SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ Duke is 12-4 overall and making its 21st appearance in the NCAA Tournament.
- ▶ The Blue Devils are coming off of an 18-8 win over Boston University to close out the regular season.
- ▶ Johns Hopkins earned the No. 6 seed with an 8-6 overall record and 3-2 mark in the Big 10. This is its 45th NCAA Tournament appearance.

THE SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ Duke and the Blue Jays are meeting for the 28th time and for the seventh time in NCAA Tournament history.
- ▶ Johns Hopkins leads the series 16-11, but Duke has won the past two games, both of which were in the NCAA Tournament. The Blue Devils are 3-3 in the six tournament outings versus the Blue Jays, four of which were decided by a single goal.

NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTES

- ▶ Duke is making its 21st appearance in the NCAA tournament and 11th straight overall.
- ▶ The Blue Devils are 32-17 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The 32 wins rank tied for fifth among Division I teams. Duke is 14-6 in first round games.
- ▶ Duke is unseeded for just the fourth time in program history. The Blue Devils are 0-3 as an unseeded team.
- ▶ Duke is 3-0 in overtime NCAA Tournament games and 2-0 under John Danowski.
- ▶ Duke has won 26 of its past 34 NCAA playoff games. Three of the losses came against Johns Hopkins in the 2005 and 2007 title games and the 2008 semifinals.
- ▶ Overall, the Blue Devils are 27-8 in NCAA action when scoring at least 10 goals and 1-9 when held to single digits.
- ▶ Duke is one of nine schools with more tournament wins than postseason appearances (Cornell, Denver, Duke, Johns Hopkins, Maryland, North Carolina, Princeton, Syracuse & Virginia).
- ▶ Duke's 16 NCAA Tournament wins since 2010 are the most of any program in that span. Maryland is second with 15.

DUKE'S NCAA TOURNAMENT STREAK AT 11

- ▶ Duke is one of five teams to have an active streak of at least 10 consecutive NCAA appearances with Maryland holding the longest at 15.
- ▶ Four of the teams are currently members of the ACC - Notre Dame at 12, Duke and UNC at 11 and Syracuse at 10.
- ▶ Overall, Johns Hopkins holds the longest streak in NCAA history, qualifying for 41 straight NCAA Tournaments from 1972-2012.

LAST TIME OUT

► Justin Guterding tallied a game-high seven points from three goals and four assists in an 18-8 victory No. 20 Boston University last Sunday.

► Brad Smith chipped in a career-high four goals, while freshman Kevin Quigley notched his first career hat trick. Sophomore Cade Van Raaphorst, freshman Brian Smyth and junior David Gill scored their first career goals.

► In goal, Danny Fowler played 49 minutes and made eight saves. Turner Uppgren and David McCann

played the final 11 minutes, combining for three saves. The quartet of Kyle Rowe (14-of-16), Smyth (6-of-9), Thomas Palisi (2-of-2) and Teddy Henderson (1-of-2) dominated the faceoff X, winning 23-of-29 restarts.

LAST TIME WE MET

► Jordan Wolf tallied eight points to lead the Blue Devils to their eight consecutive NCAA semifinal with a 19-11 win over Johns Hopkins in the 2014 NCAA quarterfinal.

► Sophomore midfielder Myles Jones added three goals and four assists, while senior Josh Dionne had four goals before suffering an injury. Case Matheis chipped in five points (3g, 2a), his third hat trick of the season.

► Brendan Fowler won 17-of-33 faceoffs and picked up 13 ground balls and Will Haus helped anchor the defensive game with an assist and three ground balls. Chris Hipps and Casey Carroll both picked up three ground balls apiece as Duke held the Blue Jays to just three goals in the second half.

► Luke Aaron made three saves in 35 minutes of action and Kyle Turri had one stop in the final 24 minutes of relief.

SCOUTING JOHNS HOPKINS

► Johns Hopkins enters the NCAA Tournament as the No. 6 seed with an 8-6 overall record. The Blue Jays are 7-1 at home this season with the lone loss coming to Syracuse in overtime. Johns Hopkins is on a two-game losing streak, falling to Maryland and Ohio State on the road in the past two outings.

► Kyle Marr and Shack Stanwick headline the offense with 45 points apiece. Joel Tinney is third with 27. Patrick Fraser paces the nation's best extra man offense with eight man-up scores.

► Overall, the Blue Jays are averaging 12 goals per game and have scored 10-plus goals in nine of the 14 games. In five of the six losses, Johns Hopkins failed to score double digit goals.

► Defensively, Johns Hopkins is giving up 10.93 goals per game. Nick Fields, All-Big Ten first team selection, is the leader on the defensive front with 15 caused turnovers and 23 ground balls. Jack Rapine has 14 forced turnovers and 25 GBs. Gerald Logan and Brock Turnbaugh have split duties in goal. Turnbaugh has started the past six games, but has only played 26:24 in the past two games before being replaced. He sports an 11.87 goals against average and .421 save percentage overall.

► The Blue Jays also split time at the faceoff X. Hunter Moreland has won 96-of-170 (.565) draws, while Craig Madarasz is 61-of-155 (.394).

MAN-UP VS. MAN-DOWN

▶ Johns Hopkins features the nation's best man-up offense, scoring on 61 percent of its extra-man opportunities. The Blue Devils, on the other hand, feature a tough man-down squad with a 70 percent success rate.

▶ Duke has allowed just 14 extra-man goals this season and only nine in the past 12 games, compared to the five allowed in the opening four outings.

▶ Johns Hopkins has a man-up goal in all but three games, while Duke has held six teams to zero extra-man tallies and only given up two in a game four times.

DANOWSKI MOVES TO TOP OF WINS LIST

▶ Head coach John Danowski etched his name at the top of the Division I men's lacrosse wins list beating Jacksonville for his 376th career victory. Dom Starsia held the previous record of 375. Danowski is third among active coaches across all three divisions and is on pace to become the first Division I head coach to reach 400 wins potentially in the 2018 season.

▶ The Blue Devils leader has 163 wins at Duke, 192 at Hofstra and 27 in his first stop at LIU Post.

FIVE EARN ALL-ACC HONORS

▶ Five Blue Devils earned All-ACC honors, the most in program history. Jack Bruckner (A), Cade Van Raaphorst (D), Kyle Rowe (FO) and Danny Fowler (G) earn recognition for the first time, while Justin Guterding garners the honor for the second season.

▶ Van Raaphorst is one of three underclassmen and one of two sophomores voted to the squad and is the first Duke close defenseman to earn All-ACC honors since Tony McDevitt in 2008.

▶ Fowler is just the fourth Duke goalie to earn All-ACC recognition since the inaugural team in 1977 and the first since Aaron Fenton in 2005.

10 BLUE DEVILS TO GRADUATE SUNDAY

▶ All 10 of Duke's seniors will take part in Duke's graduation ceremony Sunday, May 14. In the recent APR announcement, Duke totaled a score of 995 to sit in a tie for first in the ACC. Under Danowski, Duke men's lacrosse has never had below a 3.0 team GPA.

FRESHMAN PRODUCTION

► Six Blue Devil freshmen or redshirt freshmen have played at least 11 games this season, the most since the 2011 campaign. All six rookies have all played in all 16 games this season and started a combined 51 contests.

► Five of the six have at least one point and own 86 points overall this season. JT Giles-Harris is the first close defenseman to earn a starting role since Chris Hipps in 2011. Giles-Harris has 25 ground balls and five caused turnovers compared to Hipps' 12 and six, respectively.

► Offensively, the six Blue Devils in 2011 combined for 74 points from four players.

DUKE DEFENSE ONE OF BEST UNDER DANOWSKI

► Duke's 2017 defensive performance through 16 games has proven to be one of the Blue Devils' finest since head coach John Danowski took the reins in 2007.

► Duke's current 8.06 goals against average is the best for a Danowski-coached Duke squad since the 2009 team sported a 7.85 GAA.

► The Blue Devils' talented 2007, 2008 and 2009 teams all had goals against averages under eight. In Duke's three national championship seasons (2010, 2013, 2014), the Blue Devils allowed 9.23, 10.31 and 9.49 goals per game, respectively, through the first 16 games of the season.

DUKE'S DEFENSIVE STAND IN PAST 12 GAMES

► In 10 of the past 12 games, Duke has held its opponent to eight or fewer goals. The lone exceptions are No. 5 Syracuse, scoring 12 goals and Virginia netting 11 goals.

► In the Blue Devils' 10-2 stretch, Duke is allowing just 7.67 goals per game and holding teams to .254 shooting.

► Fowler is averaging 9.17 saves per game and owns a 7.58 goals against average and a .561 save percentage. He has stopped at least 50 percent of shots faced in 11 of the past 12 games and posted double digit saves in six of them.

► The combination of Duke's defense excelling and the offense clicking of late, has allowed the Blue Devils to build solid first-half leads.

► The Blue Devils are holding its past 12 opponents to an average of 13 shots and 3.58 goals in the first half, while compiling 19.6 and 7.42 of their own, respectively, in the first 30 minutes.

TOP 20 OPPONENT SCORING DROUGHTS

► In their six top 20 victories this season, the Blue Devils have clamped down on defense. Duke has held four of the five opponents to fewer than 10 goals and has held all four teams to at least one 10-minute scoreless stretch during the game and five of the six without a goal for 15-plus minutes. Duke has outscored the teams by at least 3-0 in each of the opponents' scoring droughts.

- ▶ With four points at Marquette junior Justin Guterding became the first Blue Devil to record at least 70 points in each of his first three seasons, going for 70, 71 and 72 in his respective seasons. He also is the fastest Blue Devil to 100 career points and is tied for the fastest player to 200 points.
- ▶ Guterding pushed his season points total to a league-best 84 last weekend to become the sixth Blue Devil in program history to score 80 points in a season. He currently sits in eighth in single-season points.
- ▶ He is one of six Blue Devils to rank in the top 15 in school history in career points (224), goals (140) and assists (84). The other five are Matt Danowski, Jordan Wolf, Zack Greer, Dave Hagler and Myles Jones.

TRACKING BRUCKNER AND GUTERDING

- ▶ Senior attackman Jack Bruckner notched his 100th and 101st career goals against Air Force, becoming the 19th Blue Devil in to reach the mark. He has 142 career goals, eight shy of the No. 7 spot in Duke history.
- ▶ Justin Guterding followed suit with his 100th and 101st goals versus High Point. He is on Bruckner's heels with 140.

BRUCKNER AND GUTERDING DYNAMIC DUO

- ▶ The Batman and Robin tandem of Bruckner and Guterding has been unstoppable this season. In all 16 of Duke's games this season the leading scorer has been either Guterding or Bruckner. Guterding has led the way himself nine times, tied with Bruckner three times and Joey Manown once. Bruckner was tops in points against Syracuse, Denver and Notre Dame in the regular season.
- ▶ Overall, the duo is the highest scoring attacking tandem in the country with Duke being the lone school to have two players in the top 10 among active players in career goals and one of two schools to have two players ranked in the top 20 in goals per game.
- ▶ Of Bruckner's 43 goals in 2017, 18 of them (42 percent) have been assisted by Guterding. Bruckner has provided seven assists to Guterding's 20 (35 percent) assisted scores, while the junior has thrown in 25 unassisted goals.

BLUE DEVILS DUO POINT STREAKS

- ▶ Justin Guterding has scored a point in all 53 of his games as a Blue Devil, totaling 140 goals and 84 assists for 224 points.
- ▶ Jack Bruckner is riding a 54-game point streak, dating back to May 26, 2014. He has 178 points from 135 goals and 43 assists in that span.

- ▶ At his current pace, he will finish with at least 40 assists in 2017, sixth in Duke single-season history. Only Jordan Wolf, Matt Danowski and Ned Crotty have more assists in a season than Guterding.
- ▶ Guterding will push his career total to 86 to move into 11th on the career charts as a junior. Matt Danowski and Ned Crotty sit atop the list with 183 and 147, respectively.

- ▶ With 16 faceoff wins at Syracuse, Kyle Rowe joined an elite club of players with at least 700 career wins at the X.
- ▶ He is one of 13 players in NCAA history to record 700-plus wins at the faceoff X, while his 789 victories are eighth in NCAA history. He is 11 shy of becoming the seventh player in NCAA history to record 800 faceoff victories.

ROWE IN NCAA RECORDS BOOK

- ▶ Senior faceoff specialist Kyle Rowe is the active leader and ranked fourth in NCAA history in career ground balls with 479. He is 21 shy of reaching 500, a total only three players in history have reached.
- ▶ His 7.73 ground balls per game average is 14th on the NCAA list, while his 6.93 per game average at Duke is the best in school history, edging Brendan Fowler's 6.41 per game average.

JOEY MANOWN TURNING THE CORNER

- ▶ In the past 10 games, rookie attackman Joey Manown has 23 points to push his season total to 31. The 23 points are 15 more than his total from the first six games of the year.
- ▶ He started his career with eight points in his first three games before going on a three-game scoreless stretch. He rejoined the starting lineup against Loyola and was instrumental in the Blue Devils' victory as he netted his first career hat trick. He has at least two goals in six of the past 10 games, has recorded three hat tricks and at least one point in nine of the 10 games.

- ▶ Rookie close defenseman John Thomas (JT) Giles-Harris isn't the only one from his family making a name for himself in Durham.
- ▶ JT's brother, Joe, was a redshirt freshman on the Duke football team and led the team in tackles with 107. Joe garnered honorable mention All-ACC honors in a vote of the league's coaches and was named a USA Today Sports First Team Freshman All-American.

VAN RAAPHORST'S ATHLETIC LINEAGE

- ▶ Sophomore close defenseman Cade Van Raaphorst traded the football for the lacrosse stick despite hailing from a family of elite college quarterbacks.
- ▶ Cade is the son of Jeff Van Raaphorst, quarterback at Arizona State leading the Sun Devils to the Pac-10 and Rose Bowl title in 1987. He was inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame in 2006. Jeff also played in the NFL for a few seasons.
- ▶ Uncle, Mike Van Raaphorst, was the backup quarterback to Carson Palmer at Southern California.

ETHAN POWLEY RETURNS TO LSM

- ▶ Senior captain Ethan Powley returns to his natural long stick middle position in 2017. The veteran pole is Duke's top returning takeaway artist and a ground ball leader.
- ▶ He posted a career-best 21 caused turnovers and was third among defensive players with 36 ground balls in 2016. He needs 14 ground balls to reach 100 for his career.

SMITH, LINDSAY WIN GOLD

- ▶ Duke midfielders Brad Smith and Terry Lindsay helped lead the United States U-19 squad to the FIL U19 World Championship this past summer.
- ▶ Smith played much of the tournament on the first midfield line, while Lindsay was crucial as a defensive midfielder. They are the latest Blue Devils to win gold with Team USA.

CAPUTO JOINS THE DEFENSE

- ▶ The Duke coaching staff switched things up this season as assistant coach Ron Caputo moves from the offensive to the defensive side of the ball. Caputo has worked closely with the midfield and attack during his time with Duke.

OH CAPTAINS MY CAPTAINS

- ▶ The quartet of seniors Jack Bruckner, Danny Fowler, Ethan Powley and Tommy Zenker will lead the Blue Devils in 2017. Fowler follows in the footsteps of his brother Brendan, who captained the Blue Devils to the 2014 NCAA title.

DUKE DISPLAYS GROWTH OF THE GAME

- ▶ The Blue Devils feature players from 18 different states ranging from South Carolina and Florida to Minnesota and Washington.
- ▶ New York and New Jersey still carry the majority with 16 student-athletes hailing from those two states. Four of the 10 from New York attended Chaminade High School.

- ▶ The winner of today's game advances to the NCAA quarterfinals to play the winner between Ohio State and Loyola. The quarterfinal will be played at Hofstra University in Hempstead, N.Y.
