



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Notre Dame



January 29, 2018 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,017-274 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,090-333 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke is now 552-95 all-time when playing as a top-5 ranked team.
- Tonight's game marked the 20<sup>th</sup> time in 22 games that Duke has scored 80+ points.
- Duke is now 23-7 all-time versus Notre Dame (8-1 in home games).
- When facing former assistant coaches, **Mike Krzyzewski** is now 24-5 in those games. Notre Dame's **Mike Brey** was an assistant under Coach K at Duke from 1988-95.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,006. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Duke has sold out 433 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Five Duke players reached double-digit points in the game -- it is the sixth time this season that has happened. Duke is 5-1 in those games.
- Freshman guard **Gary Trent, Jr.** recorded his first career double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds. It was the 30<sup>th</sup> double-double by a Duke freshman this season, which extends a school record.
- Trent was 6-of-10 from three-point range - the fourth time this season he has matched Duke's freshman record for most three-point field goals in a game.
- Trent has made 45 of his last 87 three-point attempts (.517).
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** extended his streak of double-digit scoring to 18 games with his 12 points.
- Sophomore **Jack White** came off the bench to record a career-high seven rebounds and matched his career-high with five points.
