**QUICK HITS**

- Head coach Pam Bustin's squad has won seven straight contests and 13 of its last 14 games.
- Duke has gotten on the board first in all 16 of its victories on the season.

**DUKE IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT**

- Duke owns an all-time record of 17-34 in the conference tournament while making three trips to the title match (1999, 2003, 2011). The program is 3-18 historically in semifinal contests and 2-1 when playing as the tournament's No. 2 seed.
- The Blue Devils advanced to the tournament semifinals for the second consecutive season.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- After playing to an overtime shootout during the regular season, Duke and Boston College needed overtime again Thursday in the ACC Championship quarterfinals.
- Sophomore midfielder Margaux Paolino knocked in the game winner four minutes into overtime to lift the second-seeded Blue Devils to the 3-2 victory.
- Junior Rose Tynan gave the Blue Devils the early advantage with two tallies inside the first nine minutes.
- Duke held the Eagles to six shots and two penalty corners on the afternoon.

**LOUISVILLE SERIES HISTORY**

- Duke leads the all-time series with the Cardinals, 10-3, and has claimed five of the last six contests in the series.
- The Blue Devils earned a 5-0 victory over Louisville during the regular season meeting Sept. 15 in Durham. Four different players found the back of the cage in Duke's home opener.
- A dominant defensive performance limited the Cardinals to just two first-half shots and two total penalty corners during that meeting.
- Duke head coach Pam Bustin spent 13 seasons (1998-2010) as Louisville's head coach prior to coming to Durham. Bustin is 3-1 against her former program.

**SCOUTING THE CARDINALS**

- Louisville secured a spot in the ACC Championship semifinals for the first time since joining the conference in 2014. The Cardinals edged Syracuse, 3-2, in Thursday's quarterfinals to move to 13-6 on the year.
- Senior Marigrace Ragsdale notched the game winner with 2:03 remaining Thursday against the Orange, lifting the Cardinals to the win. Ragsdale and Minout Mink pace Louisville with 21 points each this fall.
- Goalkeeper Ayeisha McFerran made four saves - all in the first half - of Thursday's contest and owns a 1.95 goals against average and a .667 save percentage.
- Louisville freshman Alli Bitting is the younger sister of Blue Devil midfielder Morgan Bitting.

**LEAGUE-HIGH FIVE BLUE DEVILS TABBED ALL-ACC**

- Duke led all schools with five student-athletes on the 2017 Field Hockey All-Atlantic Coast Conference teams.
- Senior back Alyssa Chillano and sophomore midfielder Margaux Paolino were named to the All-ACC First Team while senior midfielder Alexa Mackintire, redshirt sophomore goalkeeper Sammi Steele and junior forward Rose Tynan received second team nods.
- Chillano earned a spot on the all-conference first team for the second consecutive season.

**SHUTOUTS STACKING UP**

- With their seventh shutout of the season Saturday against Appalachian State, the Blue Devils have now posted 13 shutouts in the last two years and 27 in the last five.
- Duke entered the tournament ranked second in the ACC and fourth nationally in shutouts per game (0.41).
- The program record for shutouts in a season is 11, achieved by the Blue Devils in 1982.

**KRISTEN CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS**

- Senior forward Ashley Kristen tallied two goals Saturday against the Mountaineers to move her career total to 27, the most of any current Blue Devil.
- The 27 goals tie Kristen for 19th on Duke's all-time career charts, while her 80 career points rank her 15th all-time at Duke.
- Kristen is one of five Blue Devils with multiple-goal games this year.

**DUKE CLICKING ON ATTACK PENALTY CORNERS**

- The Blue Devils have averaged over seven corners per contest over the last seven outings, scoring on those corner opportunities 10 times.
- Duke's primary inserter, sophomore midfielder Margaux Paolino, has totaled seven assists over the last six contests, notching two each against Wake Forest, North Carolina and Liberty. Paolino also had the game-winning goal Thursday in the ACC Championship quarterfinals for her second tally of the season.

**DUKE DEFENSE AMONG NATION'S BEST**

- The Blue Devils continue to boast one of the strongest defenses in the country, having surrendered just 21 goals in 18 contests. The 21 goals allowed ranks the squad second in the ACC.
- Duke entered the week ranked fourth nationally in goals against average (1.09).
- Redshirt sophomore Sammi Steele led all ACC goalkeepers and ranks eighth in the country with a .782 save percentage.
- Senior back Alyssa Chillano paces the Blue Devils with three defensive saves on the year while sophomore Jillian Wolgemuth has registered two.

**SENIOR SEND-OFF**

- Duke honored its six-member senior class following last Saturday's regular season finale at Williams Field at Jack Katz Stadium.
- Alyssa Chillano, Sarah Furey, Ainsley Gill, Ashley Kristen, Alexa Mackintire and Stephanie Pezzuti have guided the Blue Devils to a 59-20 record and three straight NCAA quarterfinals appearances, including a trip to the national semifinals in 2015.

**STEELE, TYNAN COLLECT ACC WEEKLY HONORS**

- Junior forward Rose Tynan earned the nod as the ACC Offensive Player of the Week for the second time this season Oct. 23 after recording a pair of game-winning goals. She was also an honorable mention selection for the NFHCA's Division I Player of the Week award.
- Tynan racked up seven points in two Blue Devil wins to earn ACC Offensive Player of the Week honors Oct. 2.
- Steele made it a Duke sweep of the ACC weekly awards Oct. 2, earning Defensive Player of the Week recognition after matching her career best with nine saves against Boston College. She added three more stops at Boston University.
- Steele also collected ACC Defensive Player of the Week honors Sept. 5 after leading the Blue Devils to a pair of shutouts at the BIG/ACC Cup.

**CHILLANO, FUREY TABBED TO NFHCA SENIOR GAME**

- Alyssa Chillano and Sarah Furey were selected to represent Duke in the 2017 Victory Sports Tours/National Field Hockey Coaches Association Division I Senior Game.
- The Blue Devil standouts were two of 38 student-athletes named participants for the contest, which is slated for Friday, Nov. 17 at Louisville, the site of the 2017 semifinals and finals.

**ALL-REGION RETURNERS**

- Duke returns a quartet of NFHCA All-South Region selections this fall in senior back Alyssa Chillano, senior forward Ashley Kristen, redshirt sophomore goalkeeper Sammi Steele and sophomore midfielder Margaux Paolino.
- A preseason All-ACC pick, Chillano led the Blue Devils in points (32) and goals (13) a year ago while anchoring the defense from the center back position.
- Paolino ranked second in the ACC and fifth nationally last season with 14 assists, while Kristen tallied seven.
- Steele took over as the Blue Devils' starter in goal in 2016, ranking third in the ACC in goals against average (1.39) and save percentage (.730).

**BLUE DEVILS WELCOME CLASS OF 2021**

- Head coach Pam Bustin bolstered the Duke roster with the addition of five freshmen student-athletes. The class includes Libby Thompson of Illinois, Lily Posternak of Maine, Lexi Davidson of Massachusetts, Lydia Smeltz of Pennsylvania and Kira-Lee Gmeiner of Australia.
- The group was included in MAX Field Hockey's Top 10 Division I Incoming Classes.

**NEW FACES TO KNOW**

- Head coach Pam Bustin brought Ralph Boersma on board the Duke coaching staff in March. Boersma previously spent a number of years overseeing teams for the HV Victoria hockey club and the HC Hoeksche Waard club program in his native country of The Netherlands.
- More recently, Bustin rounded out the coaching staff with the addition of Tracey Griesbaum as a volunteer assistant coach. A veteran of the collegiate coaching ranks, Griesbaum spent 14 seasons as the head coach at the University of Iowa (2000-13).
