Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

January 22, 2019 - at Pittsburgh

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,043-281 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,116-340 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 19th in the series between Duke and Pitt, and the series now stands at 12-7 in favor of Duke.
- Duke has won four straight in the series, and is now 6-3 in road games in the series.
- Duke has won four consecutive games in the city of Pittsburgh, including three games last season (at Pitt, and games in the NCAA Tournament first and second rounds).
- Duke has won its first three ACC road games for the first time since going undefeated on the road in the ACC in the 2011-12 season.
- Duke was ranked No. 2 in the AP poll this week and won its first game as the No. 2-ranked team since a 75-63 win at Wake Forest in the 2014-15 season. Duke had lost its last two games as a No. 2 team.
- Duke had two freshmen combine for 51 points - **RJ Barrett** with 26 and **Zion Williamson** with 25 - marking the 11th time this season that two Duke freshmen combined for 50+ points. That happened just three times in Duke history prior to this season.
- Duke is now 961-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 559-102 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,039. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **Zion Williamson** was 9-of-9 from the field in the first half, which marked the best shooting half by a Duke player since **Luke Kennard** was 10-of-10 in the second half at Wake Forest (1/28/17).
- Williamson finished with 25 points on 11-of-13 shooting, his 12th 20-point game this season - second-most in the ACC behind teammate **RJ Barrett** (15).
- Williamson set a career high with seven assists. His previous high was five at Wake Forest (1/8/19).
- With 25 points, 7 rebounds and 7 assists, Williamson recorded the seventh 25-7-7 game under Coach K and ninth in Duke history. With Barrett also posting a 25-7-7 game this season (versus Stetson), it marks the first time at Duke its happened twice in the same season.
- Freshman **RJ Barrett** recorded his 15th 20-point game with his game-high 26 points. It marks his ACC-leading 15th 20-point game this season.
- In 30 minutes, junior **Marques Bolden** had seven points, nine rebounds, four blocked shots and one steal.
- Bolden is averaging 6.7 rebounds in ACC play - second-most on the team behind Williamson's 9.0.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** missed his second straight game as he recovers from a shoulder injury suffered early in the game on January 14.
- Junior **Javin DeLaurier** missed his first shot of the game, snapping a streak of 19 consecutive made field goals -- one shy of tying the all-time ACC record for consecutive field goals made (20) set by Duke's **Alaa Abdelnaby** in 1988-89.
