Duke Takes On Miami This Weekend

The Duke baseball team will travel to Miami for their final ACC series of the season Thursday through Saturday at Mark Light Field. Thursday and Friday's games are set for 7 p.m. and Saturday's season finale will start at 1 p.m. The Blue Devils enter the series with a 29-22 overall record and an 8-19 mark in the ACC while the Hurricanes are 32-20 and 14-13, respectively.

Duke has won 14 more games (29) in 2007 than the team won all of last season (15). Duke's 29 victories mark the second-highest win total over the last 10 years and the ninth-best win total in school history.

Bajoczky Named To Roger Clemens Award Watch List

Duke senior **Tony Bajoczky** was added to the Roger Clemens Award watch list on May 8. The Roger Clemens Award honors the top pitcher in college baseball. Bajoczky is 9-2 on the season with a 2.92 ERA. He leads the Duke pitching staff and ranks among the ACC leaders in wins (nine), ERA (2.92), opponent batting average (.212), innings pitched (86.1), strikeouts (54) and starts (13). Bajoczky's nine victories are now tied for fifth on Duke's single-season wins list and he will finish the year ranked near the top of the season leaders in ERA.

Seander Named To NCBWA Stopper Of The Year Midseason Watch List

Duke freshman right-hander **Michael Seander** was one of 40 relievers named to the midseason watch list for the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year Award, the association announced April 19. The award will be given to the top relief pitcher in Division I college baseball.

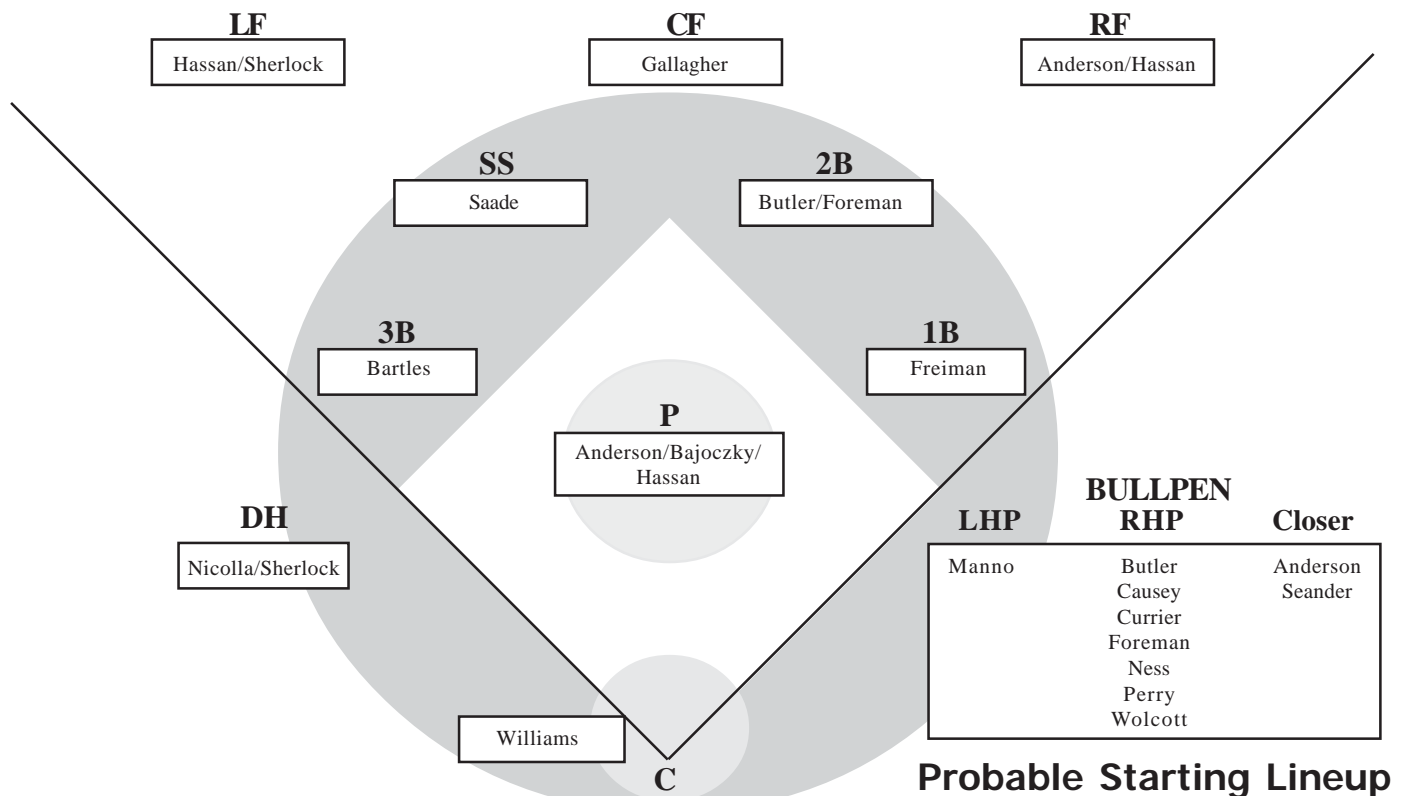
Seander has recorded nine saves on the year and holds a 1.68 ERA. His nine saves rank second on Duke's single-sea-

son chart and tied for third on the career saves list. In 48.1 innings this year, Seander has struck out 43 batters while walking just 11 and has allowed only nine earned runs in 27 appearances while holding opponents to a .236 batting average.

Bajoczky Tosses Second Career Complete Game

Senior **Tony Bajoczky** tossed his second career complete game to lead Duke to an 11-1 victory over Maryland on April 21. Bajoczky improved to 8-2 on the season, holding Maryland to eight hits in the game while striking out a season-high seven batters and walking just one.

Easy As 1-2-3

Senior **Tony Bajoczky** led the Blue Devils to wins over the top-three ranked teams in the country in three straight weekends. Bajoczky, a Tallahassee, Fla., native held No. 1 Florida State to four runs on six hits in 6.2 innings of work with four strikeouts in an 8-5 win over the Seminoles on March 31. On April 7, he limited No. 3 Virginia to four runs on six hits in six innings of work with four strikeouts in a 13-9 Duke win. Bajoczky then held No. 2 North Carolina to two earned runs on six hits with two strikeouts in eight innings in a 9-3 win over the Tar Heels on April 14.

Duke In The ACC

Entering the weekend, the Blue Devils rank second in the ACC in doubles (111), tied for third in triples (15), fourth in team batting (.304) and hits (536), tied for fifth in stolen bases (68), sixth in on-base percentage (.383), seventh in home runs (31), runs scored (338) and slugging percentage (.437) and eighth in RBI (313).

Individually, junior **Jimmy Gallagher** ranks 11th in batting average (.369) and sophomore **Nate Freiman** ranks 13th (.363). Gallagher also ranks tied for second in doubles (20), fourth in runs scored (57), 10th in hits per game (1.43), tied for fifth in stolen bases (16) and total bases (115), tied for seventh in walks (37), eighth in on-base percentage (.471) and ninth in slugging percentage (.581). Freiman is also tied for fifth in doubles (17), seventh in total bases (112) and eighth in hits per game (1.45). Junior **Brett Bartles** is tied for second in triples (five) and fourth in RBI per game (1.02) and senior **Jonathan Anderson** is seventh in stolen bases (14).

Duke is also seventh in the ACC in team ERA (4.29). Senior **Tony Bajoczky** is second in the conference in opponent batting average (.212), tied for third in wins (nine), fourth in innings pitched (86.1) and 12th in ERA (2.92). Freshman **Michael Seander** is second in saves with nine and tied for fifth in appearances (27) while Anderson is tied for seventh in saves with three.

Bajoczky Named ACC Pitcher Of The Week

Senior **Tony Bajoczky** was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Pitcher of the Week on March 26. Bajoczky became the 11th Duke pitcher in school history to receive the weekly honor, joining teammate **Michael Ness**, who earned the award on March 5.

Bajoczky tossed seven innings of shut-out ball on March 24 as Duke defeated Georgia Tech, 3-0. The Tallahassee, Fla., native held Georgia Tech to five hits in the game and struck out five batters without allowing a walk to improve to 4-2 on the season.

Gallagher Named To Coastal Plain League All-Decade Team

Duke junior **Jimmy Gallagher** was named to the Coastal Plain League All-Decade Team on March 23. The All-Decade Team honors the top players who have played in the Coastal Plain League over its first 10 years of action.

Gallagher was named the 2006 Coastal Plain League and Rawlings Offensive Player of the Year after setting the league record for batting average with a .423 mark, shattering the previous record of .378. Gallagher's .423 batting average was also 68 points higher than the next-best average of .355. He also set the league record in hits with 74, led the league in RBI with 45 and finished second in both slugging percentage (.583) and on-base percentage (.483).

He was named the Rawlings Hitter of the Week after week six of the 2006 season and was the starting leftfielder for the

National CPL All-Star Team last summer. Gallagher was also named the Coastal Plain League's No. 2 prospect by Baseball America last fall following his summer season.

Ness Named ACC Pitcher Of The Week

Freshman **Michael Ness** was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Pitcher of the Week on March 5. Ness went 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA as the Blue Devils won all four games they played Feb. 27-March 4. He became the 10th Duke pitcher in school history to receive the weekly honor and the first since 2004.

Ness, a native of Chatham, N.J., made his first career start on Feb. 27 against North Carolina A&T and held the Aggies to one earned run on four hits in six innings of work. He also recorded four strikeouts in the win without allowing a walk. On March 3, the right-hander came on in relief after Duke fell behind 5-0 to Holy Cross and guided the Blue Devils to a 10-7 victory. Ness held the Crusaders to one earned run on two hits in 3.1 innings. He had two strikeouts in the win and did not give up a walk. On the week, Ness allowed only two earned runs on just six hits in 9.1 innings pitched. He also registered six strikeouts in the two wins without allowing a walk.

Scouting Miami

Miami enters the series 32-20 overall and 14-13 in the ACC. The Hurricanes are 5-4 in ACC series this season. Miami was swept by North Carolina in their ACC opener March 9-11. The Hurricanes then won two of three games against Maryland March 16-18 before dropping two of three to Virginia March 23-25. Miami then took two of three games from Clemson and Georgia Tech before dropping two of three to N.C. State April 13-15. The Hurricanes are 6-3 in their last nine ACC contests. They swept Virginia Tech April 20-22 before dropping two of three to Florida State April 27-29. Miami won two of three against Wake Forest last weekend in their last outing.

Duke-Miami Series History

Miami holds an 11-2 overall record against Duke in series history. The Hurricanes swept the season series last year at Jack Coombs Field March 17-19, winning 3-0, 4-3 and 7-1.
