- Duke is coming off of a 13-9 loss to High Point in its home opener Wednesday
- Head Coach John Danowski garnered his 400th career win with the season-opening victory over Furman
- Saturday's game is the third in seven days for the Blue Devils

THE SERIES HISTORY

- Duke and Jacksonville are meeting for the ninth time since the inaugural matchup in 2010. The Blue Devils are 8-0 and defeated the Dolphins 19-8 last season. In the eight victories, Duke's average margin of victory is 8.9 goals.
- This will be Duke's third game in Jacksonville. The Blue Devils traveled to the Dolphins in Jacksonville's first season in 2010 and again in 2016.

MENTOR VS MENTEE

■ The head coaches of Saturday's matchup has a unique connection. Duke head coach John Danowski served as the U.S. Men's National Team coach this past summer at the FIL World Championships. Jacksonville leader John Galloway was the goaltender for the gold-medal winning squad.

■ Prior to coaching at Jacksonville, Galloway served as a volunteer assistant coach for Danowski and the Blue Devils and then as an assistant coach for former Duke assistant Chris Gabrielli at Providence.

LAST TIME OUT

■ High Point senior goaltender Tim Troutner Jr. made 19 saves and the Panthers outscored Duke 7-3 in the fourth quarter to upset the No. 2 Blue Devils 13-9 Wednesday night.

■ All square at 6-6 heading into the fourth quarter, Duke's Reilly Walsh gave the Blue Devils the 7-6 lead, but High Point responded in a big way with six unanswered over a span of 4:40 to ice the victory with a 12-7 lead.

■ Jake Seau continued his red-hot start to 2019 with two goals and three points. He has seven points on the season, just four shy of matching his total from the three previous seasons.

■ In goal, Turner Uppgren made 10 saves, including six in the first quarter. Brian Smyth was 13-of-25 at the faceoff and picked up six ground balls.

LAST TIME WE MET

■ Headlined by Justin Guterding's four tallies, five Blue Devils scored multiple goals as No. 2 Duke defeated visiting Jacksonville, 19-8 last season in Durham.

■ The Blue Devils led 9-2 after the first quarter and extended it to 15-4 after three periods. Joe Robertson had a hat trick. Greg Pelton scooped up eight ground balls and Danny Fowler had four saves in 30 minutes in goal.

LOOKING AT DUKE

■ Duke, the preseason No. 2 team behind reigning NCAA Champion Yale, heads to Jacksonville looking to bounce back after a loss to unranked High Point. The Blue Devils feature a wealth of experience both offensively and defensively, including All-Americans Brad Smith, Cade Van Raaphorst and JT Giles-Harris.

■ Jake Seau is Duke's top scorer with seven points, while sophomore Joe Robertson has six points. Senior Brad Smith, the Blue Devils' top returning scorer has only played a few plays after suffering a preseason injury. Joey Manown has four goals and an assist after making his season debut in the loss to High Point.

■ A member of the first midfield with Seau, Reilly Walsh has three goals and five points overall. Duke's second midfield has five points.

■ On defense, the duo of All-Americans Van Raaphorst and Giles-Harris will anchor the close defense along with senior Jack Fowler who earned his first career start against Furman. Graduate student Peter Welch and junior Walker Scaglione are the long stick middies and forces on the faceoff midfield. As short stick d-middies, John Prendergast, Terry Lindsay and Blake Leischow bring a lot of experience to the defensive squad.

■ Joe Stein and Brian Smyth are back at the X after sharing duties last season. Freshman Jordan Ginder is the newest addition to the faceoff crew.

■ In goal, senior Turner Uppgren has the most experience of a young group. After two games between the pipes, Uppgren sports an 11.28 goals against average and a .436 save percentage.

SCOUTING JACKSONVILLE

- Jacksonville is coming off of a season-opening loss at Detroit Mercy Feb. 2. The Dolphins scored three goals in the final 3:20 of the game, but couldn't complete the comeback in the 9-8 loss to the Titans.
- Bo BowHunter paced the team in scoring with three goals and four points overall. Jack Pucci dished out three assists. Senior midfielder Eric Applegate and sophomore defenseman Dixon Smith earned Southern Conference Preseason All-Conference awards. Both were 2018 all-conference honorees.
- Hunter Sells manned the goal in the opener, making 17 saves and allowing only nine goals. At the X, Hunter Turner took 17 of 21 faceoffs, winning six of them. Smith anchored the defensive effort with three caused turnovers.

3 BLUE DEVILS EARN PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA

- JT Giles-Harris, Brad Smith and Cade Van Raaphorst garnered preseason All-America honors. Smith was a first-team choice while Giles-Harris and Van Raaphorst were voted to the second team. All three were All-Americans in 2018.
- Duke is one of five programs to have at least three players voted to the top three teams and one of two - the other being Yale - to have three representatives on the first and second teams.

DANOWSKI CAPTURES WIN NO. 400

- Head coach John Danowski joined a club of one this past Saturday as he became the first Division I men's lacrosse head coach to capture 400 career wins. He is the third across all three divisions to reach the mark.
- He etched his name at the top of the Division I men's lacrosse wins list in 2017, beating Jacksonville for his 376th career victory. Dom Starsia held the previous record of 375.
- The Blue Devils' leader has 181 wins at Duke, 192 at Hofstra and 27 in his first stop at LIU Post.
- Danowski, a winner of three NCAA titles, is one of four active coaches to own multiple NCAA titles. He is third among the group with three, while Bill Tierney of Denver leads the way with eight.

- Cameron Badour left his mark in his Duke debut, throwing in three goals at Furman. The Ottawa, Canada, native scored Duke's eighth goal as the Blue Devils' started to pull away from the Paladins. He added another in the third quarter and the final tally of the game on man up.

TEAMMATES MEET AGAIN

- Former high school teammates Kevin Quigley and Jacksonville's Will Burckley will meet as foes Saturday. Both were four-year letterwinners at Ridge High School. Quigley led the Devils to the New Jersey state title as a freshman and was a four-time all-conference choice. Burckley was third on the team in scoring as a senior and helped the team to the Group 4 North semifinals the year after Quigley graduated.

DUKE A FORCE ON OFFENSE

- Duke has proven it traditionally features one the top offenses in Division I lacrosse. The Blue Devils have been in the top 11 in scoring in each of the past 10 seasons and are expected to be one of the top point producing programs again in 2019.

 ■ Duke is 46-46 when allowing 10 goals in a contest and 131-8 when holding opponents under 10 goals.

DUKE IN ONE GOAL GAMES

■ Duke is 77-72 in games decided by one goal in program history after upending North Carolina 11-10 in 2018.
 ■ Duke is 20-16 in one-goal contests since 2007 and last played a one-goal game in a season opener in the 11-10 loss to Air Force in 2017.

DUKE'S EXPERIENCE AT MIDFIELD

■ The Blue Devils have the luxury of depth and a wealth of experience at the midfield position. Led by senior captain Brad Smith, Duke has four upperclassmen to lead the charge. Sophomore Nakeie Montgomery is back after playing on both the first and second midfield line in 19 games last season.
 ■ Overall, Duke's collection of five midfielders who competed on the first two lines last season have combined to play 192 games.
 ■ In addition, the Blue Devils will be buoyed by sophomore Cameron Badour, who missed last season to injury but benefited from an entire season being immersed in practice.

MONTGOMERY LOOKING FOR BREAKTHROUGH

■ Sophomore Nakeie Montgomery will look to build on his NCAA Tournament performance last season. The Dallas native came on strong in the NCAA postseason event, scoring five goals in the first three games.

■ Joining the first midfield in the first-round game against Villanova, Montgomery registered his first career hat trick. A week later, he scored two goals in 60 seconds to break open Duke's one-goal lead in the fourth quarter against Johns Hopkins. On his birthday in the NCAA semifinal, Montgomery tallied another hat trick to help Duke past Maryland. He was held scoreless in the title game versus Yale.

■ Prior to the NCAA Tournament, Montgomery had just six goals and two assists in 15 games. He earned a start on the first midfield for one game during the regular season.

BRAD SMITH JUNIOR JUMP

■ Brad Smith became a household name for the Blue Devils in 2018, scoring 65 points after totaling 53 his first two seasons combined.

■ He came on a third of the way through the season, scoring 51 of his 65 points this season in the final 14 games. He averaged 2.50 points per game in the first six and 3.64 in the past 14.

ROBERTSON LACROSSE FAMILY

■ Lacrosse is a family affair for Duke sophomore Joe Robertson as he follows in the footsteps of his three older brothers to play Division I lacrosse. Matt, the oldest, played his final two seasons at Virginia. Ian was a Maryland Terrapin for three years and Phillip is a junior on the Princeton men's lacrosse team.

■ Phillip finished fourth in points for the Tigers with 36. Joe had 60 points in 20 games to rank third in scoring for the Blue Devils. Both ranked nationally among the top 40 in goals per game, the top 100 in points and the top 30 in shot percentage in 2018.

ALL IN THE FAMILY FOR GILES-HARRIS

■ Preseason All-American and All-ACC choice, junior defenseman John Thomas (JT) Giles-Harris isn't the only one from his family who has made a name for himself as a Blue Devil.

■ JT's brother, Joe, Duke football's top defensive player and team captain in 2018, recently declared for the NFL draft. He garnered four All-America awards in 2017, including second-team honors by the Walter Camp Foundation. Overall, he was the first Duke linkebacker with multiple first-team All-ACC accolades since 1985-86.

VAN RAAPHORST'S ATHLETIC LINEAGE

Cemented as one of the top coaches in college lacrosse, John Danowski has led the Duke men's lacrosse team to unprecedented success and himself to the top of the Division I men's lacrosse wins list. Danowski was introduced as Duke's eighth head men's lacrosse coach on July 21, 2006, and quickly led the Blue Devils to some of the most successful lacrosse seasons in school history, to three NCAA Championships in five seasons.

In Danowski's 11 years at the helm of the Blue Devils lacrosse program, he has compiled an impressive 181-56 record in leading Duke to seven ACC regular season titles and four ACC tournament titles, eight straight appearances in the national semifinals from 2007-14, four in the NCAA title match and ultimately to the 2010, 2013 and 2014 national titles. The 2014 NCAA crown put Danowski, a winner of 400 career games, among a small group of nine coaches to win three national titles and among eight to capture consecutive crowns. Meanwhile, Duke's run of eight straight NCAA semifinals rank as the second most of any program since 2000 with Syracuse. Most recently, Danowski passed Dom Starsia as the winningest Division I lacrosse history, garnering his 376th win with a 13-6 victory over Jacksonville, March 13, 2017.

A winner of nearly 80 percent of his games at Duke, the individual awards Blue Devil players have garnered is equally impressive. In 12 seasons, Danowski mentored 69 All-America selections, 41 All-ACC choices, two Tewaaraton Trophy winners, a pair of USILA Attackman of the Year honorees, a USILA Defenseman of the Year, three USILA Midfielder of the Year award recipients and 22 USILA Scholar All-America picks.

While the success on the field is unsurpassed in Duke lacrosse history, the student-athletes excellence in the classroom also is unrivaled. The Blue Devils consistently lead the ACC in All-ACC Academic picks as well as players on the ACC Academic Honor Roll. In 2018, Duke had 37 players - nearly 79 percent of the team - achieve a 3.0 grade point average for the entire academic year, with Justin Guterding earning USILA Scholar All-America honors.

Head coach John Danowski is one of four active coaches to own multiple NCAA titles. He is third among the group with three, while Bill Tierney of Denver leads the way with eight.
