



# Duke Postgame Notes

## Duke vs. Kansas



2018 NCAA Tournament Midwest Regional Final  
March 25, 2018 // CenturyLink Center // Omaha, Neb.

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,027-279 in his 38<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,100-338 in this, his 43<sup>rd</sup> season.
- Duke made its 42<sup>nd</sup> appearance in the NCAA Tournament and is now 111-37 (.750) all-time in the tournament, the winning percentage being the highest in the history of the tournament (min. 20 games), while the number of wins are third-most.
- Under Coach K, Duke was in the NCAA Tournament for the 34th time (23rd-consecutive) and is now 94-29 (.764) in the tournament under Coach K. Among all coaches, Coach K's 94 tournament wins are the most and his winning percentage is second to John Wooden's .825.
- Tonight was Duke's 21<sup>st</sup> appearance in the Elite Eight, and the Blue Devils are now 15-6 in the Elite Eight.
- Under Coach K, it was Duke's 15<sup>th</sup> Elite Eight appearance, and Duke's record is now 12-3.
- Duke is now 30-11 all-time when playing as the No. 2-seed in the tournament, and is 16-6 in Midwest Region games.
- Duke is now 9-7 in the NCAA Tournament when playing against a No.1-seed.
- Duke is now 7-5 all-time versus Kansas, including 3-3 in NCAA Tournament games.
- For the second time in this NCAA Tournament, all five Duke starters scored in double figures.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,021. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Freshman **Trevon Duval** finished with a team-high 20 points with six assists and two steals. He was two points shy of the career high 22 he scored versus Portland State.
- Freshman **Marvin Bagley III** had 16 points and 10 rebounds for his 22<sup>nd</sup> double-double this season, which extends Duke's freshman record.
- As a team, Duke has recorded 42 double-doubles to break the single-season record record set by the 1968-69 team.
- Senior **Grayson Allen** scored 12 points and finished his Duke career with 1,996 points to rank 12<sup>th</sup> on Duke's all-time scoring list.
- Allen finished his career with 291 three pointers, to rank fifth on Duke's all-time list.
- Freshman **Gary Trent, Jr.**, hit two three-pointers and finished with 17 points. Has made at least one three-pointer in 29 consecutive games.
- Trent's 97 three-point field goals are the Duke freshman record, surpassing the 95 by **J.J. Redick** in 2003.
