



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. Florida State



December 30, 2017 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Duke has won 11 consecutive ACC home openers and is 29-9 in ACC home openers under head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**.
- Duke has reached the 100-point mark in three consecutive home games for just the second time under Coach K (100-93 vs. Florida State, 104-40 vs. Evansville, 124-67 vs. St. Francis) and third time in school history. The other three-game stretches of 100+ points at home came in the 1996-97 and the 1977-78 seasons.
- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,011-272 in his 38th season. His overall record is 1,084-331 in this, his 43rd season.
- **Marvin Bagley III** (32 points, 21 rebounds) and **Wendell Carter, Jr.** (14 points, 16 rebounds) each recorded double-doubles in the game, marking the seventh time this season that multiple Blue Devil freshmen had a double-double in the same game. That had happened just three times in Duke history before this season.
- It is the 11th double-double for Bagley (second-most in the NCAA) and sixth for Carter.
- Bagley set a Duke freshman game record with his 21 rebounds, surpassing the mark of 20 rebounds by **Jahlil Okafor** vs. Elon (12/15/14).
- Bagley's 11 offensive rebounds are also a Duke freshman game record.
- Among all Duke players, Bagley's 21 rebounds are the second-most at Cameron Indoor Stadium in the Coach K era (22 by **Miles Plumlee** vs. Maryland in 2012) and tied for 12th-most in a game in school history. The 21 rebounds are the most by any Duke player since Plumlee's 22 vs. Maryland.
- Bagley's performance is the first 30-20 game by a Duke player under Coach K and just the fourth 30-15 game under Coach K - Bagley has three of them (34-15 vs. Texas; 30-15 vs. Florida), with **Christian Laettner** (33-16 vs. Maryland in 1992) the other.
- Bagley III's 13 made field goals (13/17) tied a Duke freshman game record that was set three previous times (13 by Mike Gminski vs. Wake, 1977; Jahlil Okafor vs. VT, 2015; Okafor vs. ND, 2015).
- The 16 rebounds by Carter are a career high (12 vs. Indiana and Michigan State).
- As a top-5 ranked team (AP poll), Duke improved to 548-93 all-time.
- When playing as the No. 4-ranked team (AP poll), Duke is now 83-15.
- Duke improved to 220-142 (.608) when facing a ranked team under Coach K (3-0 this season).
- Duke has sold out 429 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 998. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
