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The amount of financial aid available for summer school is limited. Decisions about summer awards are based on a number of factors, which may include seniority and academic need.

Under NCAA rules, a summer award must be based on the amount of athletic aid a student received in the previous academic year. For example, if you received 40% of a full athletic scholarship in 2015-16, you are eligible for no more than 40% of the cost of a summer scholarship.

You will be notified by email **no later than March 31<sup>th</sup>** of the decision regarding your summer school application. You will be responsible for registering for the EXACT classes that you have been approved to take. If you choose to register for additional and/or different classes than the ones you are approved for, you will be held responsible for any additional fees associated with that change.
