



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Syracuse



2018 NCAA Tournament Midwest Regional Semifinal  
March 23, 2018 // CenturyLink Center // Omaha, Neb.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski's** record at Duke is now 1,027-278 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,100-337 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke is making its 42<sup>nd</sup> appearance in the NCAA Tournament and is now 111-36 (.756) all-time in the tournament, the winning percentage being the highest in the history of the tournament, while the number of wins are third-most.
- Under Coach K, Duke is in the NCAA Tournament for the 34<sup>th</sup> time (23<sup>rd</sup>-consecutive) and is now 94-28 (.770) in the tournament under Coach K. Among all coaches, Coach K's 94 tournament wins are the most and his winning percentage is second to John Wooden's .825.
- Duke made its 26<sup>th</sup> all-time appearance in the Sweet 16, which are second-most all-time. The Blue Devils' 16 appearances since 1998 are the most by any school.
- The 24<sup>th</sup> Sweet 16 appearance for Coach K are the most of any coach.
- Duke is now 17-9 when playing in the Sweet 16 (since 1975). Under Coach K, Duke is 17-7 in the Sweet 16.
- Duke will make its 21<sup>st</sup> all-time appearance in the Elite Eight on Sunday (fourth-most in history) where it will face No. 1-seed Kansas.
- Duke is 3-2 versus Kansas in NCAA Tournament games, last facing the Jayhawks in the 2003 West Regional Semifinal in Anaheim, Calif. -- a 69-65 Kansas victory.
- Duke is now 30-10 all-time when playing as the No. 2-seed in the tournament, and is 16-5 in Midwest Region games.
- Duke is now 7-5 all-time versus Syracuse, including 3-0 in NCAA Tournament games.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,020. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** finished with a game-high 22 points, his 29<sup>th</sup> consecutive double-figure scoring game.
- Bagley has scored 22 points in each of Duke's three NCAA Tournament games.
- Bagley broke Duke's freshman scoring record in the game, with 678 points this season. The previous record of 670 was set by Jabari Parker in 2014.
- Freshman **Wendell Carter, Jr.** recorded his 16<sup>th</sup> double-double this season, the second-most by a freshman at Duke. Bagley's 21 are the Duke freshman record.
- The 41 double-doubles by Duke as a team have tied the school record set by the 1968-69 team.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** finished with 15 points. His 1,984 career points rank tied for 12<sup>th</sup> on Duke's all-time scoring list with **Art Heyman** (1961-63) and **Shane Battier** (1998-01).
- Allen needs 16 points to become Duke's 12<sup>th</sup> all-time 2,000-point scorer.
- Allen made three three-pointers and now has 289 in his career, which stand fifth on Duke's all-time list.
- Allen had eight assists, the second-best assist game in his NCAA Tournament career (nine vs. Iona in the 2018 First Round). Allen has 20 assists through Duke's first three tournament games this season.
- Freshman **Trevon Duval** finished with four assists, and his 201 assists this season are the fourth-most by a Duke freshman.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, hit two three-pointers and now has made at least one three-pointer in 28 consecutive games.
- Trent's 95 three-point field goals this season have tied the Duke freshman record of 95 set by **J.J. Redick** in 2003.
