## Duke vs. Notre Dame



New York Life ACC Tournament Quarterfinals

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski's** record at Duke is now 1,024-277 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,097-336 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season. In the ACC Tournament, Coach K is 62-22.
- Duke is now 24-7 in the series versus Notre Dame, including 17-6 under Coach K.
- Duke's record in the ACC Tournament is now 100-44, including a 42-19 mark in the quarterfinals and a 28-11 record when playing as the No. 2-seed.
- Duke's 100 wins in the ACC Tournament are the most in league history - North Carolina entered tonight with an ACC Tournament record of 98-45.
- This is the fourth consecutive season that Duke and Notre Dame have met in the ACC Tournament, Duke has won three of the four meetings.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,016. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** recorded his 20<sup>th</sup> double-double and his 25<sup>th</sup> consecutive double-figure scoring game with 33 points and 17 rebounds on 15-of-23 shooting from the field.
- Bagley becomes the seventh player in Duke history to record 20+ double-doubles in a season and the first since **Shelden Williams** had 21 in 2006. The Duke record is 24 double-doubles by Mike Lewis in 1968.
- Tonight was Bagley's seventh 30-point game, which extends his ACC freshman record.
- Bagley's 15 field goals were a career high and set a Duke ACC Tournament record, surpassing the 14 field goals by **Bob Verga** versus Virginia in the 1967 quarterfinals.
- Bagley's 33 points were the most by a Duke player in the ACC Tournament since **J.J. Redick's** 35 versus NC State in the 2005 semifinals.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** finished with 23 points, three assists, three rebounds, and one steal. He was 7-of-10 from the field, including 5-of-6 from three-point range.
- Allen has 1,927 career points, moving him into 16<sup>th</sup> on Duke's all-time scoring list past **Grant Hill's** 1,924 points and **Nolan Smith's** 1,911.
- Allen made five three-pointers and now has 275 in his career, which stand fifth on Duke's all-time list.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, hit one three-pointer and now has made at least one three-pointer in 24 consecutive games.
- Freshman **Trevon Duval** finished with 11 assists. His most in a game since 11 vs. St. Francis (Pa.) on Dec. 5.
- Duval now has 175 this season, moving him to fifth for most assists by a Duke freshman, surpassing the 174 by **Chris Duhon** in 2001.
- Sophomore Marques Bolden finished with eight points and seven rebounds on 4-of-5 shooting from the field. Bolden has made 24 of his last 31 from the field.
