SMALL NUMBERS IN SENIOR CLASS

Duke's 2009 roster features just nine scholarship seniors with only three players — RB **Re'quan Boyette**, OG **Jarrod Holt** & QB **Thaddeus Lewis** — on the offensive side of the football ... The squad features just four fifth-year seniors in Boyette, DT **Vince Oghobaase**, DE **Ayanga Okpokowuruk** and NG **Kinney Rucker** ... Duke's total of nine seniors ranks as the fewest in the ACC.

FINAL CALL FOR LEWIS

As a senior in 2009, QB **Thaddeus Lewis** will look to put a cap on a career that has seen steady improvement through three seasons ... A second team All-ACC pick in 2008, Lewis' completion percentage has been on the rise during his tenure, going from .529 as a rookie in 2006 to .553 as a sophomore in 2007 to .620 as a junior last fall ... In addition, his interception numbers have declined dramatically, moving from 16 in 2006 to 10 in 2007 to six in 2008 ... Among active players in the ACC, Lewis enters the 2009 campaign ranking first in passing yards (6,735), first in touchdown passes (47), first in 300-yard passing games (4) and second in total offense (6,609).

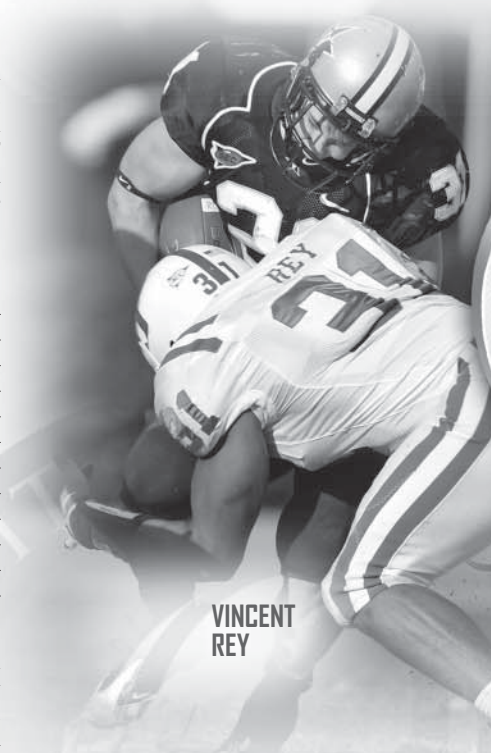

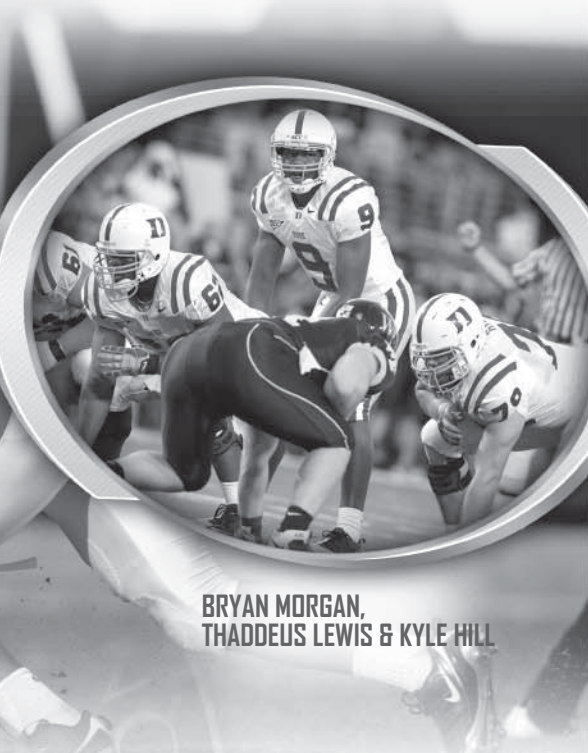
OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT

DEFENSIVE STRIDES

Duke's defensive unit posted better production in 2008 in all four major statistical categories ... The Blue Devils trimmed just under 10 points (9.7) off of its per game average, a mark that ranked as the sixth-best improvement nationally.

OGHOBAASE LEADS DEFENSIVE LINE

In 2008, DT **Vince Oghobaase** finished fifth in the All-ACC balloting for defensive tackles to receive honorable mention all-league honors ... Of note, the Houston, Texas, product was the leading vote-getter among non-seniors ... Among active ACC players, Oghobaase ranks second in career tackles for loss (29.0) and third in quarterback sacks (11.5) ... Oghobaase has started all 36 games over the past three years while compiling 128 tackles.

EARLY ENROLLEES

Four members of the 2009 signing day class graduated from high school early and enrolled at Duke in January: CB **Zach Greene**, TE **Ryan Hall**, LB **Kevin Rojas** and DT **Sydney Sarmiento**.

YOUNG RECEIVING CORPS

With the graduation of **Eron Riley** (144 career receptions for 2,413 yards) and **Raphael Chestnut** (72-760), the Duke wide receiving unit takes on a youthful look in 2009 ... Sophomores **Johnny Williams** (30-327 in 2008) and **Donovan Varner** (21-164) return after solid rookie seasons while juniors **Sheldon Bell** (14-93) and **Austin Kelly** (13-142) provide stability ... The group has zero seniors.

HILL & MORGAN

The Duke offensive line returns two starters — **Kyle Hill** and **Bryan Morgan** — from last year's unit that helped reduce the team's sacks allowed total from 45 in 2007 to just 22 in 2008 ... Hill was a second team Freshman All-America selection last year after starting all 12 games at left guard, and will switch to left tackle for the spring to replace graduated **Cameron Goldberg**, a three-year starter ... Morgan returns after starting all 12 games at center in 2008 ... Duke must replace three starters including Goldberg, OT **Fred Roland** and OG **Rob Schirmann**.

REY LOOKS FOR 100 ... AGAIN

Senior LB **Vincent Rey** enters his final season with the Blue Devils as the only active player in the ACC with multiple 100-tackle seasons to his credit ... Rey posted 111 stops as a sophomore before amassing 109 tackles last year ... Only six Blue Devils have reached the century mark in tackles in three seasons: **Carl McGee** (1975-76-77-78), **Emmett Tilley** (1980-81-82), **Mike Junkin** (1984-85-86), **Erwin Sampson** (1988-89-90), **Darrell Spells** (1990-91-92) and **Ryan Fowler** (2001-02-03).

BOYETTE EYES RETURN

Redshirt senior RB **Re'quan Boyette** — Duke's leading rusher in both 2006 and 2007 — is scheduled to return to the gridiron this spring after undergoing surgery on his left knee on August 10 and missing the entire 2008 season ... He was voted a team captain by his peers during the 2008 preseason ... The Wilson, N.C., native received a medical redshirt and begins his final season at Duke ranking 10th among active players in the ACC with 1,072 career rushing yards ... In addition, Boyette is a proven asset in the passing game with 30 career receptions.

KING BACK IN THE MIX

Duke's offense will welcome the return of TE **Brandon King** to the field ... The Doylestown, Pa., native lettered his first two seasons (2006-07) in Durham before missing the entire 2008 campaign due to injury ... King caught just 10 passes as a sophomore, but proved to be a valuable scoring threat with four touchdowns ... Also at tight end, **Brett Huffman** returns after catching 14 passes for 171 yards and one TD, as does **Danny Parker** (3-25-0).

RUNNING GAME DEPTH

With the unexpected loss of RB **Re'quan Boyette** prior to the 2008 season, opportunity presented itself to a pair of Duke running backs with zero college experience at the position ... Rookie **Jay Hollingsworth** burst onto the scene and led the Blue Devils in rushing with 399 yards while catching 25 passes for an additional 188 yards and two touchdowns ... The Sanford, N.C., native became the first true freshman to lead the team in rushing since **B.J. Hill** did so in 1998 ... Meanwhile, **Tony Jackson**, a converted safety, rushed for 259 yards while hauling in 12 passes for 106 yards and one touchdown.

RENFREE SLATED FOR BACKUP DUTY

Sean Renfree, who redshirted in 2008, joined three-year starter **Thaddeus Lewis** as the only two scholarship quarterbacks on the spring roster ... **Zack Asack**, the backup to Lewis the past two years, is no longer a member of the team while the career of **Mike Cappetto**, a reserve signal-caller for the last two seasons, has ended due to medical hardship ... Renfree was a PARADE All-America pick as a senior at Notre Dame Prep in Scottsdale, Ariz., in 2008 after throwing for 3,353 yards and 41 touchdowns.

JONES AMONG TOP ACC PUNTERS

Punter **Kevin Jones** ranked second in the ACC with a 40.8 yards per punt average last season ... Jones placed a league-high 27 punts inside the 20-yard line with just six touchbacks.

MAGGIO PERFECT ON PAT ATTEMPTS

Kicker **Nick Maggio** made all 28 of his extra point attempts and 11-of-14 field goals in 2008 ... His 28-of-28 season on PATs ranks tied for second best in school history.

A GLANCE AT THE 2009 SCHEDULE

Duke's 12 opponents combined for an 89-67 (.571) overall record while eight teams — Georgia Tech, Kansas, Maryland, Miami, North Carolina, N.C. State, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest — participated in bowl games ... Two schools — Virginia Tech (15th) and Georgia Tech (22nd) finished the year ranked in the Associated Press final poll ... In addition, Richmond posted a 13-3 overall record and captured the FCS title.

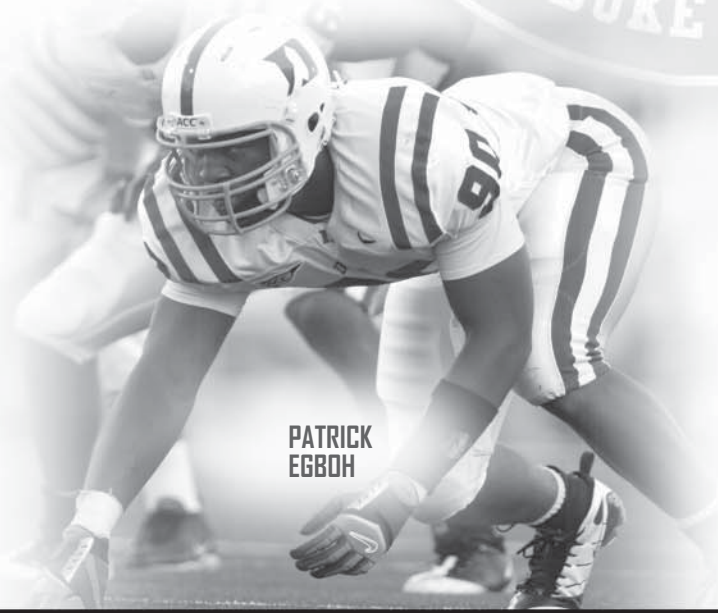
