karelov was an AVCA All-East Coast Region honorable mention and All-ACC second team honoree in 2015 ... One of the top middle blockers in the ACC, Tucker collected AVCA All-East Coast Region and first team All-ACC accolades as a junior in 2015.

BIO SUMMARY

The fifth head volleyball coach in school history, Jolene Nagel is in her 18th season at the helm of the Duke volleyball program after joining the Blue Devil staff in 1999. Under her guidance, Duke has earned a reputation as one of the elite programs on the East Coast. Nagel has led the Blue Devils to 12 NCAA Tournament appearances over the past 15 seasons, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11.

A perennial contender in the ACC, Duke has recorded 20 or more wins in 13 of Nagel's 16 campaigns and consistently finishes among the top three in the conference. Nagel has guided the Blue Devils to four ACC regular season championships, an overall record of 374-157 and an ACC record of 217-89.

The winningest Duke volleyball coach on record, she also ranks among the league coaching leaders in overall winning percentage, ACC winning percentage, ACC wins and NCAA Tournament appearances.
