



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. Utah Valley



November 11, 2017 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- With tonight's win, **Mike Krzyzewski** improved his record at Duke to 1,000-271, becoming the first head coach in Division I men's basketball to win 1,000 games at one school. Coach K is in his 38th season at Duke. His overall record improved to 1,073-330 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke extended its home winning streak in non-conference games to 134 games, the nation's longest streak.
- **Marvin Bagley III** finished with a game-high 24 points and 10 rebounds in 32 minutes. He is the first Duke freshman to post a double-double in each of his first two college games. Last night, Bagley had 25-10 versus Elon.
- Bagley is the first Duke freshman with back-to-back doubles since January 2016 when **Brandon Ingram** went for 19-10 versus Miami and 14-10 versus Georgia Tech.
- It is the first time a Duke freshman posted back-to-back 20-10 games since **Jabari Parker** had consecutive games of 21-10 versus FAU and UNC-Asheville in November 2013.
- Bagley also matches another Duke record held by Parker for most points by a freshman over the first two games of a career (49).
- Trailing Utah Valley 17-15 with 11:38 left in the first half, Duke put five freshmen on the floor together - **Marvin Bagley III, Gary Trent, Jr., Wendell Carter, Jr., Alex O'Connell** and **Jordan Goldwire** - and out-scored UVU 11-3 over the next 3:13 to claim a 26-20 lead. Bagley had seven in the run. Duke never trailed again.
- **Grayson Allen's** first points came on a dunk at 2:42 of first half. He hit a three on the next possession. He finished with 18 points.
- All five Duke starters finished in double figures, led by the 24 from Bagley.
- Freshman guard **Trevon Duval** finished with 15 points, 12 assists, three steals and one turnover. In his first two college games, Duval has posted 20 assists against just one turnover.
- Duval's 20 assists over his first two college games shatters the previous Duke record of 12 held by **Chris Duhon** in the 1999-00 season.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 986. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- The game marked the 424th consecutive sellout crowd of 9,314 at Cameron Indoor Stadium. It is the longest active streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
