LEADING OFF

After suffering a pair of midweek losses, No. 22 Duke looks to bounce back as the team heads to Charlottesville, Va., for its first true road contest of the season. The Blue Devils will face off with the Cavaliers to open ACC play for a three-game weekend series. The two ACC foes are set for a 4 p.m. first pitch on Friday afternoon for the series opener, while Saturday's and Sunday's games are both slated for a 1 p.m. start.

BY THE NUMBERS

2 Junior left-handed pitcher **Bill Chillari** currently ranks second in the ACC in WHIP, with a mark of 0.69. The southpaw has only allowed six hits and three walks across his 13.0 innings pitched, while recording 17 strikeouts in his efforts.

7 Entering the weekend series with Cavaliers, senior co-captain **Kennie Taylor** currently ranks seventh in the nation in hits with 23 -- a total that places him atop the conference in the category. Taylor has recorded eight multi-hit games this season, including three-hit efforts in his last two contests.

11 The Blue Devils have homered in eight of their last 10 contests, dating back to a Tuesday midweek matchup with Davidson. Since then, the Blue Devils have registered 11 long balls across the span, highlighted by sophomore **Michael Rothenberg** and senior **Kennie Taylor** who lead the team with three apiece.

12 Newcomers have seen their first career action as a Blue Devil across the early parts of the 2019 campaign. The combination of freshmen **Aaron Beasley, Jack Carey, Damon Lux, Rudy Maxwell, Ethan Murray, Kyle Salley, Matt Stinebiser** and **Cooper Stinson**, sophomore **Wil Hoyle**, juco transfer **Eli Herrick**, and graduate transfers **Kyle Gallagher**

and **Ben Gross** each saw their first action as Blue Devil during the first three-plus weeks.

13 Transitioning into an every-day role this season, junior infielder **Erikson Nichols** has reached base safely across every contest this season. The third baseman is tied for second on the team with hits (15), while batting at a .300 clip across the 13 games this season for the Blue Devils.

18 The Blue Devils recorded an impressive 18 wins in conference action a season ago, as part of their 45-18 overall record in the historic 2018 campaign. Duke was picked to finish second in the ACC in the league's preseason poll this year.

20 Senior **Kennie Taylor** owns a 20-game reached base streak, which dates back to last season. After reaching base safely in the last seven contests of the 2018 campaign, the Tampa, Fla., native has reached base safely in every contest this season, and also owns an eight-game hitting streak.

172 The Blue Devil pitching staff has totaled a nation-leading 172 strikeouts across 13 games, averaging 13.2 strikeouts per nine innings -- a mark that also ranks atop the country. Nine Duke pitchers have registered double-digit strikeout totals so far this season.

SERIES HISTORY

Duke and Virginia will meet for the 170th time in program history this weekend as the two teams open up conference play in Charlottesville. The Cavaliers hold the series advantage over the Blue Devils with a 106-62-1 mark, including a 51-17 mark over Duke in Charlottesville. Most recently, the Blue Devils welcomed Virginia to Durham a season ago, defeating the Cavaliers in a three-game series, winning the bookend games of the weekend. In a deciding game three, the Blue Devils walked it off on an 11th-inning hit from **Steve Mann** to secure the 3-2 series-clinching victory. Head coach **Chris Pollard** holds a 7-12 mark against Virginia, including a 6-12 mark at Duke.

BLUE DEVILS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN ACC COASTAL DIVISION

Duke was picked to finish second in the 2019 ACC Coastal Division in a poll of the conference's 14 head coaches. Thirteen coaches picked North Carolina to win the Coastal Division, while Virginia received the other first-place vote. The Tar Heels tallied 97 points, ahead of both Virginia and Duke, who tied for second with 64 points apiece. Miami placed fourth with 61 points, while Georgia Tech (59), Pitt (24) and Virginia Tech (23) rounded out the teams in the division. The Blue Devils finished second in the ACC Coastal a season ago, posting an 18-11 record in conference play.

HOT START FOR THE DEVILS

The Blue Devils are off to a hot start in the 2019 campaign, holding a 9-4 record across their first 13 games. This season has included a weekend sweep over Lehigh, a pair of series wins over Big Ten opponents in Northwestern and Penn State, and a pair of midweek victories over Davidson and Richmond. This past weekend, Duke traveled to Bradenton, Fla., for its first road trip of the season, facing off against Penn State in a neutral-site matchup. The Blue Devils won the bookend games of the series, which included a combined no-hitter from the Duke pitching staff in Friday's opener. After dropping game two of the series in a tight one-run contest, the Blue Devils battled back from behind to score nine unanswered runs in Sunday's series finale to take down the Nittany Lions, 9-2, and clinch their third consecutive weekend series win in the final weekend tuneup before conference action.

NO-HIT WONDER

In Friday's series opener against Penn State, the Duke pitching staff tossed a combined no-hitter, leading the Blue Devils to a 14-0 victory over the Nittany Lions. The no-hitter served as only the sixth in school history, and the first since **Tom Blackburn** accomplished the feat against Rollins in 1955. The Duke pitching staff tallied 11 strikeouts across the nine hitless innings, while only surrendering two walks. Headlining the effort was starting pitcher **Graeme Stinson** (2-0), who worked the first 5.0 innings, collecting five punchouts, and allowing two walks to earn his second win of the season. Sophomore **Matt Dockman** followed in relief, tossing 1.0 inning and recording one strikeout, while freshman **Jack Carey** went on to work the final 3.0 frames, notching five strikeouts to earn his first career save.

CAPTAIN KENNIE

Senior co-captain **Kennie Taylor** has proved to be a leader across the 2019 campaign, both on and off the field for this year's team. Taylor, the squad's starting center fielder, leads the club in multiple statistical categories, including hits (23), doubles (7), RBI (18), runs (14) and stolen bases (6), while tying for the team-lead in home runs with three. His 23 hits currently rank him seventh in the nation and place him atop the ACC heading into the weekend, while being tied for first in doubles. The Tampa, Fla., native has reached base safely in every contest this season, and owns a reached-base streak of 20 games, dating back to last season. This past weekend, Taylor came up clutch in the series finale against Penn State, recording his first career grand slam, as part of a six-RBI, multi-home run performance. His grand slam scored Duke's first runs of Sunday's contest, pushing the Blue Devils ahead 4-2, while his second home run of the day padded the lead in a 9-2 series-clinching victory for Duke.

BLUE DEVIL BOMBERS

The Duke offense has come alive as of late, as the Blue Devils have registered at least one home run in eight of the past 10 games, totaling 11 long balls across the span. Leading the way for the Blue Devils are sophomore **Michael Rothenberg** and senior **Kennie Taylor**, who have each recorded three apiece. Graduate transfer **Kyle Gallager** has added a pair of home runs to his totals, while the trio of freshmen **Rudy Maxwell** and **Ethan Murray** and junior **Matt Mervis** have each recorded one, marking the first of their respective careers. The offensive explosion has led the Blue Devils to a season total of 90 RBI, which rank third in the ACC, and 99 runs scored, which rank fourth in the conference.

DETAILS
On October 2, 2015, Duke renewed its agreement with the Durham Bulls to play home games at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park (DBAP), home of the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. Beginning in 2016, the contract renewal is a seven-year agreement that allows Duke to play up to 36 exhibition and home games at the DBAP each year. The agreement also called for a limited number of Duke practices at the DBAP as well as a new permanent Duke locker room and clubhouse at the facility. Duke and the Durham Bulls began their partnership prior to the Blue Devils' 2010 season. The 2019 campaign marks the 10th consecutive season in which Duke will play home games at the DBAP. Under the new agreement, the Blue Devils will play the vast majority of their home schedule at the minor league venue.

WELCOME TO K-VILLE

The Blue Devil pitching staff has been impressive thus far, recording 172 strikeouts -- the nation's highest mark and seven more than any other school through 13 contests. The Blue Devils also lead the nation in strikeouts per nine innings with 13.0, and rank sixth in the ACC in strikeout-to-walk ratio with a mark of 3.25 (172 K-53 BB). Nine Duke pitchers have recorded double-digit strikeout totals so far this season, with sophomore **Bryce Jarvis**, freshman **Cooper Stinson** and senior **Hunter Davis** leading the way for the staff with 20 punchouts apiece.

DUKE IN THE NATIONAL POLLS

The Blue Devils entered the 2019 campaign ranked within the top 25 in three of the six national collegiate baseball polls. Duke landed at No. 20 in the *Collegiate Baseball* preseason poll, No. 22 in *Baseball America's* rankings and No. 25 on the *National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association* (NCBWA) preseason poll. The Blue Devils were also listed at No. 31 in *Perfect Game's* ranking, while receiving votes in the *USA Today* Coaches Poll to begin the season. After three weekends of action, Duke now sits at No. 22 in both the *Collegiate Baseball* poll and the *Baseball America* poll.

THE STINSON SPOTLIGHT

Junior left-hander **Graeme Stinson** entered the 2019 campaign as one of the top prospects for the 2019 MLB Draft. The southpaw received five preseason All-America nods, including a *Baseball America* first-team honor where he was one of only three unanimous first-team selections. The Norcross, Ga., native also earned a spot on the *DIBaseball* first team, the *Collegiate Baseball* second team, the *Perfect Game/Rawlings* third team and the *NCBWA* third team. Graeme has assumed his role of the Blue Devils' Friday night starter, while his younger brother, **Cooper Stinson**, serves in the weekend rotation as the Sunday starter. The Stinsons rank first and fifth on the team and strikeouts, as Cooper is tied for the team lead with 20 punchouts, while Graeme is right behind with 18 of his own. Graeme has surrendered only two hits across his 12.0 scoreless innings of work. *DIBaseball* lists the younger Stinson at No. 4 among the publication's list of impact freshmen in the ACC.

FRESH FACES ON THE DIAMOND

After losing 16 lettermen from last year's roster, including seven of nine positional starters, 12 newcomers have seen their first career action as a Blue Devil across the first seven contests this season. The combination of freshmen **Jack Carey**, **Damon Lux**, **Rudy Maxwell**, **Ethan Murray**, **Matt Stinebiser** and **Cooper Stinson**, sophomore **Wil Hoyle**, juco transfer **Eli Herrick**, and graduate transfers **Kyle Gallagher** and **Ben Gross** each saw their first action as Blue Devil opening weekend against Lehigh, while freshmen **Aaron Beasley** and **Kyle Salley** made their first career appearances in the Northwestern series. Murray and Gallagher have each started all 13 games this season, while Maxwell has started 12.

ON DECK FOR DUKE

Following this weekend in Charlottesville, the Blue Devils will return home to Durham an eight-game homestand. Next week, Duke welcomes a pair of ranked opponents to Durham Bulls Athletic Park in No. 13 Louisville and No. 14 East Carolina. The Blue Devils and the Pirates will face off in a midweek matchup Tuesday afternoon at the DBAP, before Duke and Louisville square off in a three-game weekend series next weekend in the second week of conference action.

Chris Pollard became Duke University's 25th head baseball coach in June 2012, taking the reigns of the Blue Devil program after successful stints at Pfeiffer University and Appalachian State University. In addition to guiding the Blue Devils to five straight 30-win seasons, Pollard led Duke to an at-large bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament, ending the program's 55-year drought without making the postseason event. Pollard became the fastest Duke head coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils, recording his 100th victory at Duke March 15, 2016, against Maryland Eastern Shore. During Pollard's tenure, 19 Blue Devils have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.

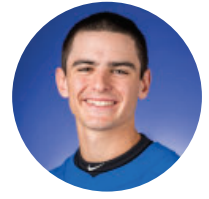

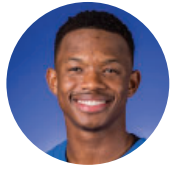
