Dear Mr. Jones:

After a careful check of our records, I find no reference to a no-hit baseball game pitched in the year 1921. We do have on record a 3-0 shutout pitched against Wake Forest.

However, in the old Alumni Register for July, 1921, we have recorded the 3-0 game played against Wake Forest on May 5, 1921. The record clearly states that Carroll, pitcher for the Trinity team, allowed one scratch hit to the opponents. This was written two months after the game was played, and as far as I have been able to find out, that one hit has never been changed to an error- at least not in the records which I have examined.

A Trinity College Baseball Hall of Fame, compiled by "Cap" Card lists the no-hit games on record at Duke and Trinity, but the list does not include any game played in either 1921 or 1922.
