Career Notes

One of four senior captains for Duke in 2005-06 ... is currently the NCAA's all-time leader in free throw percentage (.922) ... second on the school scoring charts, fourth in ACC history and 46th in NCAA history with 2,527 career points ... fourth on Duke's career chart and tied for 18th in ACC history with a .408 (416-of-1019) three-point field goal percentage ... holds the NCAA record with 416 three-point field goals made ... has started 123 of 128 career games, averaging 19.7 points, 2.8 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game ... the ACC career (.922) and single-season (.953 — 2003-04) free throw percentage leader ... ranks second all-time at Duke with 613 career free throws made ... has reached double digits in scoring 111 times ... scored 20-or-more points in a game 62 times, including 21 times as a junior in 2004-05 and 20 times this season ... has made at least one three-point field goal in 122 games and at least three triples 84 times ... has 27 games with five or more made three-point field goals ... has been named ACC Player of the Week 10 times in his career.

Senior Season (2005-06)

Became the NCAA record holder in three-point field goals, passing Curtis Staples of Virginia (413) against Wake Forest (2/14) ... scored 33 points on 11-of-18 shooting, 4-of-9 from beyond the arc and 7-of-7 from the free-throw line against the Demon Deacons to become the 54th player in NCAA history to score over 2,500 career points ... named ACC Player of the Week for the fifth time this season (2/13) ... tallied 35 points on 9-of-19 shooting, 4-of-10 from three-point range and 13-of-14 from the free-throw line against Maryland (2/11) ... scored the most points (35) ever by a Duke player at North Carolina and second most by an opposing player in the Dean Smith Center ... finished the game 12-of-22 from the field, 5-of-10 from three-point range and 6-of-6 from the free-throw line to go along with four steals against the No. 23 Tar Heels (2/7) ... recorded 36 points, six rebounds and six assists against Florida State (2/4) ... tallied 28 points, five rebounds, four assists and two steals against No. 15 Boston College (2/1) ... shot 8-of-18 from the floor, 3-of-6 from three-point range and 9-of-10 from the free-throw line against the Eagles ... named ACC Player of the Week for the fourth time of the season on January 30 ... scored 40 points on 11-of-13 shooting, 8-of-10 from three-point range and 10-11 from the free-throw line against Virginia (1/28) ... tallied 24 points on 7-of-17 shooting and 8-of-9 from the free-throw line against Virginia Tech (1/26) ... named ACC co-Player of the Week on January 23 ... tied a career high with 41 points on 12-of-24 shooting, 6-of-11 from downtown and 11-of-13 from the free-throw line against Georgetown (1/21) ... scored 28 points on 7-of-15 shooting and a perfect 10-of-10 from the free-throw line to go along with six assists against No. 14 N.C. State (1/18) ... shot 10-of-16 from the field and 12-of-16 from the free-throw line for 34 points against Clemson (1/14) ... posted 27 points on 9-of-22 shooting and 4-of-13 from behind the arc against No. 23 Maryland (1/11) ... also recorded his first career dunk against the Terps ... scored 32 points on 12-of-21 shooting, including 5-of-13 from three-point range to go along with three assists and two steals against No. 23 Wake Forest (1/8) ... tallied 22 points on 9-of-21 shooting against Bucknell (1/2) ... made six three-point field goals and was 9-of-9 from the free throw line for a game-high 35 points against UNC Greensboro (12/31) ... scored a game-high 18 points on 6-of-16 shooting with three assists against St. John's (12/21) ... led all scorers with 30 points on 9-of-15 shooting and 5-of-9 from three-point range against Valparaiso (12/18) ... named ACC Player of the Week (12/12) for the second time this season after leading Duke to a 31-point victory over No. 2 Texas in East Rutherford, N.J. ... posted career highs with 41 points, 13 field goals and nine three-point field goals against No. 2 Texas (12/10) ... his 41 points against the Longhorns is tied for the sixth-most in a game by a Duke player, while his nine three-pointers tied Shane Battier's school record ... the 41 points also made him the ninth player in Duke history to reach the 2,000 point mark for his career ... also became Duke's career three-point field goal leader in the win over the Longhorns... led all scorers with 24 points on 8-of-16 shooting and 4-of-9 from downtown to go along with four assists against Pennsylvania (12/7) ... recorded 18 points on 6-of-19 shooting against Virginia Tech (12/4) in the ACC opener ... posted 29 points on 10-of-17 shooting, 4-of-8 from downtown and 5-of-6 from the free-throw line to go along with five assists, four rebounds and two steals at No. 17 Indiana ... scored all 15 of his points in the first half and shot a perfect 3-of-3 from three-point range against No. 11 Memphis in the championship game of the NIT Season Tip-Off (11/25) ... recorded his seventh career game with over 30 points against Drexel in the semifinals of the NIT Season Tip-Off (11/23) ... finished with 31 points on 8-of-19 shooting and a 13-of-15 mark from the charity stripe ... named ACC Player of the Week after leading Duke to three wins to open the season ... scored 29 points on 10-of-18 from the field, 4-of-6 from 3-point range and 5-of-5 from the charity stripe against Davidson (11/19) ... led Duke with 18 points on 4-of-7 shooting from behind the arc against Seton Hall in the NIT Season Tip-Off (11/16) ... shot 6-of-11 overall with four rebounds and one assist against the Pirates ... posted 19 points on 7-of-14 shooting, including 5-of-7 from the free-throw line against Boston University in the NIT Season Tip-Off (11/14).
