



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. St. Francis (Pa.)



December 5, 2017 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Duke set a school record with 34 assists. The previous record was 33 versus Miami on February 19, 1986.
- Duke's 71-point first half was one shy of the school record for points in a half. It was just the fourth 70-point half in school history. The record of 72 points was set versus Virginia (2<sup>nd</sup> half) on February 11, 1965 and 72 versus Harvard (1<sup>st</sup> half) on November 25, 1989.
- With 124 points, it stands as the fifth-highest scoring game in school history, and the most points in a game since 126 versus Mercer on December 21, 1997. The school record is 136 points versus Harvard on February 11, 1965.
- The 57-point margin of victory was the 12<sup>th</sup>-largest in the Mike Krzyzewski-era, and the largest since a 113-44 (69 points) win over Presbyterian on November 14, 2014.
- Tonight's game was Duke's 234<sup>rd</sup> when playing as the No. 1-ranked team under head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**, five more than UCLA's John Wooden for most games coached as a No. 1 team in NCAA history. Duke improved to 205-29 in those games.
- Duke's 262 all-time games played as the No. 1-ranked team are the most in NCAA history.
- Duke played its 160<sup>th</sup> game as the nation's No. 1-ranked team in the AP poll since 1998. That figure is 79 more than the next closest school (Kentucky) during that time.
- Coach K's record at Duke improved to 1,009-271 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record improved to 1,082-330 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke is 11-0 to start a season for the fourth time since the 2010-11 season, and 11<sup>th</sup> time under Coach K - nine of those seasons have ended in the Sweet 16 or beyond.
- The Blue Devils extended their streak to 138 consecutive non-conference home wins at Cameron Indoor Stadium. It is the nation's longest active streak.
- Duke has sold out 427 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 995. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** won his 50<sup>th</sup> game at Cameron Indoor Stadium, improving his home record as a Blue Devil to 50-5 (.909).
- Allen finished the game 5-of-5 from the field, 2-of-2 at the free-throw line, had 14 points, six assists and five rebounds.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** posted his ninth double-double to tie the NCAA lead. Bagley has had a double-double in six consecutive games, and in seven of the last eight.
- Sophomore **Marques Bolden** recorded his first career double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds in just 15 minutes of action. The 17 points were a career-high and he matched his career-high with 10 rebounds.
- Bolden is the first non-freshman to record a double-double for Duke this season. The Blue Devils' other 16 double-doubles have come from freshmen -- tied for the second-most by a rookie class in a season in Duke history. (Bagley 9, **Wendell Carter Jr.** 5, **Trevon Duval** 2).
- Sophomore **Justin Robinson** had career highs of points (five), minutes (eight) and blocks (three).
- Freshman **Jordan Tucker** (six points) and **Mike Buckmire** (three) each scored their first collegiate points.
