## Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

*February 2, 2019 - vs. St. John's*

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski's** record at Duke is now 1,046-281 in his 39<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,119-340 in this, his 44<sup>th</sup> season.
- The game was the 24<sup>th</sup> in the series between Duke and St. John's, with the Blue Devils leading the series 17-7.
- In games in Durham, the series now stands at 7-1 in favor of Duke.
- Duke's home non-conference winning streak now stands at 147 games - the nation's longest active streak. The Blue Devils last non-conference home loss came to St. John's on February 26, 2000 (83-82) - 6,916 days.
- Duke is now 126-22 all-time when playing as the No. 2-ranked team in the AP poll.
- Duke is now 964-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 562-102 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,042. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Duke improved to 888-160 all-time at Cameron Indoor Stadium, including 530-65 under Coach K. Duke is 11-1 at home this season.
- The game was Duke's 450<sup>th</sup> consecutive sellout at Cameron Indoor Stadium, extending the longest streak in men's college basketball.

### PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **RJ Barrett** posted his fourth double-double with 15 points and 14 rebound (two shy of career high), four assists and two steals in 33 minutes.
- Barrett is averaging 10.0 rebounds over the last six games.
- Freshman **Zion Williamson** scored a game-high 29 points, his 14<sup>th</sup> game this season reaching 20 points - the second most in the ACC this season behind teammate **RJ Barrett** (16).
- Williamson has 10 25-point games this season, to extend his Duke freshman record. The previous mark of eight was held by Williamson, teammate **RJ Barrett** and **Marvin Bagley III** (2017-18).
- Williamson, who was 13-of-17 from the field, finished with six rebounds, two blocks and a career-high tying five steals in 33 minutes.
- Over the last four games, Williamson is 43-of-54 (.796) from the field with 102 points.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** finished with 13 points, a career-high seven rebounds, seven assists and three steals in 36 minutes.
- Freshman **Cam Reddish** scored 16 points and is averaging 13.9 points over the last six games. Over the six games prior, Reddish averaged 7.7 points.
- Duke had five players in double figures for the first time since an 87-68 win over Clemson on January 5, 2019.
