### UNDER THE HAT

•Stetson's 116 points against Johnson is the most points scored by the Hatters since a program record 143 points against St. Leo on Nov. 30, 1991

•The Hatters grabbed 66 rebounds against Johnson, the second-highest total in school history. The single-game record is 78 against Hartwick on Dec. 21, 1967

•Saturday's game at Duke is Stetson's first against an Associated Press Top 25 opponent since the Hatters visited No. 21 Notre Dame on Nov. 10, 2013 (L, 80-49).

•Sophomore forward Abayomi Iyiola is averaging 18.0 points, 9.7 rebounds and 2.8 blocked shots over the last three games. He scored a career-high 26 points in Wednesday's loss at USF.

## About the Game

- Stetson returns to what used to be a regular part of the basketball schedule on Saturday when the Hatters visit No. 3 Duke
- From 1980-90, the Hatters and Blue Devils faced each other 10 times, including four times on either neutral courts in Florida or at Stetson's Edmunds Center. The other six meetings took place at Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- Stetson junior Jahlil Rawley is a native of Durham, N.C.. He attended Kestrel Heights.
- Duke head coach Mike Krzyzewski earned his first Blue Devils' coaching victory against the Hatters on Nov. 29, 1980, a 67-49 win in Durham
- Saturday's game is being televised on ESPN2, thus marking Stetson's first regular-season national TV appearance in three years. The Hatters last played a nationally televised regular-season game when they visited Marquette in January of 2016 on FSI.

## Duke-Stetson Series

Saturday's game is the 12th meeting all-time between Duke and Stetson, in a series which began in 1917 when Duke was known as Trinity College. Duke leads, 9-2.

The Hatters and Blue Devils faced each other 10 times from 1980 to 1990, due largely to the relationship between Mike Krzyzewski and Stetson head coach and College Basketball Hall of Famer Glenn Wilkes.

The Blue Devils visited Florida four times during that decade-long series. Stetson's only win against Coach K was an 88-81 victory on Feb. 10, 1982 at Edmunds Center, still home to the Hatters today.

## Hatters vs. AP Top 25

Stetson is 2-37 all-time against Associated Press Top 25-ranked opponents.

Stetson's only victories against the Top 25 are a 67-65 win over No. 17 New Mexico on Feb. 2, 1974, and a 76-69 victory against No. 16 West Virginia on Dec. 21, 1982 in DeLand.

Stetson's last game against an AP Top 25 team came on Nov. 10, 2013 at Notre Dame (L, 49-80). Overall, the Hatters have lost 27 consecutive games to AP Top 25 opponents.

## USF Leftovers

In addition to his career-high point total, **Abayomi Iyiola** also set a career bests for blocks (4) while tying marks for field goals made (10), free throws made (6) and steals (2) ... **Christiaan Jones** enjoyed his second 20-point game of the season and third of his career. He also had a career-high 4 assists and tied a career mark with 2 steals ... **Marques Sumner** had a season-high 6 assists ... USF's 42.9 field-goal percentage was the lowest for any Stetson Division I opponent this season ... Stetson's 8 blocked shots were a season high.

## New Faces, New Places

The Hatters will have a brand new look this season after three years of familiarity.

Gone are veterans like all-time leading scorer Divine Myles, all-time assists leader Angel Rivera, and

all-time three-point shooter Luke Doyle.

Those three, and fellow seniors B.J. Glasford and Larry Dennis, accounted for 64 percent of the scoring, 52 percent of the rebounding and 83 percent of the assists.

Newcomers such as junior college transfers **Ricardo Lynch**, **Jahlil Rawley** and **Marques Sumner** will be asked to make an immediate impact, as will returning ASUN All-Freshman team selection **Abayomi Iyiola**.

Role players from a season ago like senior **Leo Goodman**, sophomores **Kenny Aninye**, **Christiaan Jones**, **Keith Matthews**, **Raine McKeython**, and **Adam Webb**, and redshirts **Clay Verk** and **Ricky Gouety** will be asked to provide a lift.

## Digging Deeper

- Stetson has made at least one 3-point field goal in each of the last 432 games after making 7 in Wednesday's loss at USF

- Stetson's last game without a trey was vs. Colorado State on Dec. 28, 2004.

- Sophomore forward **Abayomi Iyiola** is averaging 18.0 points, 9.7 rebounds and 2.8 blocked shots over the last three games. He scored a career-high 26 points in Wednesday's loss at USF.

- Iyiola is currently third in the ASUN in rebounding (8.4) and second in total blocked shots (12)

- Sophomore **Kenny Aninye** made his first career start last Friday against VMI and responded with 12 points in 34 minutes

- The Hatters will make their first national television appearance in three years on Dec. 1 when they face Duke on ESPN2. The Hatters last played a nationally televised regular-season game when they visited Marquette in January of 2016 (FSI).

- For the second time in three seasons, the Hatters have just one senior on the roster. **Leo Goodman** follows in the footsteps of Brain Pegg, who was Stetson's lone senior during the 2016-17 campaign.

- Stetson plays 21 of its 31 scheduled games in the State of Florida this season

- The Hatters will face a pair of newcomers in ASUN Conference play this season as the league welcomes both Liberty and North Alabama for the league. With the departure of USC Upstate, the ASUN now boasts nine member institutions.

nament will remain an 8-team field. Tournament play begins at the campus sites of the four highest seeds on March 4, with the championship game set for March 10.

### Iyiola Named Preseason All-ASUN; Hats Picked 8th

Stetson's **Abayomi Iyiola** was named to the ASUN Conference Men's Basketball Preseason all-conference team, the league office announced today. The Hatters were picked to finish eighth in the nine-team league both the coaches and media polls.

Iyiola, a sophomore forward, was an ASUN All-Freshman selection at the end of last season when he averaged 10.2 points and 6.2 rebounds per game while shooting 51.9 percent from the field. He scored in double figures 18 times and recoded four double-doubles, including an 18-point, 10-rebound effort in the quarterfinals of the ASUN Tournament against eventual champion Lipscomb.

Lipscomb was picked to finish first in both preseason polls, receiving seven of a possible nine first place votes. The Bisons were followed in the coaches poll by FGCU, ASUN newcomer Liberty, North Florida, Jacksonville, NJIT, Kennesaw State, Stetson and ASUN newcomer North Alabama.

Lipscomb's Garrison Matthews was chosen as the preseason player of the year, while North Florida's Noah Horchler was tabbed as the league's preseason defensive player of the year.

### ESPN+ to Carry All Home Games

Stetson Athletics continues a new and exciting chapter this season as every men's basketball home game will be carried live on ESPN+.

Stetson will produce and broadcast each event through its own Stetson Video Productions, under

the guidance Director of Broadcasting Jeff Taylor. Games are streamed on the Watch ESPN app and at WatchESPN.com. Evan Weston returns for his fourth season as the TV play-by-play voice of the Hatters. He'll be joined by a variety of color commentators throughout the season.

### About Stetson University

Stetson is located in DeLand, Fla., with a second campus in Gulfport, Fla. and two satellite centers. Founded in 1883 by Henry A. DeLand as the DeLand Academy and later renamed Stetson University to honor its benefactor, Philadelphia hat maker John B. Stetson, the university has a storied history of leadership, values and significance. The university is home to many Florida firsts, including the first collegiate newspaper, the oldest schools of business administration and music, the first college of law and the state's first private university to integrate.

## HEAD COACH COREY WILLIAMS



Corey Williams begins his sixth season as Stetson men's basketball head coach in 2018-19.

Williams was named the 21st head coach in program history on June 3, 2013 -- less than 10 weeks before the start of the school year.

"I'm excited," Williams said at the press conference announcing his hire. "To be able to lead this program means an awful lot to me and my family. I knew back when I first started out in this profession that my ambition was always to be a head coach. For Stetson University to give me this opportunity, I'm very grateful. I'm humbled, I'm grateful."

"Stetson University is privileged to be able to call Corey Williams our new men's basketball head coach,"

Stetson Director of Athletics Jeff Altier said that day. "Corey is a winner, he has worked with and played for some of the finest minds in the world of basketball and as such he understands the discipline, commitment and strategy that is needed to be successful. Everywhere Corey has played or coached his teams have won and won big, and I am excited to have him as a part of the Stetson team."

In 2017-18, the Hatters made history as several players broke long-standing records. Senior Divine Myles became the program's all-time leading scorer. Angel Rivera eclipsed to previous standard for career assists, and Luke Doyle established a new school mark for career three-pointers.

The 2016-17 season was another step for the Hatters as Williams continues his efforts to rebuild the program. The campaign saw three players -- Divine Myles, Derick Newton and Brian Pegg -- each eclipse the 1,000-point mark in career scoring. Newton was named 2nd-team All-ASUN and Pegg was honored as the ASUN Scholar-Athlete of the Year for men's basketball.

At the end of the 2015-16 season, Williams' efforts finally began to pay off. The Hatters closed the regular season with a thrilling 80-73 win over conference foe FGCU, then steamrolled their way to a pair of Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament victories to reach the tournament finals for the first time since 1994.

With a championship on the line, Williams guided a senior-less roster to within a basket of winning the title as the Hatters lost 80-78 in overtime at FGCU.

Williams' third season got off to a rough start as one of the nation's youngest rosters struggled to gel, but there were some bright spots: a come-from-behind win at FIU in November; another tough road win at Kennesaw State in early January; and an impressive near-comeback at Marquette on national television the same month gave fans and Williams an idea that more was on the way.

With freshman Derick Newton and junior Brian Pegg leading the way the Hatters became a post-season force. Pegg led the A-Sun in rebounding and Newton rewrote Stetson's freshman record book on his way to earning Freshman All-America and A-Sun Freshman of the Year honors.

In his second season roaming the sidelines at the Edmunds Center, Williams guided one of the youngest teams in the country to a second straight Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament appearance. With a lineup regularly featuring two or even three freshmen, Williams kept the Hatters competitive throughout the 2014-15 season while also laying the foundation for a strong future.

The young talent that season was evident. Guards Grant Lozoya and Divine Myles earned spots on the A-Sun's All-Freshmen teams, while fellow freshman Angel Rivera set the program's record for assists by a freshman with 120. He and Myles also became the first teammates, regardless of class, to each record 100 assists in the same season.

After opening his rookie coaching season with eight consecutive games away from home, Williams earned his first career head coaching victory with a 56-52 win over Volusia County rival Bethune-Cookman on Dec. 3, 2013 in DeLand. The Hatters struggled throughout the year, however, and finished the season with a 7-24 mark.

Williams has been blessed throughout his basketball playing and coaching career to be surrounded by and learn from some of the finest minds in the game, including Phil Jackson, Eddie Sutton, Bill Self and Leonard Hamilton.

A native of Macon, Ga., Williams played point guard at Oklahoma State. He had a lengthy career as a professional player, spending his rookie season in the NBA with the Chicago Bulls where he was a part of the 1993 NBA Championship team, before starting

his coaching career.

Prior to taking the reins at Stetson, Williams spent six seasons as an assistant at Florida State. His career with the Seminoles coincided with the team's winningest five-year period, beginning in 2007-08. During this time the team won its first ACC Championship, enjoyed a school-record run of four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, four consecutive years of double digit wins in ACC play, produced five NBA Draft picks, recorded 16 wins over nationally ranked teams and appeared in the national rankings in four straight seasons.

Williams assisted in the development of the Seminoles into one of the best programs in the ACC with the perseverance that has also made him one of the nation's top recruiters. He was instrumental in Florida State's run to the 2011 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 as well as the 2012 ACC Championship.

Before joining the Florida State staff, Williams was an assistant coach for seven seasons at Oral Roberts where he aided the Golden Eagles in achieving an average of 18 wins per season, including 20 or more wins in each of his last three seasons in Tulsa. ORU captured the Mid-Continent Conference regular season and tournament titles in 2006 and 2007, advancing to play in the NCAA Tournament each season. The 2006-07 squad not only finished with a 23-11 record, but the Golden Eagles also stunned the college basketball world when they defeated then-No. 3 Kansas, 78-71, in an early-season game at legendary Allen Fieldhouse.

Williams played collegiately at Oklahoma State from 1989-1992. He finished his career eighth on OSU's career scoring charts with 1,320 points. During his collegiate playing career he helped lead the Cowboys to consecutive NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearances under Coach Eddie Sutton in 1991 and 1992. The Cowboys were ranked 14th in the final Associated Press poll of the 1991 season and 10th in the final coaches' poll following the 1992 season. With Williams in Oklahoma State's line-up for 128 games during his four-year varsity career, the Cowboys ranked as one of the top teams statistically in the nation.

Following the conclusion of his collegiate career, Williams was a 2nd-round draft pick of the Chicago Bulls, but that wasn't his only professional opportunity. Despite having not played football since junior high, the Kansas City Chiefs selected Williams in the 12th round of the 1992 NFL Draft. He was the only OSU Cowboy drafted that year.

As a rookie in the NBA, Williams was a member of the Michael Jordan-led Bulls as the franchise captured its third straight NBA title. Following his one season in Chicago, Williams played parts of the next season with the Minnesota Timberwolves, while also playing for the Oklahoma City Cavalry of the CBA. He returned to Oklahoma State as a student assistant in 1994, serving as a member of the Cowboys' staff during their 1994 Final Four campaign. Williams then played and coached professionally in Taiwan, from 1995-98.

Williams, 47, earned his bachelor's degree in education from Oklahoma State in 2002. He and his wife, Nicole, have two children: Jourdan (19) and Corey, Jr. (15).
