- The Blue Devils jumped seven spots to No. 13 in this week's IWLCA Division I Coaches Poll after defeating Campbell and No. 11 Northwestern last weekend.
- Through three contests, Duke has outscored its opponents, 44-25, and is outdrawing opponents by a 48-26 margin.

CADOUX, NORTH SWEEP ACC WEEKLY AWARDS

- Sophomore goalkeeper Gabbe Cadoux and freshman attacker Charlotte North earned ACC weekly honors Tuesday following wins over Campbell and No. 11 Northwestern.
- Cadoux was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week after coming up big for the Blue Devils in the waning minutes of Sunday's thrilling 9-8 victory over the Wildcats. She made three consecutive stops on Northwestern's final offensive possession to seal the win.
- On the weekend, Cadoux totaled 13 saves.
- North paced the Duke attack in both wins, racking up nine goals and one assist. Her six-goal showing Friday against the Camels marked the highest single-game output by a Blue Devil since 2016.
- The rookie from Dallas, Texas recorded what would prove to be the game winner against the Wildcats.

DEFENSE SLOWS WILDCATS IN TOP-20 SHOWDOWN

- Anchored by Gabbe Cadoux in the net, Duke's defensive unit held a Northwestern attack averaging 18.0 goals per game to just eight tallies on 26 shots in Sunday's win.
- The unit also limited the Wildcats to 2-of-6 on free position opportunities.
- Seven different Blue Devils accounted for at least one caused turnover on the day.
- Duke has held all three opponents so far to single-digit scoring.

NORTH OFF TO HOT START

- Freshman attacker Charlotte North has impressed in her first few games in a Duke uniform, posting three hat tricks in as many outings.
- Her six-goal output against Campbell marked the highest by a Blue Devil this season. The Dallas, Texas native also scored the game winner in a 9-8 defeat of No. 11 Northwestern last Sunday.
- North's 12 goals and 13 points lead the Duke attack. She entered the week ranked second in the ACC and 16th nationally with 4.00 goals per game.
- North became the first Blue Devil to garner ACC Offensive Player of the Week recognition as a freshman since Kelci Smesko in 2013.

VIRGINIA TECH SERIES HISTORY

- Duke heads to Blacksburg with a 19-1 advantage in the all-time series with the Hokies.
- The Blue Devils suffered their only setback to Virginia Tech last season, falling by an 11-6 margin March 4 in Durham.
- In three career contests against the Hokies, senior Kyra Harney has totaled nine goals, four assists and two caused turnovers. Senior midfielder Maddie Crutchfield owns six goals and 12 draw controls against Virginia Tech, while junior attacker Olivia Jenner has totaled nine draw controls and senior defender Anne Slusser three ground balls.

SCOUTING THE HOKIES

- Virginia Tech evened its record at 2-2 with a 17-8 victory over Campbell Wednesday in Blacksburg. The Hokies' losses have both come at the hands of top-10 teams in No. 8 Southern California and No. 8 James Madison.
- Virginia Tech midfielder Mary Claire Byrne has totaled 10 caused turnovers to help the squad rank third in the ACC in that category (10.25 cto/game).
- Goalkeeper Meagh Graham paces the conference in saves (31) following a 13-save outing Wednesday against the Camels.
- Offensively, the Hokies have been led by Emma Crooks (10g, 1a) and Tristan McGinley (9g).

JENNER CLOSING IN ON CAREER DRAWS RECORD

- Junior Olivia Jenner has helped Duke outdraw all three of its opponents so far in 2018, totaling 29 draw controls in those contests.
- During the 2017 campaign, Jenner surpassed 2014 graduate Taylor Virden (184) for second on the program's all-time list with 213 career draws. She enters Saturday's game just 23 shy of Duke's all-time career leader, Emma Hamm (265).
- Jenner's 242 career draw controls entering the weekend ranked her fourth among all active Division I players behind only seniors Shelby Fredericks of Northwestern (355), Katherine Judge of Winthrop (286) and Caroline Queally of Richmond (271).

CADOUX APPROACHING CENTURY MARK IN SAVES

- Sophomore Gabbe Cadoux sits nine saves shy of the century mark for her career following a pair of double-digit save performances against Elon and Northwestern.
- She stands to become the eighth goalkeeper in Duke history to reach the 100-saves mark.
- Cadoux enters Saturday's matchup averaging 7.67 saves per game and is leading the ACC in ground balls per game (4.00).

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Blue Devils are 18-18 against ranked foes since 2015 with wins over two ranked opponents already this season. The squad dispatched No. 21 Elon, 17-9, in the season opener and edged No. 11 Northwestern, 9-8, last Sunday.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Head coach Kerstin Kimmel's squad will play 11 of its 16 regular season contests at home in Koskinen Stadium this spring. The 11 home contests include ACC matchups against Louisville, Virginia and Boston College.
- Duke went 4-4 at home last spring and is 68-21 at Koskinen since the 2009 season.
- Following this weekend's trip to Blacksburg, the Blue Devils will host a six-game home stand at Koskinen Stadium.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Senior midfielder Maddie Crutchfield was selected to the 2018 Preseason All-ACC Team. The co-captain from Concord, N.H., was a second team all-conference pick last spring.
- Crutchfield was also tabbed a Preseason All-America honorable mention selection by Inside Lacrosse. She was joined in earning honorable mention recognition from the publication by sophomore goalkeeper Gabbe Cadoux and junior attacker Olivia Jenner.

- The Blue Devils came in at No. 20 in the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWLCA) Division I Coaches Poll released Jan. 29.
- Nine of Duke's 2018 opponents were listed in the initial poll, including three inside the top 10.
- Head coach Kerstin Kimel's squad was also tabbed No. 19 in preseason rankings released by Inside Lacrosse and US Lacrosse Magazine.

VETERAN ATTACK RETURNS IN 2018

- The Blue Devils return six of their seven leading point scorers from a year ago.
- Seniors Maddie Crutchfield (32g, 17a) and Kyra Harney (30g, 20a) lead the way after achieving statistical milestones last spring. Harney became the 17th player in program history to reach 100 career goals while Crutchfield became the 26th player in Duke history to reach the 100-point mark for her career.
- Catherine Cordrey found a home among the Blue Devil attack last year, tying for seventh on the program's freshman chart with 28 goals.
- Duke also welcomes back Olivia Jenner (20g, 8a), Ellie Majure (17g, 9a) and Grace Fallon (16g, 16a) - all starters from a season ago.

IRIZARRY JOINS DUKE COACHING STAFF

- Bria Irizarry joined the Blue Devil coaching staff in August after spending the past three seasons as the top assistant at Army West Point alongside head coach Kristen Waagbo - a former Blue Devil standout and assistant coach.
- Irizarry oversees Duke's defensive personnel, which includes returners Anne Slusser, Michelle Staggers, Callie Humphrey and Charlotte Tucci.
- A 2011 graduate of Richmond, Irizarry has also previously coached at George Washington and at her alma mater.

BLUE DEVILS WELCOME CLASS OF 2021

- Head coach Kerstin Kimel bolstered the roster with the addition of 10 student-athletes for the 2018 campaign.
- Three members of the freshman class competed in the 12th annual Under Armour All-America Lacrosse Game over the summer - Catriona Barry, Katie Cosgrove and game MVP Charlotte North.

SENIOR DUO SELECTED IN UWLX COLLEGE DRAFT

- Blue Devil seniors Maddie Crutchfield and Kyra Harney were among more than 60 female athletes chosen in November's United Women's Lacrosse League 2018 College Draft.
- Crutchfield was selected 12th overall by the Long Island Sound while Harney was the 40th player drafted and was chosen by the Baltimore Ride.

KERSTIN KIMEL

HEAD COACH • 23RD SEASON AT DUKE
MARYLAND, 1993



The only head coach in Duke women's lacrosse history, Kerstin Kimel has led the program from its inception in 1996, molding the Blue Devils into one of the nation's elite teams.

In Kimel's 22 seasons at the helm of Duke women's lacrosse, she has guided the Blue Devils to seven national semifinals, four ACC regular season titles, an ACC Tournament Championship and 19 NCAA Tournament appearances.

A five-time ACC Coach of the Year, Kimel has overseen 59 All-America selections, 82 all-region honorees and 70 All-ACC picks. Six of her former players have competed on the U.S. National Team, representing the United States at the 2009, 2013 and 2017 World Cups. The Blue Devils have achieved equal success in the classroom during Kimel's tenure, collecting 59 IWFLCA Academic Honor Roll accolades since 1997.

Kimel registered her 250th career victory Feb. 22, 2015 in a win over William & Mary. She is one of just six active Division I coaches with 280 or more wins.

Kimel was honored with an IWFLCA Service Award in November, 2016 for her work as co-chair of the NCAA Division I Legislation Committee to slow down early recruiting within the sport. She was presented with the IWFLCA's highest award, the Diane Geppi-Aikens Memorial Award, in November, 2015.

Duke returned to the NCAA semifinals to punctuate an outstanding 16-5 campaign in 2015. Led by a veteran group of eight seniors, the Blue Devils concluded the season ranked fourth in the final national poll. Attacker Kerrin Maurer became Duke's career assist leader and garnered first team All-America recognition from the IWFLCA. Goalkeeper Kelsey Duryea headlined the Blue Devils' three All-America selections in 2016, and concluded an outstanding career as one of just three goalkeepers in ACC history to top 600 saves for her career. She ranked among the nation's leaders in save percentage while anchoring Duke to an 11-9 ledger and a trip to the NCAA second round.

The Blue Devils recorded 14 or more wins four times from 2009 to 2014, advancing to the national quarterfinals on five occasions and the semifinals in 2011. Under Kimel's watch, Duke produced 13 All-America selections during that time, while Emma Hamm (2011) and Carolyn Davis (2009) were named finalists for the Tewaaraton Trophy. Led by Davis and Caroline Cryer, the 2009 squad rewrote the program's offensive record book, totaling team highs in goals scored (313), assists (150) and points (463). In 2013, Duryea became the first goalkeeper in program history to receive All-America recognition as a rookie, rounding out the season ranked top-10 nationally in save percentage and saves per game. A two-time first team All-American on defense, Taylor Virden wrapped up her senior campaign (2014) ranked second in program history in career draw controls.

From 2004 to 2008, Duke put together one of the most successful stretches in program history, advancing to four consecutive national semifinals from 2005 to 2008 and earning at least a share of four-straight ACC regular season titles from 2004 to 2007. During that span, the Blue Devils placed 21 players on both All-America and all-region lists, in addition to posting three Tewaaraton finalists. Kimel led Duke to a 13-8 overall record and the Blue Devils' fourth-straight NCAA semifinal appearance in 2008, earning womenslax.com Coach of the Year honors for her efforts.

Led by Tewaaraton Trophy recipient and two-time ACC Player of the Year Katie Chrest, the 2005 and 2006 Duke squads combined for a 35-7 overall record, including a program-best 18 victories in 2006, a 7-2 mark in the ACC and two conference regular season titles. After seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments bids, the 2005 installment earned a trip to the national semifinals for the second time in program history to ignite Duke's string of four straight appearances.

From 2000 to 2002, the Blue Devils advanced to three consecutive NCAA Tournament quarterfinals, and in 2001, made the program's first ACC Championship game. However, success did not always come easy, as Duke's 12th women's varsity program began its inaugural season in 1996 with four-straight losses before earning the Devils' first win -- a 10-6 victory over UMBC on March 18, 1996. The Blue Devils would finish the season at 3-12, marking the first and only year Duke women's lacrosse has posted a losing record. Duke began its rapid ascension the following season, recording an 8-8 mark before breaking through in 1998 with the program's first NCAA Tournament bid. The 1999 season took Duke to new heights as the Blue Devils achieved the program's first trip to the NCAA semifinals.

Prior to her arrival at Duke, Kimel was the head coach at Davidson College, leading the newly-created Wildcats program to a 4-8 record in 1994 as one of the nation's youngest head coaches in her first and only season at Davidson.

Kimel was no stranger to NCAA Division I women's lacrosse before her time at Davidson, having played at the University of Maryland from 1990-93. During her career, she led the Terrapins to four consecutive national semifinal appearances and the 1992 NCAA National Championship. The Havertown, Pa., native was a two-time All-America selection and the 1993 NCAA National Defensive Player of the Year, appearing in Sports Illustrated's "Faces in the Crowd." Kimel graduated from Maryland in 1993 with a bachelor's degree in speech communications.

Most recently, Kimel served as Co-Chair of the IWFLCA Recruiting Issues Committee from 2014-16 and is currently the Chair of the IWFLCA Division I Legislative Committee.
