Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

March 2, 2019 - vs. Miami

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,052-283 in his 39th season. His overall record is 1,125-342 in this, his 44th season.
- The game was the 27th in the series versus Miami, and the series now stands at 20-7 in favor of Duke. At Cameron Indoor Stadium, the series is now 10-2 in favor of Duke.
- Duke (25-4) has now reached the 25-win mark in each of the last 12 seasons, joining Gonzaga as the only teams to do so in each of the last 12 seasons.
- Duke is now 970-220 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 567-104 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,050. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.
- Duke improved to 891-161 all-time at Cameron Indoor Stadium, including 533-66 under Coach K. Duke is 14-2 at home this season.
- The game was Duke's 454th consecutive sellout at Cameron Indoor Stadium, extending the longest streak in men's college basketball.

PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **RJ Barrett** recorded his seventh double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds. He also had seven assists in 34 minutes.
- Barrett is the only player in the ACC to have scored in double-figures every game this season.
- Now with 670 points this season, Barrett has tied **Jabari Parker** (2014) for second on Duke's freshman season scoring list. He is 24 points off of tying **Marvin Bagley III**'s Duke freshman record (694).
- Junior **Marques Bolden** recorded his second double-double this season (third of his career) with 15 points and 10 rebounds in 23 minutes. Bolden was 6-of-9 from the field and is 14-of-19 (.737) from the field over the last five games.
- Bolden has scored 29 points over the last two games.
- Freshman **Tre Jones** matched his career high with six steals. He also had six versus Texas Tech on Dec. 20, 2018. Jones also had six points and five assists in 35 minutes.
- Freshman **Alex O'Connell** made his third straight start and scored 11 points. He is averaging 12.3 points over the last three games, and shooting 8-of-13 (.615) from three-point range in that time.
- Freshman **Zion Williamson** missed his third straight game (knee).
