Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

January 28, 2019 - vs. Notre Dame

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,045-281 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,118-340 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 32nd in the series between Duke and Notre Dame, with Duke leading the series 25-7.
- In games in Notre Dame, Ind., the series now favors Duke 6-4.
- Duke has now won five straight in the series.
- Duke completed the month of January with a 7-1 record, its best record in the month of January since going 7-1 in the 2008-09 season.
- Duke was 10-of-19 (.526) from three-point range, its best three-point percentage in a game this season and best since hitting 12-of-20 (.600) on January 29, 2018 versus Notre Dame and Cameron Indoor.
- Duke's .526 percentage from three-point range was its best three-point shooting performance in a road game since December 3, 2014 at Wisconsin (7-of-12, .583).
- Duke is now 125-22 all-time when playing as the No. 2-ranked team in the AP poll.
- Duke is now 963-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 561-102 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,041. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **Zion Williamson** scored a game-high 26 points, his 13th game this season reaching 20 points - the second most in the ACC this season behind teammate RJ Barrett (16).
- Williamson has nine 25-point games this season, to set a new Duke freshman record. The previous mark of eight was held by Williamson, teammate **RJ Barrett** and **Marvin Bagley III** (2017-18).
- Williamson, who was 10-of-12 from the field, finished with nine rebounds, four blocks and four assists in 33 minutes.
- It is the fifth consecutive game for Williamson scoring 22 or more points.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** finished with nine points, five assists and one turnover. In 18 games this season, Jones has just 18 turnovers and 100 assists.
- Junior **Marques Bolden** finished with eight points, seven rebounds and two blocks in 21 minutes.
