



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Virginia Tech



February 14, 2018 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,019-276 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,092-335 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke is now 46-9 in the series versus Virginia Tech, including 20-1 at home.
- Duke's 52 points allowed matched its fewest allowed in an ACC game this season (87-52 at Pitt), and also matched the fewest scored by Virginia Tech this season (78-52 loss vs. Virginia).
- Duke improved to 20-11 all-time when playing on Valentine's Day (8-1 under Coach K) and has won eight straight.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,010. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Duke has sold out 434 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Duke was 15-of-33 from three-point range, setting an ACC season-high for the Blue Devils, and the second-most in a game this season (16 vs. Evansville).
- Senior **Grayson Allen** scored a game-high 25 points - his second straight 20-point, his seventh this season (7-0) and 37<sup>th</sup> of his career (31-6).
- Allen surpassed 1,800 career points in the win, becoming just the 20<sup>th</sup> player in Duke history to reach the 1,800-career point mark. His career total is now 1,814 points.
- The win was Allen's 56<sup>th</sup> career at Cameron Indoor Stadium (56-6), which puts him 17<sup>th</sup> on Duke's all-time list for career wins at Cameron.
- Allen was 7-of-15 from three-point ranging, matching his career-high for most made threes (set three previous times; last vs. Michigan State on Nov. 14, 2017).
- Freshman **Wendell Carter, Jr.**, has recorded his 13th double-double this season -- seven of them have come over Duke's last 10 games. Carter finished with 13 points and 13 rebounds.
- Carter has scored in double figures in 17 consecutive games.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, finished with 19 points - his 15<sup>th</sup> double-figure game in the last 16.
- Trent has made at least one three-pointer in 17 straight games.
- Trent was 5-for-9 from three-point range, and has made 20 of his last 33, and 59 of his last 110.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** missed his second straight game with a mild sprain in his right knee.
