



Duke Postgame Notes

Duke vs. Virginia Tech



February 26, 2018 // Cassell Coliseum // Blacksburg, Va.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,022-277 in his 38th season. His overall record is 1,095-336 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke is now 46-10 in the series versus Virginia Tech, including 11-7 in road games.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,014. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** finished with a game-high 22 points with six rebounds, three assists, and three steals. It was his ninth 20-point game this season (8-1), his fourth in the last six games, and the 39th of his career (32-7).
- Allen now has 1,889 career points, moving him to 18th on Duke's all-time list past **Jeff Mullins**' 1,884 (1962-64) and **Dick Groat**'s 1,886 (1950-52).
- Allen made four three-pointers and now has 268 in his career, moving him to fifth all-time at Duke past **Kyle Singler**'s 267 (2008-11).
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** scored 12 points, his 23rd consecutive double-figure scoring game.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, has made at least one three-pointer in 21 consecutive games.
