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► DUKE AT THE NCAA EAST PRELIMINARY ROUND

SETTING THE SCENE

- With trips to the 2018 NCAA Outdoor Championships on the line, members of the Duke track & field squad will travel to Tampa, Fla., for the NCAA East Preliminary Round May 24-26.
- Competing at the University of South Florida's Track and Field Stadium, the Blue Devils will need to place among the top 12 in their respective events to advance to the national meet in June.
- All three days of action at the NCAA East Preliminary Round will feature live coverage on Flotrack.com. Thursday's broadcast will begin at 3:15 p.m. and will continue through Saturday.

RETURN TO EUGENE

- Senior Madison Heath returns to the preliminary rounds in search of qualifying for the national stage for the fourth consecutive year.
- Maddy Price and MacKenzie Kerr will be trying to reach Eugene for the third consecutive year in the 4x400m relay while India Lowe will try for a second straight year.
- Finally, Laura Marty will be trying to reach Eugene in each of her first two collegiate seasons after doing so last year.

JAVELIN AND VAULT SQUADS SHINE

- Both the men's javelin throw and women's pole vault squads have seen great success during the outdoor season as two throwers and three vaulters qualified for this weekend's competition.
- Heath enters the weekend tabbed the 3rd seed in the east following a clearance of 14-7.25 (4.45), placing her second all-time at Duke. She will be joined by Marty who is seeded 13th and Nati Sheppard who is seeded 32nd.
- For the men, Kiegan Lenihan won his first ACC title with a personal-best throw of 221-2 (67.42) to

place him third all-time at Duke. Lenihan will be seeded 21st this weekend. Competing alongside Lenihan will be Michael Marsack. Marsack is fourth all-time at Duke with a throw of 216-8 (66.03) and will be seeded 35th.

RECORD SETTING SEASON

•Five Blue Devils have etched their name atop the Duke all-time list in their respective events throughout the outdoor campaign and each are slated to compete in Lexington.

•Senior Maddy Price broke the Duke record in the 400m at the ACC Championships, finishing second with a time of 52.30. She also broke the 200m with a time of 23.20.

•Rookie Kethlin Campbell broke the 100m and 200m school records this season, although Price has since retaken the 200m record. Campbell's time in the 100m is a Duke record 11.59.

•Junior Stefani Vukajlovic rewrote the record book multiple times this season in hammer throw and ultimately tossed the implement 203-1 (61.90), setting both the school record and Bosnia-Herzegovina national record.

•In women's triple jump, Domonique Panton cleared 42-2.00 (12.85) to become the Duke all-time leader in the event.

•Graduate student Steven Solomon has seen great success during his first season as a member of the Blue Devil track & field squad and blazed to a time of 45.50 to shatter the Duke 400m record.

PRICE SETS GAZE ON NATIONAL STAGE

•Senior Maddy Price is set to compete in three different events at the regional, in the 400m, the 4x100m relay and the 4x400m relay.

•Price has experience qualifying in both the 400m and the 4x400m relay. She helped Duke's relay squad reach the 2016 and 2017 NCAA Outdoor Championships and also qualified for the 2016 edition in the individual 400m. She is coming off a silver medal in the solo quarter-mile at the ACC Championships, breaking the school record while doing so.

SOLOMON SECURES GOLD AND TRIP TO LEXINGTON

•Graduate student Steven Solomon earned his first ACC title with a first-place showing in the men's 400m competition.

•Solomon ran a Duke record in both the prelims and the final. He opened with a time of 46.57 in the heats and then followed with a time of 45.50 to claim the gold medal. Solomon will be seeded seventh in the regional, the highest Duke seed on the men's side.

BLUE DEVILS THRIVE AT PENN RELAYS

•The Penn Relays are one of the most historic track meets in the world and the 2018 edition was one of the best for the Duke Blue Devils

•The 4x400m relay team of India Lowe, MacKenzie Kerr, Brittany Aveni and Maddy Price took first place with a dramatic finish, as Price passed two teams during her final quarter-mile. It was the fifth Penn Relays title for Duke and the first since 2011.

•The men's sprint medley relay of Jacob Sobota, Miles Mingo, Steven Solomon and Matt Wisner finished in fourth place and in the process, broke the Duke record by nearly six seconds. That record had been set in 1971 and was the longest tenured Duke relay record.
