Duke (16-13) vs. Ole Miss (14-12)

• Duke (16-13) makes its second consecutive NCAA Team Championship appearance after missing the field in 2016. This will be the Blue Devils' 27th overall appearance in the main event and 26th showing in the last 27 seasons.

• The Blue Devils play their first match of the event Saturday, May 12, against Ole Miss (14-12) at 1 p.m. ET inside the Taube Family Tennis Stadium in Palo Alto, Calif.

• No. 4 Stanford, the No. 4 seed for the NCAA Team Championship, is serving as the host for the first and second rounds.

• Should Duke defeat the Rebels on Saturday, it would take on the winner of the Stanford versus New Mexico State match Sunday at 5 p.m. ET.

• Two weekend wins for the Blue Devils would put them back in North Carolina for the duration of the event as Wake Forest is serving as the host for the NCAA Team Championship Round of 16 through the title match.

• Duke holds a 4-2 advantage in the all-time series with Ole Miss, last winning 4-0 on February 15, 2015, at the ITA National Team Indoor Championship. The Rebels won the only NCAA Team Championship meeting, in 2003.

• Duke positioned itself for the NCAA Team Championship appearance by facing 10 top-25 opponents this season.

• The Blue Devils enter the NCAA event with a 10-7 record in nonconference matches this season.

• Duke faced 16 teams in the regular season that qualified for the NCAA Team Championship, playing 19 matches against them and going 7-12 in those contests.

• Of Duke's 13 losses, nine were to teams that are nationally seeded in the NCAA Team Championship.

• Of Duke's 13 losses, 12 came to NCAA Team Championship participants, six to teams currently in the top 10 and eight to teams within the top 11.

• The Blue Devils made a return to the ITA National Team Indoor Championship in February after not qualifying for the premier indoor event since 2015.

• Duke has been led by redshirt junior **Nicolas Alvarez**, who has played on the top court all season. The first team All-ACC pick enters the event ranked No. 19 nationally.

• Duke finished the year with a 9-4 home record, but excelled outdoors in Durham, going 6-0 in Ambler Tennis Stadium.

• The Blue Devils own a 4-4 neutral site record, going 2-0 at the ITA Kick-Off Weekend in Fort Worth, Texas, 1-2 at the ITA National Team Indoor Championships in Seattle, 0-1 against TCU at Lake Nona, Fla., and 1-1 at the ACC Championship in Cary, N.C., advancing to the quarterfinals.

• In the last six years, Duke has played to a 9-5 (.643 winning percentage) record during May.

Noting the Blue Devils

Versus Ole Miss ...

Duke owns a 4-2 advantage in the all-time series with the last meeting a 4-0 Duke victory on February 15, 2015, at the ITA National Team Indoor Championship in Chicago. Of the six meetings, five have taken place on neutral courts.

During the 2015 match, **Nicolas Alvarez** was the only current member of the team to participate as he won the court one doubles match with **Raphael Hemmeler** against No. 55 Gustav Hansson and William Kallberg, 6-4, and went unfinished in his No. 1 singles match against No. 59 Nicholas Scholtz.

Taking on the Cardinal ...

Stanford owns a 7-2 advantage in the all-time series, but Duke won the last meeting, 4-1 on May 9, 2015, in the NCAA Team Championship Round of 32. This will mark Duke's second trip to Palo Alto after playing there in 2006.

In the 2015 match, Stanford took the doubles point but the Blue Devils rallied with singles victories on courts one, four, three and six for the victory. **Alvarez** lost his doubles match on court one to No. 9 John Morrissey and Robert Stineman but rebounded in singles to even the match at 1-1 with a victory versus No. 26 Tom Fawcett 6-4, 6-0 on court one.

Against New Mexico State ...

A potential second round matchup would be the first between Duke and New Mexico State.

Another NCAA Team Championship Appearance ...

Duke is back in the NCAA event for the second-straight year after missing the 2016 event. The Blue Devils have qualified for the tournament in 26 of the last 27 seasons.

How We Got Here ...

New Mexico State received the Western Athletic Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Team Championship with a 4-0 victory against top-seeded Kansas City.

Stanford, Ole Miss and Duke all received at-large bids to the NCAA's main event.

Duke Against the SEC, Pac-12 and WAC ...

Entering this weekend's NCAA Team Championship action, the Blue Devils own a combined record of 104-93 against SEC clubs, 19-37 versus Pac-12 programs and have never faced a current Western Athletic Conference member.

Strength in Numbers ...

Duke is one of nine ACC teams to receive a bid to the NCAA Team Championship, joining top-seeded Wake Forest, No. 7 seed North Carolina, No. 12 seed Florida State, Miami, N.C. State, Notre Dame, Virginia and Virginia Tech. The nine clubs trail only 10 selections by the SEC.

We've Met in May Before ...

Duke has previously faced Ole Miss and Stanford in NCAA Team Championship action, going a combined 1-5 in those NCAA events. A closer look:

Alvarez to NCAA Singles Tournament ...

Redshirt junior **Nicolas Alvarez** will represent Duke at the NCAA Singles Tournament for the third time in his career. He is one of 64 individuals who will participate and one of 49 at-large selections.

Alvarez is 14-8 this season and 9-6 in dual matches, all on court one. The Lima, Peru, native has a 7-5 mark against top-100 opponents and owns an upset of the nation's No. 1 player with a 6-3, 6-4 victory against North Carolina's William Blumberg on March 9. Alvarez is the eighth Blue Devil in program history to be selected to three or more NCAA Singles Tournaments. A closer look:

Clinchers for Mateas ...

Junior **Catalin Mateas** leads the Blue Devils with four matches clinched this season, including one of Duke's most dramatic wins, coming back from a 3-0 deficit to defeat No. 22 Notre Dame at the ITA National Team Indoor Championship, as well as the ACC Championship second round win.

Mateas has secured victories versus Kentucky, No. 22 Notre Dame, Virginia Tech and Clemson in the postseason contest.

The Doubles Point a Good Indicator of the End Result ...

Duke has won the doubles point 18 times during its 29 matches, including six of its last eight contests. In the 18 matches Duke has taken the early lead, the Blue Devils own a 14-4 record (.778 winning percentage). At the ACC Championship, Duke won both of its doubles points, against Clemson and No. 11 Florida State.

Wins on Court Three in Doubles ...

Part of Duke's success in doubles has been due to court three, where the Blue Devils own a .720 winning percentage. The mark is a vast improvement from 2017, when Duke had a .591 winning percentage on the third doubles court. This year's .720 winning percentage from the third court is Duke's highest since 2013. Five Straight Versus Ranked Pairs ...

Redshirt junior **Nicolas Alvarez** and **Mateas** have been Duke's hottest doubles team recently, winning six consecutive matches and five straight against ranked pairs. Alvarez and Mateas debuted in the Oracle/ITA rankings on April 24 at No. 39 and enter the tournament at No. 48.

The pair is the first Duke duo to win five consecutive matches against ranked foes since **Henrique Cunha** and **Raphael Hemmeler** won 13 consecutive from March 5 through May 16, 2013.

Stachowiak Secures 25 Again ...

Sophomore **Nick Stachowiak** enters the NCAA Team Championship with 25 singles wins this year after totaling 32 as a rookie in 2016-17. The Cary, N.C., native is the first Blue Devil to have 25 or more singles wins in each of his first two seasons since **Hemmeler**, **Chris Mengel** and **Jason Tahir** all accomplished the feat in 2011-12 and 2012-13.

Stachowiak and Lapidus Receive Team Honors ...

Before NCAA Team Championship action began, the Blue Devils selected sophomore **Nick Stachowiak** as their Charles Hamilton Hargrave Most Valuable Player for the 2017-18 campaign. The team also presented the second annual Robert C. Taylor Leadership Award to junior **Jason Lapidus**.

Another Road Challenge for Duke ...

Playing ranked opponents outside of Durham is nothing new for this year's squad. The Blue Devils had eight true road matches during the regular season plus eight neutral site contests.

The Blue Devils went 3-5 on the road with a 5-2 victory at Arizona State on January 13 to open the season, a 6-1 win at No. 16 N.C. State on March 16 and a 7-0 triumph at Boston College on March 25.

A Strong Return ...

With a 2-5 record through his first seven dual match decisions, sophomore **Robert Levine** was taken out of the lineup for nearly a month with just one day of competition from February 18 through March 15. Levine came back strong in his return to the regular lineup, going 7-1 in his next eight decisions.

Levine finished the ACC season with a team-best seven victories and 7-3 record. The campaign was a turnaround from 2017, when he went just 1-5 in ACC competition.

A Davis Cup Break ...

Alvarez missed the weekend of April 6-8 to play for his native country of Peru in Davis Cup by BNP Paribas action. Alvarez, the second-youngest player on his squad, evened the match against Mexico at 1-1 with a 6-3, 3-6, 6-4 victory against Luis Patino. With the win, Alvarez is now 5-2 in career Davis Cup action for Peru.

Three on the Top Court ...

A year after Duke rotated four players at the No. 1 singles position, the most since head coach **Ramsey Smith** took over, the Blue Devils have had three this spring. Alvarez has gone 9-6 on the top court while **Mateas** is 1-3 and **Stachowiak** is 1-0.

Four in the 50-Win Club ...

Four Blue Devils enter the NCAA Team Championship with 50 or more career singles wins with three joining the group this year. **Stachowiak**, junior **Ryan Dickerson** and **Mateas** all picked up their 50th career wins during the 2018 dual match season. A closer look:

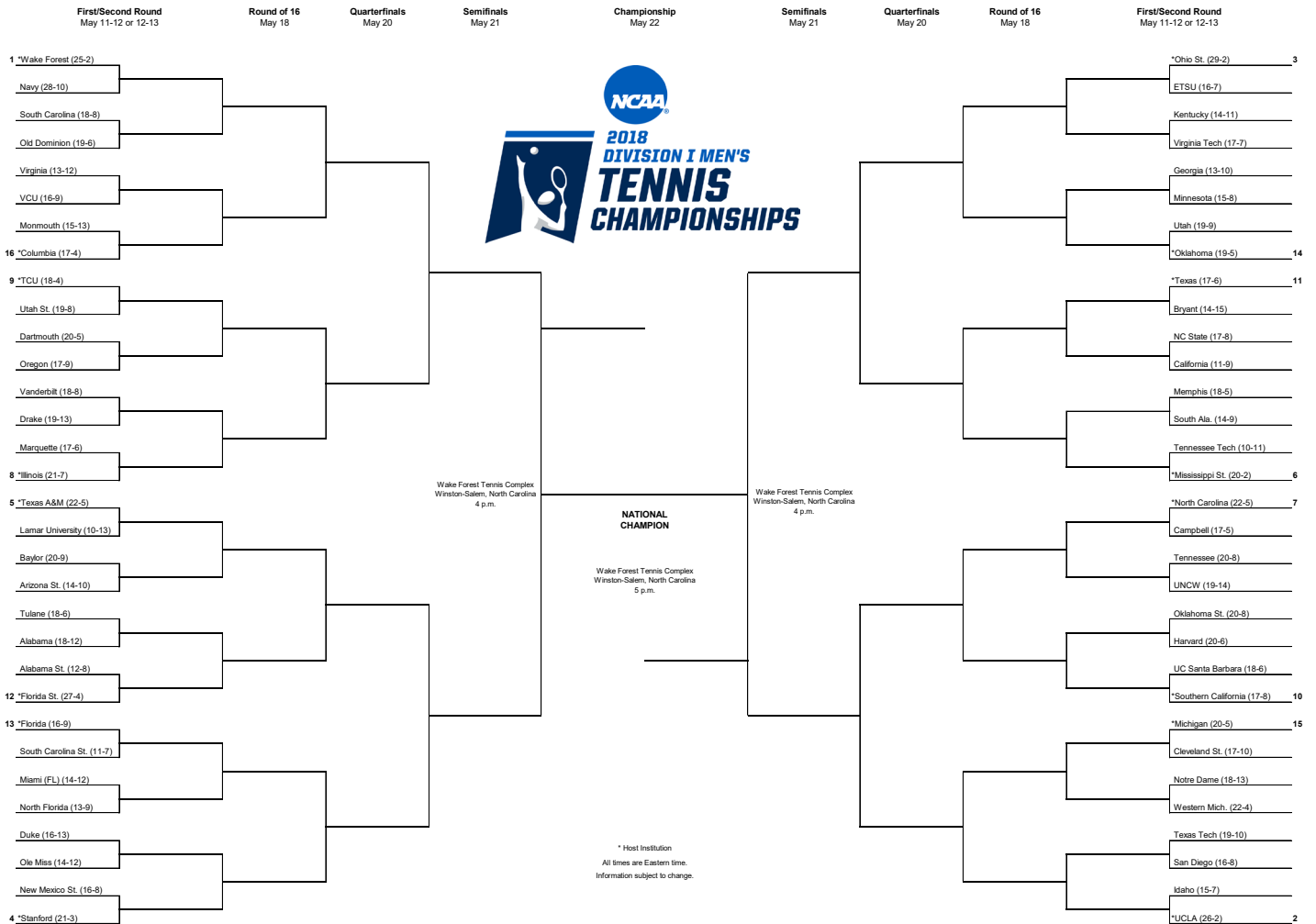
