### LEADING OFF

Duke and Virginia take the diamond to open ACC play as the Blue Devils host the Cavaliers Friday-Sunday, March 9-11 at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park. Duke and Virginia face off in the series opener at 4 p.m., Friday, March 9, resume the series at 1 p.m., Saturday, March 10, and conclude the weekend at 1 p.m., Sunday March 11. ACC Network Extra is set to broadcast all three games available via ESPN3 and the Watch ESPN app. Duke (10-2, 0-0 ACC) enters the weekend on a nine-game win streak after sweeping Cornell and defeating Longwood in midweek action. Virginia (9-4, 0-0 ACC) took 2-of-3 from Yale this past weekend before downing Davidson, 12-3, Tuesday.

### BY THE NUMBERS

**7** Number of current Blue Devils selected in the Major League Baseball Draft: OF Griffin Conine, OF Jimmy Herron, INF Wil Hoyle, LHP Adam Laskey, OF Steve Mann, LHP Chris McGrath and INF/RHP Matt Mervis.

**9** Consecutive Duke wins heading into the ACC opener, the Blue Devils' longest undefeated stretch since 2015. Joey Loperfido (.481), Zack Kone (.382), Michael Rothenberg (.321) and Jimmy Herron (.314) are all batting above .300 during that streak while the Duke pitching staff has posted a 2.56 ERA and limited opponents to a .201 batting average.

**11** Junior catcher Chris Proctor has reached base safely in a team-best 11 consecutive games heading into the weekend.

**13** Newcomers who joined the 2018 Duke roster: Graduate student transfer pitchers Ethan DeCaster and Sam Granoff join freshmen Chris Crabtree, Thomas Girard, Matt Dockman, Wil Hoyle, Toma Shigaki-Tham, Bryce Jarvis, Steve Mann, Joey Loperfido, Josh Nifong, Michael Rothenberg and Tyler Wardwell. Through the first four games of the season, nine of the new Blue Devils have seen playing time.

**21** Stolen bases for the Blue Devils this season to rank tied for second in the ACC. Seven different Blue Devils have stolen a base this season, led by Max Miller's five.

**22** Blue Devil returning letterwinners, including all nine starting position players. Preseason first team All-Americans Griffin Conine and Jimmy Herron headline that group while Duke also returned starting center fielder Kenny Taylor, second baseman Max Miller, shortstop Zack Kone, third baseman Jack Labosky, catcher Chris Proctor and designated hitter Michael Smiciklas.

**25** Combined hits for freshmen Joey Loperfido and Michael Rothenberg. Loperfido ranks ninth in the ACC with a .389 batting average while Rothenberg's .355 average ranks 19th. Duke's rookie pair are hitting a combined .373 (25-67) on the year.

**45** Career stolen bases for junior outfielder Jimmy Herron to rank tied for 11th all-time in program history. Herron also ranks 15th all-time in career batting average, 16th in career on base percentage and 17th in career doubles.

**155** Number of consecutive games played for senior captain Max Miller.

## LOPERFIDO, ROTHENBERG OFF TO STRONG STARTS

Freshmen **Joey Loperfido** and **Michael Rothenberg** have enjoyed strong starts to their collegiate careers. Loperfido has started all 12 games at first base and leads the Blue Devils with a .389 batting average. Loperfido also lead the team with five multiple hit games on the year. Rothenberg has started five games behind the plate and four at designated hitter, batting .355 on the year. The switch hitter has a home run from each side of the plate and ranks tied for ninth in the league with a .645 slugging percentage.

## NEWCOMER IMPACT

Eleven of Duke's 13 newcomers have seen action through Duke's first 12 games. In addition to **Joey Loperfido** and **Michael Rothenberg**, position players **Chris Crabtree**, **Steve Mann** and **Tyler Wardwell** have all made their collegiate debuts. On the mound, newcomers **Ethan DeCaster**, **Thomas Girard**, **Sam Granoff**, **Matt Dockman**, **Bryce Jarvis** and **Josh Nifong** have combined for a 2.22 ERA over 28.1 innings, totaling 31 strikeouts.

## ROTATION RETURNS

Duke returned its entire weekend rotation from a season ago in sophomore **Adam Laskey**, senior **Ryan Day** and senior **Mitch Stallings**. Laskey was the first freshman featured in Duke's weekend rotation since Trent Swart in 2011 and has moved to the Friday night slot as a sophomore. In three starts this season, he leads the team with a 2.65 ERA, registering two quality starts while limiting opposing hitters to a .222 average. Both Day and Stallings spent their first two seasons in the bullpen before moving into the starting rotation this past season. As a junior, Stallings recorded seven quality starts as Duke's Friday starter, leading the team in innings (76.0) and strikeouts (74). The Atlanta native ranks 16th in program history in career ERA (3.70), fourth in career saves (12) and seventh in strikeouts per nine innings (9.04). In 2017, Day was the only ACC pitcher to throw 1.0 innings per game and not allow a home run to rank 12th in the league in ERA (3.30), fifth in walks allowed (17), third in doubles allowed (7) and fifth in WHIP (1.10).

## CONINE'S BREAKOUT SEASON

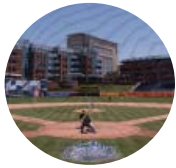
Junior outfielder **Griffin Conine** entered the season as one of the nation's most touted players. In addition to first team Preseason All-America honors from Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball and Perfect Game/Rawlings, Conine was also named to the 55-player Golden Spikes Award watch list. This past season, Conine collected his first career All-ACC honors after leading the Blue Devils in slugging percentage (.571), on base percentage (.437), RBI (56), triples (2), home runs (13), total bases (117) and walks (40). Conine was the first Blue Devil to total 50-plus RBI in a season since first baseman Nate Freiman (62) in 2009. He was also the first Duke player with 10 or more home runs in a season since Jake Lemmerman (10) in 2010. Over the summer, Conine earned the Cape Cod Baseball League's Robert A. McNeece Award, given to the league's top pro prospect as voted on by Major League Baseball scouts. In 45 games with the Cotuit Kettleers, Conine hit .326 with 58 hits, 11 home runs, five doubles and 31 RBI. He was selected to the CCBL All-Star Game and garnered West Division MVP honors as well.

## HERRON LEADING OFF

**Griffin Conine** is not the only Blue Devil outfielder to earn 2018 preseason All-America honors. Selected by the Yankees in the 31st round of the 2017 MLB Draft, junior **Jimmy Herron** was tabbed to the Baseball America Preseason All-America third team. Herron followed his freshman All-America season with another standout campaign this past year. Herron led the team in batting average (.326), doubles (17), runs (53), hits (74) and stolen bases (17). In addition, Herron drove in 39 RBI and knocked five home runs. In three seasons at Duke, Herron owns a .322 batting average, good for 15th in the school's all-time records. Herron also ranks 11th in school history with 45 career stolen bases, 13th in career on base percentage (.416) and 17th in career doubles (45). Over the summer, he earned CCBL East Division MVP accolades, hitting .343 with 11 doubles, four homers, 22 RBI and 15 stolen bases with the Orleans Firebirds.

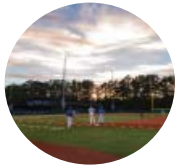

On October 2, 2015, Duke renewed its agreement with the Durham Bulls to play home games at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (DBAP), home of the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. Beginning in 2016, the contract renewal is a seven-year agreement that allows Duke to play up to 36 exhibition and home games at the DBAP each year. The agreement also called for a limited number of Duke practices at the DBAP as well as a new permanent Duke locker room and clubhouse at the facility. Duke and the Durham Bulls began their partnership prior to the Blue Devils' 2010 season. The 2016 campaign marks the seventh consecutive season in which Duke will play home games at the DBAP. Under the new agreement, the Blue Devils will play the vast majority of their home schedule at the minor league venue.

## UP FOR THE CHALLENGE

Duke began the season against a ranked team for the fourth time during head coach **Chris Pollard's** six-year tenure. The Blue Devils went 1-2 against No. 15 Vanderbilt this past weekend. A season-ago, Duke faced then-No. 7 Oregon State twice at the Sanderson Ford Spring Training Classic in Surprise Arizona. In 2016, Duke won 2-of-3 against then-No. 10 California at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park, securing a pair of walkoff victories. Pollard's first season as Duke's head coach pitted the Blue Devils against then-No. 13 Florida to start the 2013 campaign. Overall, the Blue Devils once again face a challenging slate as 29 of Duke's 56 contests in 2018 are against teams that registered 30 or more wins a season ago. In addition, Duke's 2018 schedule features 22 games versus 2017 NCAA Tournament participants, including match ups against Vanderbilt, Yale, Virginia, Wake Forest, Florida State, Davidson, NC State and North Carolina.

## DUKE RANKED IN PRESEASON POLLS

For the first time in program history, Duke appeared in three preseason polls to start the 2018 season, landing at No. 31 on the National Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) list, No. 25 on D1Baseball's chart and No. 20 in Perfect Game's rankings.

## BLUE DEVILS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN ACC COASTAL DIVISION

Duke was picked to finish third in the 2018 ACC Coastal Division in a poll of the conference's 14 head coaches. Twelve coaches picked North Carolina to win the Coastal Division, while Virginia received the other two first place votes. The Tar Heels tallied 96 points, ahead of Virginia (83), Duke (62), Miami (60), Georgia Tech (46), Virginia Tech (27), and Pittsburgh (18).

## CAPE COD LEAGUE SUCCESS

Five Blue Devils spent the summer in Massachusetts, playing in the prestigious Cape Code Baseball League. Outfielder's **Griffin Conine** and **Jimmy Herron** were both named to the all-league team as well as the all-star game, ultimately earning joining MVP honors. Shortstop **Zack Kone** was also named to the all-start game, while catcher **Chris Proctor** won a gold glove for his position. Lastly, pitcher **Graeme Stinson** posted a 2.45 ERA with 32 strikeouts in 18.1 innings with the Orleans Firebirds.

## BLUE DEVILS IN THE 2017 MLB DRAFT

Three Blue Devils and two Duke NLI signees were selected during the 2017 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft. Junior first baseman Justin Bellinger was taken by the Cincinnati Reds in the 22nd round, redshirt junior pitcher James Ziemba was selected in the 22nd round by the Los Angeles Angels and outfielder **Jimmy Herron** was picked in the 31st round by the New York Yankees. Bellinger began his professional career with AZL Reds, Ziemba was assigned to the Orem Owlz and Herron elected to return to Duke for his junior season. Head coach **Chris Pollard** has had 14 players drafted during his Duke tenure, including 11 pitchers and three position players. In addition, the Detroit Tigers picked freshman outfielder **Steve Mann** in the 38th round and the Oakland Athletics drafted freshman infielder **Wil Hoyle** in the 38th round. Both elected to enroll at Duke and join the 2018 Blue Devils.

## STAFF ADDITIONS

Head coach **Chris Pollard** made two changes to his staff entering the 2018 season. After five seasons as the head coach at Pfeiffer University, **Dusty Blake** joined the Blue Devils as Duke's pitching coach, taking over for Pete Maki who left to become the Minnesota Twins' minor league pitching coordinator. In addition, Pollard hired **Chris Gordon** as the Blue Devils' Assistant to the Head Coach, a role that coordinates team travel and meals, assists with the recruiting process and on-campus visits, facilitates the team's statistics and analytics technology, and coordinates all Duke baseball camps. Gordon came to Duke from East Tennessee State, where he spent the past four seasons as the program's pitching coach and recruiting coordinator.

## UPWARD TREND

With wins over No. 14 Clemson and No. 10 Virginia, Duke not only clinched the Pool D slot in the 2017 ACC Championship semifinals but also secured 30 wins for the fourth straight season. With 30 wins in 2017, Duke recorded the program's first stretch of four-consecutive 30-win seasons since the Blue Devils compiled a run of seven straight 30-win campaigns from 1992-98. In 2016, Duke earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, ending a drought of 55 years without making the postseason event. The first head coach to guide the Blue Devils to the NCAA Tournament since 1961, **Chris Pollard** is also the first Duke skipper to lead the team to four 30-win seasons in his first five campaigns and is the fastest Duke coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils.

Chris Pollard became Duke University's 25th head baseball coach in June 2012, taking the reigns of the Blue Devil program after successful stints at Pfeiffer University and Appalachian State University. In addition to guiding the Blue Devils to four straight 30-win seasons, Pollard led Duke to an at-large bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament, ending the program's 55-year drought without making the postseason event. Pollard became the fastest Duke head coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils, recording his 100th victory at Duke March 15, 2016 against Maryland Eastern Shore. During Pollard's tenure, 13 Blue Devils have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.
