



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. Pitt



January 20, 2018 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,015-273 in his 38th season. His overall record is 1,088-332 in this, his 43rd season.
- The Blue Devils are 91-28 when playing as the No. 5-ranked team, and improved to 550-94 all-time when playing as a top-5 ranked team.
- Duke has scored 80+ points in 15 consecutive games, which is the third-longest streak in team history.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,003. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Duke has sold out 431 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Duke completed the season sweep of Pitt and is now 11-7 versus the Panthers all-time, including a 5-1 mark since Pitt joined the ACC.
- Freshman **Wendell Carter, Jr.** has scored in double-figures in nine straight games. It was his third 20-point effort, finishing with 21 points on 9-of-10 shooting and eight rebounds.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** extended his streak of double-digit scoring to 16 games with his 20 points. It is his ACC-leading 11th 20-point effort this season.
- It is the first time this season that Carter and Bagley each scored 20+ points in the same game.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, has scored in double-figures in nine straight games with 17 points on 5-of-7 shooting from three-point range. He is 17-of-23 from three-point range (.739) over Duke's last three games.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** scored 16 points, which included four three-pointers. His 238 career three-pointers lead all active ACC players and moved him to eighth on Duke's career list, surpassing **Quinn Cook** (236).
- Duke is now 64-15 when Allen scores in double figures.
