Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

December 20, 2018 - vs. Texas Tech (Madison Square Garden)

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,038-280 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,111-339 in this, his 44th season.
- Duke made its 53rd appearance at Madison Square Garden and is now 35-18 at MSG. With 35 wins, MSG is Duke's sixth-winningest venue all-time and the winningest outside the state of North Carolina.
- Duke is now 80-31 in current NBA venues, and has won 11 of its last 13, including 2-0 this season.
- The win was Coach K's 30th at Madison Square Garden (30-11).
- The game was the first in the series versus Texas Tech.
- The game was Duke's fourth versus a top-15 ranked team this season - no team in the country has played more than three to date - and Duke improved to 3-1 in those games.
- The Blue Devils improved to 225-147 against ranked teams under Coach K, including 63-27 versus ranked non-conference teams under Coach K.
- Duke is now 956-217 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 554-101 when playing as a ranked Top 5 team under Coach K.
- Duke had 15 steals in the game, its sixth straight game with double-digit steals - tied for the second-longest streak in school history and the longest since a six-game streak in the 2000-01 season. The record is a seven-game streak in 1996-97.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,033. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Duke is now 16-7 all-time when playing on December 20.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **Tre Jones** set a career-high with six steals, which was one steal shy of Duke's freshman record for steals (seven by Shane Battier vs. Davidson in 1996-97).
- Jones had 13 points, five assists, one turnover and five rebounds in 39 minutes.
- Freshman **Zion Williamson** had his fifth double-double with 17 points and 13 rebounds in 25 minutes. It is his second straight double-double and third in four games.
- Junior **Jack White** had eight points, five rebounds, two assists, two steals and two blocks in 32 minutes.
- Junior Javin DeLaurier made both of his shots from the field and has made 13 consecutive field goals over the last four games. He's made 17-of-19 over the last five games.
