

Duke Postgame Notes Duke vs. North Carolina

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,017-276 in his 38th season. His overall record is 1,090-335 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke is now 110-136 in the series versus North Carolina, including 45-41 under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,008. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Duke's 49 points in the first half were its second-most in the first half of an ACC game this season (50 at Pitt, Jan. 10).
- Freshman Marvin Bagley III recorded his 18th double-double, which extends Duke's freshman record for double-doubles in a season.
- Bagley finished with 15 points and 16 rebounds to extend his streak of double-digit scoring to 21 games it is the second-longest active streak in the ACC (31, Bonzie Colson).
- Duke's freshmen have 32 of the team's 33 double-doubles this season to extend a team record.
- Bagley matched a career-high with four assists (4 vs. Evansville, Dec. 20, 2017).
- Freshman **Gary Trent Jr.**, scored a team-high 16 points, his 13th double-digit game in the last 14. He has 18 double-digit scoring games this season.
