



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Georgia Tech



February 11, 2018 // McCamish Pavilion // Atlanta, Ga.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,018-276 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,091-335 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke won its 20<sup>th</sup> game, extending its streak of 20-win season to 22. It is the 53<sup>rd</sup> 20-win season in Duke's 113 seasons.
- Duke is now 72-23 in the series versus Georgia Tech and has won 11 straight games in the series - its longest active ACC winning streak.
- Duke has scored 80+ points in 21 of 25 games this season.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,009. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** scored a team-high 23 points - his sixth 20-point game this season (Duke is 6-0 when he scores 20+) and the 36<sup>th</sup> of his career (30-6).
- Freshman **Wendell Carter, Jr.**, has recorded his 12th double-double this season -- six of them have come over Duke's last nine games. Carter finished with 19 points and 10 rebounds.
- Carter has scored in double figures in 16 consecutive games.
- Carter had a streak of 16 consecutive made free throws snapped in the game, which dated back to the Notre Dame game.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, finished with 15 points - his 14<sup>th</sup> double-figure game in the last 15.
- Trent has made at least one three-pointer in 16 straight games.
- Trent was 2-for-2 from three-point range, and has made 15 of his last 24, and 54 of his last 101.
- Freshman **Trevon Duval** tied a career high with five rebounds (five at Miami).
- Sophomore **Marques Bolden** played a career-high 25 minutes and scored eight points with six rebounds. Since returning four games ago from a knee injury, Bolden is 10-of-13 from the field has scored 20 points with 17 rebounds.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** missed the game with a mild sprain in his right knee.
