



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. St. John's



February 3, 2018 // Madison Square Garden // New York, N.Y.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski's** record at Duke is now 1,017-275 in his 38th season. His overall record is 1,090-334 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke is now 552-96 all-time when playing as a top-5 ranked team.
- The game was Coach K's 40th coaching at Madison Square Garden and Duke is now 29-11 in MSG under Coach K.
- Duke is 34-19 all-time playing at Madison Square Garden.
- Duke is now 16-7 all-time versus St. John's (6-4 in games played in New York).
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,007. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- **Wendell Carter, Jr.** recorded his 11th double-double of the season with 14 points and a game-high 15 rebounds. He has recorded five double-doubles in the last seven games.
- Duke's freshmen have 31 of the team's 32 double-doubles this season to extend a team record.
- Freshman guard **Gary Trent, Jr.** was 5-for-7 from three-point range - the fifth time in the last seven games that he has made four or more threes in a game. Trent has made 50 of his last 94 three-point attempts (.532).
- With 65, Trent has made the fourth-most threes in a season by a Duke freshman. **Jason Williams'** 73 are third-most (2000).
- Trent's .448 three-point shooting percentage this season leads all NCAA freshmen.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** scored 19 points to extend his streak of double-digit scoring to 20 games - it is the second-longest active streak in the ACC (31, Bonzie Colson).
