Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

February 5, 2019 - vs. Boston College

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski's** record at Duke is now 1,047-281 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,120-340 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 24th in the series between Duke and Boston College, with the Blue Devils leading the series 21-3. In games in Durham, the series now stands at 10-0 in favor of Duke.
- Duke has won 10 of the last 11 in the series.
- Duke has reached the 20-win mark for the 54th time in program history, including in 23 consecutive seasons.
- The Blue Devils improved to 8-1 in ACC play, its best start to an ACC season since beginning the 2010-11 season 12-1 in conference play.
- Duke is now 127-22 all-time when playing as the No. 2-ranked team in the AP poll.
- Duke is now 965-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 563-102 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,043. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Duke improved to 889-160 all-time at Cameron Indoor Stadium, including 531-65 under Coach K. Duke is 12-1 at home this season.
- This decade, Duke's home winning percentage of .938 (152-10) is third-best in the NCAA.
- The game was Duke's 451st consecutive sellout at Cameron Indoor Stadium, extending the longest streak in men's college basketball.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **Zion Williamson** recorded his ninth double-double with 16 points and 17 rebounds in 33 minutes. His 17 rebounds were a career high, surpassing the 16 he had versus Army West Point.
- Over the last five games, Williamson is 50-of-66 (.758) from the field with 118 points.
- Williamson added three assists, three blocks and four steals to his stat line.
- Williamson has nine steals over the last two games.
- Freshman **RJ Barrett** scored 19 points and has surpassed the 500-point mark this season. With 505 points in 22 games this season, Barrett has moved to 10th on Duke's freshman single-season scoring list.
- Freshman **Cam Reddish** scored 24 points -- one shy of his career high 25 vs. Army -- and his career high in ACC play. Reddish is averaging 15.3 points over the last seven games.
- Reddish was 4-of-4 at the free throw line, and has hit 18 consecutive free throws over the last five games.
