2018 NCAA Tournament First Round

March 15, 2018 // PPG Paints Arena // Pittsburgh, Pa.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,025-278 in his 38th season. His overall record is 1,098-337 in this, his 43rd season.
- Duke is making its 42nd appearance in the NCAA Tournament and is now 109-36 (.752) all-time in the tournament, the winning percentage being the highest in the history of the tournament, while the number of wins are third-most.
- Under Coach K, Duke is in the NCAA Tournament for the 34th time (23rd-consecutive) and is now 92-28 (.767) in the tournament under Coach K. Among all coaches, Coach K's 92 tournament wins are the most and his winning percentage is second to John Wooden's .825.
- Duke is now 28-10 all-time when playing as the No. 2-seed in the tournament, and is 14-5 in Midwest Region games.
- Duke is 28-4 in NCAA First Round game since 1985.
- Duke scored 53 points in the first half, tied for its third-most in a half in its NCAA Tournament history.
- Duke will play No. 7-seed Rhode Island in the NCAA Tournament Second Round on Saturday. The Blue Devils are 2-0 versus the Rams in the NCAA Tournament.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,018. It is the nation's fourth-longest active streak.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** finished with a game-high 22 points, his 27th consecutive double-figure scoring game. Bagley was 10-of-14 from the field and had seven rebounds.
- Since shooting 4-of-11 in the first half of the ACC quarterfinal game versus Notre Dame, Bagley has made 28 of his last 39 shots.
- Bagley finished the game with four dunks. His 89 this season are a Duke single-season record (previous: 87 by Mason Plumlee 2013).
- Senior **Grayson Allen** finished with 16 points and his nine assists were an NCAA Tournament career-high for the senior. His previous NCAA Tournament career-high was five versus UNC Wilmington in the 2016 First Round.
- Allen has 1,959 career points and is 15th on Duke's all-time scoring list.
- Allen made four three-pointers and now has 283 in his career, which stand fifth on Duke's all-time list.
- Freshman **Trevon Duval** finished with 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting and a career-best four three points (on five attempts). The 19 were his most points since a career-high 22 vs. Portland State (Nov. 23).
- Duval finished with eight assists and his 190 this season are the fourth-most by a Duke freshman.
- Duval has 32 assists over Duke's last four games.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, hit four three-pointers and now has made at least one three-pointer in 26 consecutive games.
