SETTING THE SCENE

► Duke is 5-2 overall after cruising past No. 12 Loyola 15-7 for its second straight top 15 victory.

► Duke head coach John Danowski will be looking for his 376th career victory, breaking the all-time NCAA Division I wins record of 375.

► Jacksonville is 0-5 on the year and is coached by former Duke volunteer assistant coach John Galloway. The former Syracuse goaltender is in his first year as the head coach of the Dolphins.

THE SERIES HISTORY

► Duke has dominated the series with the Dolphins 6-0 since Jacksonville joined the lacrosse ranks.

► The Blue Devils have outscored the Dolphins 97-44 in the six previous meetings.

► The two teams have met in six of the past seven seasons - they did not face off in 2015.

LAST TIME OUT

- Senior goaltender Danny Fowler made 14 saves to lead No. 16 Duke to a 15-7 victory over No. 12 Loyola Saturday.
- The Blue Devils outscored the Greyhounds by a 5-0 margin in the second quarter to take an 8-3 advantage into halftime. Brad Smith spearheaded the spurt with a pair of goals.
- The attack unit of Jack Bruckner, Justin Guterding and Joey Manown combined for 14 points - Bruckner and Guterding with five apiece and Manown with a career-high four.
- Defensively, the Blue Devils held Pat Spencer - the nation's leader in points per game - to just three points on the afternoon.

LAST TIME WE MET

- Duke's Case Matheis recorded a career-high seven points and Justin Guterding added six to lead the third-ranked Blue Devils to an 18-5 victory at Jacksonville last season.
- Senior Reid Maxmin and Peter Welch scored their first career goals for the Blue Devils, while rookie goaltender David McCann made his first career save in the game's final three minutes. Myles Jones recorded his 100th career goal as well, becoming the first Duke midfielder with 100 career tallies.
- The Blue Devils struggled to get into a rhythm offensively, scoring just once in the first period on 12 shots. Jacksonville tied the game 1:10 into the second quarter with a goal from Aaron Jollow, but it was all Blue Devils over the next 13 minutes in building an 8-2 halftime lead.
- In goal, Danny Fowler made six stops and allowed four goals in 45 minutes of action. Luke Aaron had two stops and McCann made one. The Blue Devils held the Dolphins to only 28 shots and forced 22 turnovers, 13 of which were caused.

SCOUTING JACKSONVILLE

▶ Jacksonville is in its eighth season and first under new head coach John Galloway, who previously served on Duke's staff during the 2012 season.

▶ The Dolphins are 0-5 on the year and haven't played a game in nine days. Will Hendrick paces the offense with 11 goals and three assists for 14 points. McLean Chicquen has 11 points.

▶ Chase York leads the defensive unit with eight caused turnovers and 17 ground balls. Hunter Foles handles the faceoff duties and is 58-of-120 for a .483 win percentage at the X.

▶ In goal, Ben Gleichenhaus sports a .496 save percentage and a 14.37 goals against average in his five outings. He is coming off of a 16-save performance at Hartford.

FAMILIAR FACE RETURNS TO DURHAM

▶ Jacksonville head coach John Galloway returns to familiar territory Monday. The first-year head coach was on John Danowski's staff for the 2012 season. He helped Duke to a 15-5 record and a run to the NCAA semifinals.

▶ Prior to taking the reins at Jacksonville, Galloway was an assistant coach at Providence under former Blue Devil assistant Chris Gabrielli.

TOP SCORING ATTACK LINES

▶ The trio of Guterding, Bruckner and Joey Manown is one of the highest scoring attack units nationally. Bolstered by 337 points from Guterding and Bruckner, the trio has amassed 349 points on 241 goals and 108 assists to rank second among current attacking units.

▶ Maryland tops the list with 364 career points and 252 career goals. Bruckner and Guterding's 327 points alone rank second behind the Terrapin trio.

DUKE SPECIAL TEAMS ARE SPECIAL

▶ Since giving up two man-up goals on four chances in the season-opening loss to Air Force, the Blue Devils have allowed just four extra-man scores on 19 man-up opportunities for their opponents. Overall, Duke is successfully killing 74 percent of its penalties this season, the best in the ACC and 13th nationally.

▶ The Blue Devils have found good success on man up this season, converting 60 percent of their extra man opportunities. Duke owns the best EMO in the ACC and is fourth nationally.

HOME SWEET HOME FOR THE BLUE DEVILS

▶ Duke has fared well in the comfy confines of Koskinen Stadium since 2007. The Blue Devils went 5-3 in Durham last season and are 92-16 all-time at home under John Danowski.

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

▶ Since 2006, Duke is 96-48 (.667) versus ranked opponents.

▶ In 2017, Duke is 2-2 against top 20 foes and has six remaining on the regular season schedule

DUKE IN ONE GOAL GAMES

▶ Duke is 76-68 all-time in games decided by one goal in program history.

▶ The Blue Devils played a program-high seven one-goal games in both 1994 and 1997.

▶ Duke is 19-12 in one-goal contests under head coach John Danowski.

DUKE'S TOUGH SCHEDULE

▶ Duke's schedule is annually one of the toughest in collegiate lacrosse. In addition to playing in the ACC, where all five teams are currently in the top 16, the Blue Devils test themselves against ranked non-conference foes as well.

▶ The Blue Devils have already played four top 20 teams and have five more remaining among the next nine regular season games. Four of those six are against teams currently ranked in the top 12.

DANOWSKI NEARING WINS RECORD

► Head coach John Danowski is one win shy of setting the Division I all-time wins record. Dom Starsia and Danowski are currently tied with 375 career victories. Danowski is third among active coaches across all three divisions and is on pace to become the first Division I head coach to reach 400 wins potentially in the 2018 season.

► The Blue Devils leader has 156 wins at Duke, 192 at Hofstra and 27 in his first stop at C.W. Post, now LIU Post.

100 AND COUNTING

► Senior attackman Jack Bruckner notched his 100th and 101st career goals against Air Force, becoming the 19th Blue Devil in to reach the mark. He has 118 career goals to rank 14th at Duke. He needs 16 goals to move into the top 10.

► Justin Guterding followed suit with his 100th and 101st goals versus High Point. He is 15th on the Duke list with 114.

SOPHOMORE BUMP FOR SMITH

► Sophomore midfielder Brad Smith owns eight goals and seven assists for 15 points, surpassing his total from his 19 games as a rookie.

► In 2016, Smith had nine goals and five assists for 14 points. He registered multiple points in four games with a season-high three points against Georgetown last season. In seven games this season, Smith has multiple points in four outings and registered a career-high four points against Cleveland State.

SUCCESS AT THE X

► Duke senior faceoff specialist Kyle Rowe is off to a solid start in 2017, winning 57 percent of his faceoffs in the six games he has played.

► He has picked up double digit ground balls in two of the six games and has won the ground ball in 72 percent of the faceoffs that resulted in ground balls (43-of-60). Of the 50 faceoffs he has won with ensuing ground balls, he has picked up 36 ground balls.

► Of the 72 faceoffs overall won by Rowe, he has 43 ground balls, has won four on violation, 17 have been picked up by Blue Devil teammates and nine resulted in a technical violation or no ground ball.

GUTERDING GOING FOR 70 FOR THIRD TIME

- ▶ Junior Justin Guterding left his name in the Duke records book twice in 2016, becoming the fastest Blue Devil to 100 career points and the first player to score 70 points in each of his first two seasons.
- ▶ He is on pace for just over 80 points this season as he aims to be the fastest player to reach 200 career points. He needs just 23 points and is on pace to reach the mark in 49 games, one faster than Zack Greer's 50.

- ▶ Justin Guterding has scored a point in all 44 of his games as a Blue Devil, totaling 114 goals and 63 assists for 177 points.
- ▶ Jack Bruckner is riding a 45-game point streak, dating back to May 26, 2014. He has 148 points from 111 goals and 37 assists in that span.

GUTERDING GOAL SCORING STREAK

- ▶ Justin Guterding, with a hat trick in five of seven games this season, has at least one goal in 16 consecutive games. He is one of eight Division I players to have an active streak of a goal in the past 10 games.

GUTERDING'S ASSIST GAME THRIVING

- ▶ Guterding is averaging 2.4 assists per game this season, one assist per game improvement of his 1.4 in 2016.
- ▶ At his current pace, he will finish with 39 assists at the conclusion of the regular season, good for sixth in Duke single-season history, only behind single-season performances from Matt Danowski, Ned Crotty and Jordan Wolf.
- ▶ He will push his career total to 85 at his current pace to move into 10th on the career charts as a junior. Danowski and Crotty sit atop the list with 183 and 147, respectively.

NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

- ▶ Duke has a trio of players peppered throughout the top 10 NCAA DI active leaders lists.

- ▶ With a pair of ground balls at Denver, faceoff specialist Kyle Rowe joined the elite 400 ground ball club with 15 other players in NCAA Division I history.
- ▶ He has 419 ground balls and currently is tied for 11th on the NCAA all-time list. His 7.91 ground balls per game average is 12th on the NCAA list, while his 7.00 per game average at Duke is the best in school history.
- ▶ The Vienna, Va., native also moved into the top 25 in the NCAA records book for faceoffs won, ranking 12th with 677.

UPPGREN GRABS FIRST WIN

- ▶ Redshirt freshman goaltender Turner Uppgren picked up his first career victory between the pipes against Cleveland State last weekend. Uppgren came off the bench in the second quarter against the Vikings and made six saves and allowed just one goal in 27:10 of action.
- ▶ He saw his first minutes in goal, playing the second half against High Point. He made one save and allowed one goal against the Panthers.
- ▶ In 71:34 in the cage, Uppgren sports a 3.35 goals against average and a .692 save percentage.

ALL IN THE FAMILY FOR GILES-HARRIS

- ▶ Rookie close defenseman John Thomas (JT) Giles-Harris isn't the only one from his family making a name for himself in Durham.
- ▶ JT's brother, Joe, is a redshirt freshman on the Duke football team and led the team in tackles with 107. Joe garnered honorable mention All-ACC honors in a vote of the league's coaches as well as to the USA

Today Sports Freshman All-America team.

VAN RAAPHORST'S ATHLETIC LINEAGE

- ▶ Sophomore close defenseman Cade Van Raaphorst traded the football for the lacrosse stick despite hailing from a family of elite college quarterbacks.
- ▶ Cade is the son of Jeff Van Raaphorst, quarterback at Arizona State leading the Sun Devils to the Pac-10 and Rose Bowl title in 1987. He was inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame in 2006. Jeff also played in the NFL for a few seasons.
- ▶ Uncle, Mike Van Raaphorst, was the backup quarterback to Carson Palmer at Southern California.

ETHAN POWLEY RETURNS TO LSM

- ▶ Senior captain Ethan Powley will return to his natural long stick middle position in 2017. The veteran pole is Duke's top returning takeaway artist and a ground ball leader.
- ▶ He posted a career-best 21 caused turnovers and was third among defensive players with 36 ground balls. He needs 30 ground balls to reach 100 for his career.

SMITH, LINDSAY WIN GOLD

- ▶ Duke midfielders Brad Smith and Terry Lindsay helped lead the United States U19 squad to the FIL U19 World Championship this past summer.
- ▶ Smith played much of the tournament on the first midfield line, while Lindsay was crucial as a defensive midfielder. They are the latest Blue Devils to win gold with Team USA.

DUKE FEATURES HERALDED ROOKIE CLASS

- ▶ Inside Lacrosse tabbed Duke's rookie class as the best in the nation heading into 2017. The group features six players ranked in the top 36 of Inside Lacrosse's Power 100 list.
- ▶ Attackman Joey Manown, after a postgraduate year at Deerfield Academy, headlines the group at No. 7, while midfielders Reilly Walsh (Brunswick) and Terry Lindsay (Georgetown Prep) rounded out Duke in the top 15 at Nos. 12 and 13, respectively.
- ▶ Kevin Quigley (Ridge) was No. 17 and defenseman JT Giles-Harris (St. Joseph's [N.J.]) was 25th. Brian Smyth (Westminster School), a faceoff specialist, was the final Blue Devil in the rankings at No. 36.
- ▶ Walsh, Smyth and Giles-Harris suited up for the North Team and Quigley wore the South Team jersey at the 2016 Under Armour All-America game.

CAPUTO JOINS THE DEFENSE

- ▶ The Duke coaching staff switched things up this season as assistant coach Ron Caputo moves from the offensive to the defensive side of the ball. Caputo has worked closely with the midfield and attack during his time with Duke.
- ▶ Head coach John Danowski recently had been with the defense for the past few seasons and now Caputo will take over the reins with volunteer assistant coach Alec Jernstedt, while John Danowski joins his son Matt on offense.

OH CAPTAINS MY CAPTAINS

► The quartet of seniors Jack Bruckner, Danny Fowler, Ethan Powley and Tommy Zenker will lead the Blue Devils in 2017. Fowler follows in the footsteps of his brother Brendan, who captained the Blue Devils to the 2014 NCAA title.

DUKE DISPLAYS GROWTH OF THE GAME

► The Blue Devils feature players from 18 different states ranging from South Carolina and Florida to Minnesota and Washington.

► New York and New Jersey still carry the majority with 16 student-athletes hailing from those two states. Four of the 10 from New York attended Chaminade High School.
