Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

January 12, 2019 - at Florida State

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski's** record at Duke is now 1,041-280 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,114-339 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 49th in the series versus Florida State, and the series now stands at 39-10 in favor of Duke, including 16-7 in Tallahassee.
- Over Duke's nine game winning streak, each opponent has been held to 78 points or fewer.
- The game was the Blue Devils' fifth season versus an AP top 15 ranked opponent - the most nationally - and Duke is now 4-1 in those games - each of the five have been played away from Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- Duke is now 226-147 versus ranked teams under Coach K.
- Duke snapped a three-game skid when playing at Florida State as the No. 1-ranked team.
- The game marked Duke's 242nd when playing as the AP No. 1-ranked team under Coach K, and Duke is now 211-31 in those games.
- All-time, Duke is now 234-36 when playing as the No. 1-ranked team.
- Duke is now 959-217 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 557-101 when playing as a ranked Top 5 team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,036. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **RJ Barrett** scored a game high 32 points, one shy of the career high 33 in the Kentucky win.
- Barrett's four three-pointers were also a career high.
- Freshman **Cam Reddish** scored 23 points, two shy of the career high 25 in the Army West Point win.
- Freshman **Zion Williamson** scored 11 points with eight rebounds in 17 minutes to snap his streak of four consecutive double-doubles. Williamson played just 17 minutes, missing the second half with an eye injury.
- Junior **Javin DeLaurier** did not attempt a field goal in the game, keeping his streak of 18 consecutive field goals alive. He is two field goal shy of tying the ACC record of 20 held by Duke's **Alaa Abdelnaby** in 1988-89.
