



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Louisville



February 21, 2018 // Cameron Indoor Stadium // Durham, N.C.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,021-276 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,094-335 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke is now 9-6 in the series versus Louisville, including 3-1 at home.
- Duke held Louisville to a season-low 56 points in the 82-56 win.
- Duke has held three consecutive ACC opponents to less than 60 points. It is the first time that has happened since Coach K's first season (1980-81), when Duke did it in five straight games.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,012. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Duke had a season-high 14 dunks in the game. The previous high of nine was set on five occasions.
- Duke has sold out 435 consecutive games at Cameron Indoor Stadium, the longest current streak in both men's college basketball and the NBA.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** scored a game-high 28 points - his third 20-point game in the last four. Duke is 8-0 this season and 32-6 in his career when Allen goes for 20+.
- Allen recorded three assists in the game, and now has 127 this season. It matches his season career-high of 127 set in 2014-15.
- Freshman **Wendell Carter, Jr.**, finished with 18 points, nine rebounds, a career-high six assists, and three blocked shots. It is his 18th consecutive double-digit scoring game.
- Carter was 6/10 from the field, 1/1 from three-point range, and 5/5 at the free throw line.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, finished with 11 points - his 17<sup>th</sup> double-figure game in the last 18.
- Trent has made at least one three-pointer in 19 straight games.
- Freshman **Trevon Duval**'s five steals were one shy of his career high.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** missed his fourth straight game with a mild sprain in his right knee.
