

East Campus (Field Hockey) Facilities

On behalf of the Sports Medicine Staff I would like to welcome you to Duke University for the upcoming field hockey game. The athletic training room is located on Duke University's East Campus in the Brodie Center. The Brodie Center is adjacent to Williams Field (Field Hockey Turf). You can access the training room through the front doors of the Brodie Center. Make a right pass the front desk and continue down the hallway. The training room is labeled Sports Therapy office # 114. You will have full access to our facility 1/5 hours prior to the game and 1 hour following competition. The following modalities will be available:

- Hot packs, whirlpools, muscle stimulation, ultrasound, and ice.

Duke University will also provide the following for all visiting teams:

- Water and cups
- Cooler with ice and bags
- Emergency first aid assistance

If you require any other assistance or have any special needs, please contact the individual assigned to your sport before you arrive on campus. We will do our best to accommodate your request.

****IMPORTANT-** If a student athletic trainer will be traveling with your team, he/she must have written instructions in order to use any modalities. If an athletic trainer is not traveling with your team **please call ahead** giving specific instructions for treatments or taping. Please send all taping supplies and any emergency information which might be needed. A Certified Athletic Trainer will be at every home game. Our team physician will either be in attendance during the game or on call.
