



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. South Dakota



December 2, 2017 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Tonight's game was Duke's 233rd when playing as the No. 1-ranked team under head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**, five more than UCLA's John Wooden for most games coached as a No. 1 team in NCAA history. Duke improved to 204-29 in those games.
- Duke's 261 all-time games played as the No. 1-ranked team are the most in NCAA history.
- Duke played its 159th game as the nation's No. 1-ranked team in the AP poll since 1998. That figure is 78 more than the next closest school (Kentucky) during that time.
- Coach K's record at Duke improved to 1,008-271 in his 38th season. His overall record improved to 1,081-330 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke is 10-0 to start a season for the fourth time since the 2010-11 season, and 15th time under Coach K - 13 of those seasons have ended in the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- The Blue Devils extended their streak to 137 consecutive non-conference home wins at Cameron Indoor Stadium. It is the nation's longest active streak.
- Duke has sold out 426 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 994. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** posted his eighth double-double with 19 points and 12 rebounds to tie the NCAA lead. Bagley has had a double-double in five consecutive games, and in six of the last seven.
- Bagley set a career high with three blocked shots.
- Each of Duke's 15 double-doubles have come from freshmen this season, the third-most by a freshman class in a season in Duke history. (Bagley 8, Carter 5, **Trevon Duval** 2).
- Sophomore **Javin DeLaurier** set a career high with 13 points and finished a rebound shy of his first career double-double. His previous career best of six points occurred on four previous occasions.
- Senior guard **Grayson Allen** scored 25 points - his fourth 20-point game this season and 34th of his career. Duke improved to 28-6 when Allen scores 20+.
