Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

February 9, 2019 - at Virginia

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,048-281 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,121-340 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 172nd in the series versus Virginia, and the series now stands at 121-51 in favor of the Blue Devils. In Charlottesville, the series is now 42-34 in favor of Duke, including 6-3 in Duke's favor at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Duke has won five of the last six in the series, including three straight in Charlottesville.
- The Blue Devils improved to 9-1 in ACC play, their best start to an ACC season since beginning the 2010-11 season 12-1 in conference play.
- Duke is now an NCAA-leading 6-1 this season in games versus AP top 15-ranked opponents, including 5-1 in games away from Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- Coach K has now won 16 road games versus AP top five-ranked teams, the most in the history of the poll.
- Duke is now 128-22 all-time when playing as the No. 2-ranked team in the AP poll.
- Duke is now 966-218 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 563-102 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- The 81 points were the most allowed by Virginia since January 4, 2017, an 88-76 loss in overtime at Pittsburgh.
- Duke was 13-of-21 (.619) from three-point range, its best three-point percentage in a game this season and best since hitting .625 (10-of-16) versus North Carolina on February 18, 2015 at Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- Duke's .619 percentage from three-point range was its best three-point shooting performance in a road game since February 21, 2013 at Virginia Tech (12-of-17, .706).
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,044. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Duke out-scored Virginia in fast-break points, 17-0. Duke has allowed two total fast-break points over the last two games.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **RJ Barrett** hit five three-pointers (5-of-7) in the first half, to set a career-high for a game. He finished 6-of-10 from three-point range and led all scorers with 26 points on 8-of-15 shooting.
- Freshman **Zion Williamson** entered the game needing 16 points to reach 500 points for the season. He finished with 18, becoming the second-fastest freshman in Duke history to score 500 points in a season (23 games). The record is held by Barrett, who did it in 22 games.
- It is the first time in school history a pair of teammates has scored 500+ points in less than 24 games.
- Freshman **Cam Reddish** was 5-of-8 from three-point range and scored 17 points. He is averaging 4.3 made threes over the last three games -- was averaging 2.4 over the first 19 games this season.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** was Duke's fourth player in double-figures with 13 points, six rebounds, seven assists and two steals.
