



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. Florida / PK80 Championship

- Tonight's game was Duke's 231st when playing as the No. 1-ranked team under head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**, three more than UCLA's John Wooden for most games coached as a No. 1 team in NCAA history. Duke improved to 202-29 in those games.
- Duke has won 47 of its past 72 games when both teams have been ranked in the top 10. The Blue Devils are 79-55 overall under Coach K when both teams are ranked in the top 10.
- Duke played its 157th game as the nation's No. 1-ranked team in the AP poll since 1998. That figure is 76 more than the next closest school (Kentucky) during that time.
- Duke has won eight consecutive games played in NBA arenas, and is 26-7 in NBA arenas since the start of the 2010-11 season.
- Coach K's record at Duke improved to 1,006-271 in his 38th season. His overall record improved to 1,079-330 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke's 17-point second-half comeback (trailed 74-57 with 9:48 remaining) matches the fifth-largest comeback in school history.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 993. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- The Blue Devils improved to 5-0 all-time when playing in the city of Portland, Oregon.
- Freshman forward **Marvin Bagley III** recorded his third straight double-double and sixth in eight games, which ties the NCAA lead with Minnesota's Jordan Murphy.
- With 30 points and 15 rebounds, Bagley becomes the first Duke player in history to record onsecutive games of 30-15 games. He had 34-15 in Friday's win over Texas.
- Bagley III's six double-doubles through the first eight games are the most by any Duke freshman in history.
- Bagley is the first Duke player since 1973 to record three-consecutive games of 15+ rebounds.
- Each of Duke's 12 double-doubles this season have come from freshmen (Bagley 6, Carter 4, Duval 2).
- Freshman guard **Gary Trent, Jr.**, was 4-for-4 at the free throw line, extending his streak of consecutive made free throws to 17.
