Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

January 19, 2019 - vs. Virginia

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,042-281 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,115-340 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was just the fourth in NCAA history between two No. 1 ranked teams. Duke was ranked No. 1 in the AP poll and Virginia was No. 1 in the Coaches poll.
- The game was Duke's NCAA-leading sixth this season versus an opponent ranked 15th or better in the AP poll, and the Blue Devils improved to 5-1 in those games.
- The 72 points were the most allowed by Virginia over the last two regular seasons, surpassing the 71 scored by Maryland in a 76-71 UVa win on Nov. 28, 2018.
- The game was the 171st in the series between Duke and Virginia, and the series now stands at 120-51 in favor of Duke.
- At Cameron Indoor Stadium, the series favors Duke, 53-9.
- Duke has won four of the last five in the series.
- The game was the 50th at Cameron Indoor Stadium involving teams each ranked in the AP top 10 - Duke is now 39-11 in those games.
- The game was the 16th at Cameron Indoor Stadium involving team each ranked in the AP top 5 - Duke is now 12-4 in those games.
- The game marked Duke's 244th when playing as the AP No. 1-ranked team under Coach K, and Duke is now 212-32 in those games.
- All-time, Duke is now 235-37 when playing as the No. 1-ranked team.
- Duke is now 960-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 558-102 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,038. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- The game was Duke's 448th consecutive sellout at Cameron Indoor Stadium, extending the longest streak in men's college basketball.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **RJ Barrett** scored a game-high 30 points with five rebounds, playing all 40 minutes. It marks his fourth career 30-point game - the second-most by a freshman in Duke history.
- Freshman **Zion Williamson** scored 27 points on 10-of-16 shooting with nine rebounds, two steals and one block in 38 minutes.
- Freshman **Cam Reddish** recorded a career-high eight rebounds. His previous high was seven vs. Army West Point.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** missed the game as he recovers from a shoulder injury suffered early in the game on January 14.
- Junior **Javin DeLaurier** has made his last 19 field goal attempts, and is one shy of tying the all-time ACC record for consecutive field goals made (20) set by Duke's **Alaa Abdelnaby** in 1988-89.
