- Duke is ranked second nationally and is coming off of a 17-9 season-opening victory at Furman
- Head Coach John Danowski garnered his 400th career win with the victory over the Paladins
- Wednesday's game is the second of five February games for the Blue Devils in 2019

#### THE SERIES HISTORY

- Duke and High Point are meeting for the sixth time since the Panthers became a program in 2013. The Blue Devils are 5-0 overall with an average margin of victory of just over 10 goals per game.
- In 2018, Duke defeated High Point by an 18-6 score in Durham, the second largest win margin in the five meetings.

## 3 BLUE DEVILS EARN PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA

■ JT Giles-Harris, Brad Smith and Cade Van Raaphorst garnered preseason All-America honors. Smith was a first-team choice while Giles-Harris and Van Raaphorst were voted to the second team. All three were All-Americans in 2018.

■ Duke is one of five programs to have at least three players voted to the top three teams and one of two - the other being Yale - to have three representatives on the first and second teams.

## DANOWSKI CAPTURES WIN NO. 400

■ Head coach John Danowski joined a club of one this past Saturday as he became the first Division I men's lacrosse head coach to capture 400 career wins. He is the third across all three divisions to reach the mark.

■ He etched his name at the top of the Division I men's lacrosse wins list in 2017, beating Jacksonville for his 376th career victory. Dom Starsia held the previous record of 375.

■ The Blue Devils' leader has 181 wins at Duke, 192 at Hofstra and 27 in his first stop at LIU Post.

■ Danowski, a winner of three NCAA titles, is one of four active coaches to own multiple NCAA titles. He is third among the group with three, while Bill Tierney of Denver leads the way with eight.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Joe Robertson tallied four goals and an assist and Brian Smyth won 19-of-27 faceoffs to post a 17-9 season-opening victory at Furman Saturday night. CJ Carpenter and Cameron Badour added three goals apiece, registering their first career hat tricks. Jake Seau posted his first multiple goal game and finished with a career-best four points.
- Brian Smyth won 70 percent of his restarts and picked up 14 ground balls - both of which are the second highest totals in his career. In goal, Turner Uppgren made seven saves in his first career start.

## LAST TIME WE MET

- Senior Justin Guterding posted eight points on five goals and three assists to propel No. 2 Duke to an 18-6 victory over visiting High Point last season.
- The Blue Devils led 9-2 after the first quarter and extended it to 15-4 after three periods. Joe Robertson had a hat trick. Greg Pelton scooped up eight ground balls and Danny Fowler had four saves in 30 minutes in goal.

## LOOKING AT DUKE

- Duke, the preseason No. 2 team behind reigning NCAA Champion Yale, is 1-0 on the year. The Blue Devils feature a wealth of talent both offensively and defensively, including All-Americans Brad Smith, Cade Van Raaphorst and JT Giles-Harris.
- Smith, Duke's most versatile player, is the Blue Devils' top returning scorer after registering 65 points in 2018. Sophomore Joe Robertson picked up right where he left off, tallying five points in his season opener. Seniors Sean Lowrie and CJ Carpenter and junior Joey Manown all will be crucial pieces with Robertson at attack.
- Duke's first midfield against the Paladins was Jake Seau, Kevin Quigley and Reilly Walsh. They combined for six goals and 10 points overall. Smith, upon returning to the lineup, will be the undisputed leader on that line. Sophomores Nakeie Montgomery, Cameron Badour and Garrett Leadmon rounded out the second midfield and finished with a combined four points.
- On defense, the duo of All-Americans Van Raaphorst and Giles-Harris will anchor the close defense along with senior Jack Fowler earning his first career start Saturday. Graduate student Peter Welch and junior Walker Scaglione will be the long stick middies. As short stick d-middies, John Prendergast, Terry Lindsay and Blake Leischow will bring a lot of experience to the defensive squad.
- Joe Stein and Brian Smyth are back at the X after sharing duties last season. Freshman Jordan Ginder is the newest addition to the faceoff crew.
- In goal, senior Turner Uppgren has the most experience of a young crew. Freshmen Garrett Smith and Andrew Bonafede will battle for time along with senior David McCann.

## SCOUTING HIGH POINT

- High Point comes to Durham after beating first-year program St. Bonaventure 13-0. Asher Nolting led the way with seven points, three goals and four assists, while Chris Young had four goals. Six Panthers scored goals in the victory. In 2018, Nolting became the first High Point player to record a 30-goal and 30-assist season with 30 goals and 36 helpers. He was a preseason All-America honorable mention pick by Inside Lacrosse.
- The Panthers fired 62 shots, but only connected 13 times for a .210 shot percentage. They only allowed 17 shots and forced St. Bonaventure into 33 turnovers.
- Tim Troutner Jr. led the Panthers in the cage with a 147 saves and was named Preseason All-SoCon. Junior Davis Sampere led the Panthers at the faceoff X last season with 154 wins and a .537 percentage. He led HPU and ranked third in the SoCon in ground balls at 83.

## SEAU SAVING THE BEST FOR LAST

- Jake Seau, in his fifth season with the team, is determined to make his last year his best year. Against Furman, the California native registered his first multiple goal game with two scores. His four points versus the Paladins are just one fewer than he had in 13 outings last year. He has 11 points in his career.

## BADOUR MAKES BLUE DEVIL DEBUT

- Cameron Badour left his mark in his Duke debut, throwing in three goals. The Ottawa, Canada, native scored Duke's eighth goal as the Blue Devils' started to pull away. He added another in the third quarter and the final tally of the game on man up.

## DUKE A FORCE ON OFFENSE

- Duke has proven it traditionally features one the top offenses in Division I lacrosse. The Blue Devils have been in the top 11 in scoring in each of the past 10 seasons and are expected to be one of the top point producing programs again in 2019.

## DUKE'S EXPERIENCE AT MIDFIELD

- The Blue Devils have the luxury of depth and a wealth of experience at the midfield position. Led by senior captain Brad Smith, Duke has four upperclassmen to lead the charge. Sophomore Nakeie Montgomery is back after playing on both the first and second midfield line in 19 games last season.
- Overall, Duke's collection of five midfielders who competed on the first two lines last season have combined to play 192 games.
- In addition, the Blue Devils will be buoyed by sophomore Cameron Badour, who missed last season to injury but benefited from an entire season being immersed in practice.

## MONTGOMERY LOOKING FOR BREAKTHROUGH

- Sophomore Nakeie Montgomery will look to build on his NCAA Tournament performance last season. The Dallas native came on strong in the NCAA postseason event, scoring five goals in the first three games.
- Joining the first midfield in the first-round game against Villanova, Montgomery registered his first career hat trick. A week later, he scored two goals in 60 seconds to break open Duke's one-goal lead in the fourth quarter against Johns Hopkins. On his birthday in the NCAA semifinal, Montgomery tallied another hat trick to help Duke past Maryland. He was held scoreless in the title game versus Yale.
- Prior to the NCAA Tournament, Montgomery had just six goals and two assists in 15 games. He earned a start on the first midfield for one game during the regular season.

## BRAD SMITH POINT SCORING STREAK

- Senior Brad Smith enters the 2019 season riding a 35-game point streak. His 35-game stretch started Feb. 10, 2017 and he has scored 100 points in that span. He is third among active players on the list and only one of 12 to have a point in 20 straight games.
- The next closest Blue Devil is sophomore Joe Robertson at 11 games.

## BRAD SMITH JUNIOR JUMP

- Brad Smith became a household name for the Blue Devils in 2018, scoring 65 points after totaling 53 his first two seasons combined.
- He came on a third of the way through the season, scoring 51 of his 65 points this season in the final 14 games. He averaged 2.50 points per game in the first six and 3.64 in the past 14.

## ROBERTSON LACROSSE FAMILY

- Lacrosse is a family affair for Duke sophomore Joe Robertson as he follows in the footsteps of his three older brothers to play Division I lacrosse. Matt, the oldest, played his final two seasons at Virginia. Ian was a Maryland Terrapin for three years and Phillip is a junior on the Princeton men's lacrosse team.
- Phillip finished fourth in points for the Tigers with 36. Joe had 60 points in 20 games to rank third in scoring for the Blue Devils. Both ranked nationally among the top 40 in goals per game, the top 100 in points and the top 30 in shot percentage in 2018.

## ALL IN THE FAMILY FOR GILES-HARRIS

- Preseason All-American and All-ACC choice, junior defenseman John Thomas (JT) Giles-Harris isn't the only one from his family who has made a name for himself as a Blue Devil.
- JT's brother, Joe, Duke football's top defensive player and team captain in 2018, recently declared for the NFL draft. He garnered four All-America awards in 2017, including second-team honors by the Walter Camp Foundation. Overall, he was the first Duke linkebacker with multiple first-team All-ACC accolades since 1985-86.

## VAN RAAPHORST'S ATHLETIC LINEAGE

- Junior close defenseman Cade Van Raaphorst traded the football for the lacrosse stick despite hailing from a family of elite college quarterbacks.
- Cade is the son of Jeff Van Raaphorst, quarterback at Arizona State leading the Sun Devils to the Pac-10 and Rose Bowl titles in 1987. He was inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame in 2006. Jeff also played in the NFL for a few seasons.
- Uncle, Mike Van Raaphorst, was the backup quarterback to Carson Palmer at Southern California.

## >> JOHN DANOWSKI BIO



Cemented as one of the top coaches in college lacrosse, John Danowski has led the Duke men's lacrosse team to unprecedented success and himself to the top of the Division I men's lacrosse wins list. Danowski was introduced as Duke's eighth head men's lacrosse coach on July 21, 2006, and quickly led the Blue Devils to some of the most successful lacrosse seasons in school history, to three NCAA Championships in five seasons.

In Danowski's 11 years at the helm of the Blue Devils lacrosse program, he has compiled an impressive 181-55 record in leading Duke to seven ACC regular season titles and four ACC tournament titles, eight straight appearances in the national semifinals from 2007-14, four in the NCAA title match and ultimately to the 2010, 2013 and 2014 national titles. The 2014 NCAA crown put Danowski, a winner of 400 career games, among a small group of nine coaches to win three national titles and among eight to capture consecutive crowns. Meanwhile, Duke's run of eight straight NCAA semifinals rank as the second most of any program since 2000 with Syracuse. Most recently, Danowski passed Dom Starsia as the winningest Division I lacrosse history, garnering his 376th win with a 13-6 victory over Jacksonville, March 13, 2017.

A winner of nearly 80 percent of his games at Duke, the individual awards Blue Devil players have garnered is equally impressive. In 12 seasons, Danowski mentored 69 All-America selections, 41 All-ACC choices, two Tewaaraton Trophy winners, a pair of USILA Attackman of the Year honorees, a USILA Defenseman of the Year, three USILA Midfielder of the Year award recipients and 22 USILA Scholar All-America picks.

While the success on the field is unsurpassed in Duke lacrosse history, the student-athletes excellence in the classroom also is unrivaled. The Blue Devils consistently lead the ACC in All-ACC Academic picks as well as players on the ACC Academic Honor Roll. In 2018, Duke had 37 players - nearly 79 percent of the team - achieve a 3.0 grade point average for the entire academic year, with Justin Guterding earning USILA Scholar All-America honors.

Head coach John Danowski is one of four active coaches to own multiple NCAA titles. He is third among the group with three, while Bill Tierney of Denver leads the way with eight.
