### SETTING THE SCENE

► Duke is 6-2 overall after posting two wins in three days, including a top-20 win over Loyola.

► Duke head coach John Danowski climbed to the top of the NCAA Division I wins list with his 376th career victory.

► Georgetown is 2-4 overall and coming off of a commanding 16-6 victory over Hobart. Three of the four losses came against current top 20 teams.

### THE SERIES HISTORY

► Duke, meeting Georgetown for the 30th time, has dominated the series, going 23-6.

► The Blue Devils won last season 20-6 and edged the Hoyas 15-13 in Washington D.C., in 2015. The Hoyas' last win over Duke was an 11-7 upset in 2008.

► The two teams have played in nine of the past 10 seasons.

### LAST TIME OUT

► Duke head coach John Danowski etched his name in the NCAA records book as the NCAA Division I men's lacrosse wins leader with a 13-6 victory over Jacksonville Monday. Coaching in his 563rd career game overall and 205th at Duke, Danowski climbed atop the Division I coaching records list with his 376th career victory.

► The Blue Devils got off to a slow start offensively, managing just one goal in the opening 10 minutes. Knotted 1-1 midway through the first quarter, Sean Lowrie sparked a 4-0 run for Duke. Joey Manown registered a hat trick as he and Lowrie finished the afternoon with four points. Justin Guterding continued his scoring pace with a goal and three assists.

► Duke was solid defensively, forcing 22 turnovers and holding the Dolphins to only 20 shots for the game. Danny Fowler (49:34, 4 GA, 5 saves), Turner Uppgren (8:37, 1 GA, 1 save) and David McCann (1:49, 1 GA) combined for six saves. Cade Van Raaphorst led all Blue Devils with six ground balls. Kyle Rowe went 7-of-15 at the X with four ground balls.

### LAST TIME WE MET

► Junior Jack Bruckner scored five goals and added two assists to lead No. 9 Duke to a 20-6 win over visiting Georgetown last season.

► Justin Guterding added three goals and three assists to the offensive output, while Danny Fowler made nine saves on 12 shots on goal. Blue Devil seniors John Shaffer and Joe Kruy threw in their first goals of the season and rookie Brad Smith finished with a career-high three points on a goal and two helpers.

► Kyle Rowe keyed Duke's faceoff success by winning 19-of-23 draws while picking up 14 ground balls. In the Duke net, Fowler (9 saves & 3 goals allowed in 37:20), Luke Aaron (3 saves & 3 goals allowed in 20:15) and David McCann (0 saves & 0 goals allowed in 2:25) combined to limit the Hoyas to six goals on 33 shots.

► For Georgetown, Devon Harris recorded two goals and one assist. Starting goalkeeper Nick Marrocco logged four saves against 15 goals allowed in 33:15 between the pipes.

#### SCOUTING GEORGETOWN

► Georgetown is 2-4 on the season and coming off of a 16-6 win over Hobart. The Hoyas are averaging 10 goals per game and giving up 10 goals per game.

► Daniel Bucaro headlines the offense with 25 points from 19 goals and six assists, while Peter Conley has 22 points. The pair accounts for 51 percent of Georgetown's scoring.

► Michael Mayer leads the defensive charge with 12 caused turnovers and 22 ground balls. Peter Tagliaferri handles the faceoff duties, winning 33-of-49 restarts and picking up seven ground balls.

► In goal, Nick Marrocco sports a 9.91 goals against average and a .532 save percentage.

#### TOP SCORING ATTACK LINES

► The trio of Guterding, Bruckner and Joey Manown is one of the highest scoring attack units nationally both this season and in overall combined career points.

► Duke's trio is third nationally in scoring this season with 86 points (52g, 34a) ... Only Virginia (93) and Penn State (87) are higher. Bruckner and Guterding's 70 points alone this season rank sixth among three-man units.

► On the career list, Guterding, Bruckner and Manown are second. Bolstered by 343 points from Guterding and Bruckner, the trio has amassed 359 points on 246 goals and 113 assists to rank second among current attacking units.

► Maryland tops the list with 364 career points and 252 career goals. Bruckner and Guterding's 343 points alone rank second behind the Terrapin trio.

#### DUKE SPECIAL TEAMS ARE SPECIAL

► Since allowing two man-up goals on four chances in the season-opening loss to Air Force, the Blue Devils have surrendered just five extra-man scores on 20 man-up opportunities for their opponents. Overall, Duke is successfully killing 71 percent of its penalties this season, the best in the ACC and 17th nationally.

► The Blue Devils have found good success on man up this season, converting 55 percent of their extra man opportunities. Duke owns the second best EMO in the ACC and is eighth nationally.

#### AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

► Since 2006, Duke is 96-48 (.667) versus ranked opponents.

► In 2017, Duke is 2-2 against top 20 foes and has six remaining on the regular season schedule

► With a pair of ground balls at Denver, faceoff specialist Kyle Rowe joined the elite 400 ground ball club with 15 other players in NCAA Division I history.

► He has 423 ground balls and 10th on the NCAA all-time list. His 7.83 ground balls per game average is 13th on the NCAA list, while his 6.92 per game average at Duke is the best in school history.

► The Vienna, Va., native also moved into the top 25 in the NCAA records book for faceoffs won, ranking 12th with 684.

► Redshirt freshman goaltender Turner Uppgren picked up his first career victory between the pipes against Cleveland State. Uppgren came off the bench in the second quarter against the Vikings and made six saves and allowed just one goal in 27:10 of action.

► He saw his first minutes in goal, playing the second half against High Point. He made one save and allowed one goal against the Panthers.

► In 80:11 in the cage, Uppgren sports a 3.74 goals against average and a .667 save percentage.

► Sophomore close defenseman Cade Van Raaphorst traded the football for the lacrosse stick despite hailing from a family of elite college quarterbacks.

► Cade is the son of Jeff Van Raaphorst, quarterback at Arizona State leading the Sun Devils to the Pac-10 and Rose Bowl title in 1987. He was inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame in 2006. Jeff also played in the NFL for a few seasons.

► Uncle, Mike Van Raaphorst, was the backup quarterback to Carson Palmer at Southern California.

#### **ETHAN POWLEY RETURNS TO LSM**

► Senior captain Ethan Powley will return to his natural long stick middle position in 2017. The veteran pole is Duke's top returning takeaway artist and a ground ball leader.

► He posted a career-best 21 caused turnovers and was third among defensive players with 36 ground balls in 2016. He needs 23 ground balls to reach 100 for his career.

#### **SMITH, LINDSAY WIN GOLD**

► Duke midfielders Brad Smith and Terry Lindsay helped lead the United States U-19 squad to the FIL U19 World Championship this past summer.

► Smith played much of the tournament on the first midfield line, while Lindsay was crucial as a defensive midfielder. They are the latest Blue Devils to win gold with Team USA.

#### **DUKE FEATURES HERALDED ROOKIE CLASS**

► Inside Lacrosse tabbed Duke's rookie class as the best in the nation heading into 2017. The group features six players ranked in the top 36 of Inside Lacrosse's Power 100 list.

► Attackman Joey Manown, after a postgraduate year at Deerfield Academy, headlines the group at No. 7, while midfielders Reilly Walsh (Brunswick) and Terry Lindsay (Georgetown Prep) rounded out Duke in the top 15 at Nos. 12 and 13, respectively.

► Kevin Quigley (Ridge) was No. 17 and defenseman JT Giles-Harris (St. Joseph's [N.J.]) was 25th. Brian Smyth (Westminster School), a faceoff specialist, was the final Blue Devil in the rankings at No. 36.

► Walsh, Smyth and Giles-Harris suited up for the North Team and Quigley wore the South Team jersey at the 2016 Under Armour All-America game.

#### **CAPUTO JOINS THE DEFENSE**

► The Duke coaching staff switched things up this season as assistant coach Ron Caputo moves from the offensive to the defensive side of the ball. Caputo has worked closely with the midfield and attack during his time with Duke.

► Head coach John Danowski had been with the defense for the past few seasons and now Caputo will take over the reins with volunteer assistant coach Alec Jernstedt, while John Danowski joins his son Matt on offense.

#### **OH CAPTAINS MY CAPTAINS**

► The quartet of seniors Jack Bruckner, Danny Fowler, Ethan Powley and Tommy Zenker will lead the Blue Devils in 2017. Fowler follows in the footsteps of his brother Brendan, who captained the Blue Devils to the 2014 NCAA title.

#### **DUKE DISPLAYS GROWTH OF THE GAME**

► The Blue Devils feature players from 18 different states ranging from South Carolina and Florida to Minnesota and Washington.

► New York and New Jersey still carry the majority with 16 student-athletes hailing from those two states. Four of the 10 from New York attended Chaminade High School.

#### **UP NEXT**

► Duke opens ACC play next weekend as it continues its three-game road swing. The Blue Devils face off with No. 6 Syracuse at 1:30 p.m., in the Carrier Dome.
