



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Wake Forest



January 23, 2018 // LJV Coliseum // Winston-Salem, N.C.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,016-273 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,089-332 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke is now 551-94 all-time when playing as a top-5 ranked team.
- Duke has scored 80+ points in 16 consecutive games, which is the third-longest streak in team history.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,004. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Duke completed the season sweep of Wake Forest and is now 171-78 versus the Demon Deacons all-time, including a 49-39 mark in road games. Duke's eight-game winning streak in the series is the team's second-longest active ACC winning streak (Georgia Tech, 10).
- Freshman **Wendell Carter, Jr.** recorded his second consecutive 20-point effort (third this season) and recorded his ninth double-double with a game-high 23 points and 12 rebounds.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** also had a double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds, his 16<sup>th</sup> double-double this season, which are second-most in the NCAA.
- It marks the 10<sup>th</sup> time this season that multiple freshmen have recorded a double-double in the same game. That happened just three times at Duke before this season.
- Of Duke's 28 double-doubles this season, 27 have come from freshmen which extends a school record.
- Duke's 28 double-doubles are the second-most by a Coach K team, trailing only the 29 by the 1989-90 squad.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, has scored in double-figures in 10 straight games with 19 points. He is 19-of-28 from three-point range (.679) over Duke's last four games.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** scored 17 points, along with six assists, four rebounds and three steals.
- Duke is now 65-15 when Allen scores in double figures.
