RECAPPING 2018 ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

► Four Blue Devils clinched automatic bids and Jacob Kasper won the heavyweight title to highlight Duke's 2018 ACC Championship. The Blue Devils finished fourth of six teams with 47.5 points. It was the best finish for Duke since it took fourth in 2015.

► Joining Kasper on the All-ACC team with runner-up honors were Mitch Finesilver (157) and Zach Finesilver (165). The second-place showing was the third for Mitch, while Zach's run to the title match was arguably the best story of the day.

► Seeded sixth at 165 pounds, Zach Finesilver upset the No. 3 seed to advance to the semifinals. The dream day continued for him in the next bout, where he bested the second seed to secure one of the two automatic bids to the NCAA Championships and an appearance in the ACC title match.

► Mitch Finesilver, seeded second, cruised to the finals with a 6-0 semifinal win before dropping a hard-fought 3-2 decision to NC State's Hayden Hidlay.

DUKE IN THE ACC

► A member of the ACC in wrestling since 1956, Duke's highest finish in the ACC Tournament was third place five times, most recently in 2004.

► Twenty-three different Duke wrestlers have won 32 ACC titles overall with Jacob Kasper being the most recent in 2018.

► Joel Puleo is the Blue Devils' lone competitor to win three consecutive championships, bringing home top honors at heavyweight in 1973, 1974 and 1975.

► Five other wrestlers captured consecutive championships during their careers. In the current weight classifications, Duke has 10 ACC titles at heavyweight, two at 184 pounds and 197 and one in the 174, 133 and 125-pound classifications.

► Duke has had 36 All-ACC selections, including three last season, since teams were compiled in 1986.

LOOKING AT FIRST ROUND MATCHUPS

► The first round will feature a host of interesting matchups as multiple of the regular season duals were very close on the mat. Alec Schenk will look to match his winning performance at Pittsburgh against No. 4 seed Kellan Stout, while Josh Finesilver aims to do the same against Panther LJ Bentley.

► At 174 pounds, Matt Finesilver likely will go up against No. 3 seed Daniel Bullard who he edged 8-7 during the regular season. Mitch Finesilver, after his first-round bye, is poised to take on Ryan Blees after winning both regular season meetings.

MITCH FINESILVER LOOKING TO BREAK THROUGH

► A three-time ACC runner-up at 133, 149 and 157 pounds, Mitch Finesilver is looking to climb to the top of the podium this year to become Duke's 24th different ACC Champion and first at 149 pounds.

► Mitch is on track to become Duke's first four-time All-ACC honoree after garnering All-ACC recognition each of the past three seasons. He and current assistant coach Jacob Kasper are the lone three-time All-ACC honorees.

ARIEN LEIGH DEBUTS

► Rookie Arien Leigh made his Duke debut against Appalachian State and will line up at 133 pounds in the ACC Championships. The freshman 125-pounder turned in an exciting performance in his first match, scoring immediately before eventually dropping the hard-fought bout.

TOP DUAL SCORERS

► In Duke's 11 duals, Mitch Finesilver (149) led the way with 46 points, while Matt Finesilver (174) had 37. Mitch finished the dual season unbeaten, while Matt lost just once.

HITTING THE BOOKS AND THE MAT HARD

► Four Blue Devils earned spots on the Dean's List this past semester and two did so with Distinction. Mitch Finesilver and Anthony DeMartino both earned a 4.0 GPA, while Araad Fisher and Mason Eaglin posted a 3.85 and a 3.95 GPA, respectively.

► Most recently, Mitch Finesilver was the recipient of an ACC Postgraduate Scholarship for excellence in the classroom and on the mat. He will receive \$6,000 towards his graduate education.

LOOKING AT DUKE

► Duke has a host of wrestlers with their sights set on the NCAA Championships. The Blue Devils sent a program-record five last season and hope to eclipse that mark this year. With 37 bids up for grabs the Blue Devils are in the hunt for a historic finish to the season.

► Fourth-ranked Mitch Finesilver paces the Blue Devils with a 26-3 overall record and is on a nine-match win streak. Matt Finesilver is ranked 17th week and sports a 23-6 mark. He is 9-1 in his previous 10 matches with the lone loss being a 6-2 decision against top-seeded David McFadden of Virginia Tech. Zach Finesilver, after missing the early portion of the campaign to an off-season injury, is 16-7 on the year and arguably wrestling his best right now. Josh Finesilver (141) is 19-10 overall has won his past four matches, including a thriller over UNC's A.C. Headlee in the final bout of the regular season.

► At 184 pounds, Kaden Russell has taken big strides and is 17-12 on the year. He posted a huge result against Virginia's Will Schany and was 33rd in the coaches' rankings and 30th in the RPI earlier in the year. His 17 wins are 10 more than he had all of last season.

MATT FINESILVER WINNING WAYS

► Sophomore Matt Finesilver is 10-1 in his past 11 bouts. Included in that list are victories over Nos. 17, 19 and 20. His lone loss was to No. 7 David McFadden. Four of the 10 triumphs were by major decision as he allowed just 23 points.

O'CONNOR VS. FINESILVER IV

► A fourth matchup between Duke's Mitch Finesilver and UNC's Austin O'Connor could be on tap for the ACC's crown at 149 pounds. The pair has met three times prior this season with Mitch Finesilver winning two of them, including the regular season dual in Cameron. O'Connor earned his one victory in the consolation bracket at the Cliff Keen Invite.

DUKE'S TREND UNDER LANHAM

► The Blue Devils have steadily improved in the six-plus years under head coach Glen Lanham. Duke has sent multiple qualifiers to the NCAA Championships for six straight seasons and had a program-record five in 2018. Prior to the 2016 season, Duke had never sent more than two wrestlers to NCAA Championships in consecutive seasons.

► This year was the first time in program history Duke wrestling opened a campaign ranked in the top 25 by the National Wrestling Coaches Association. The Blue Devils were voted 24th in the poll.

► Duke finished 22nd last season at the NCAA Championships, the highest finish in program history. The Blue Devils have finished in the top 32 in the NCAA each of the past five seasons. Prior to the team's 29th-place finish in 2014, Duke had never finished higher than 35th and had never put together three consecutive top 35 finishes.

► Most recently Duke garnered its second consecutive top 10 finish at the Southern Scuffle with a seventh-place showing. The Blue Devils, after taking fifth last year, had never finished in the top 10 prior to Lanham.

RUSSELL'S SOPHOMORE SPIKE

► Sophomore 184-pounder Kaden Russell's hard work over the summer and in the preseason is paying off. The sophomore 184-pounder has 17 wins on the year after posting just seven last season. He recently garnered a ranked victory at Virginia as he makes the push to become a first-time NCAA qualifier.

► The Medina, Ohio native took third at the Keystone Classic and turned in a solid showing at the Cliff Keen Invitational. He also came up only one win shy of placing at the Southern Scuffle.

JOSH FINESILVER FALLS

► Sophomore Josh Finesilver has taken his offense to a new level this season, recording six pins in his 29 matches. He only had one last season and five of the six this season have come in the first two periods.

OH CAPTAINS MY CAPTAINS

► Seniors Mitch Finesilver, Zach Finesilver and Alec Schenk will lead the Blue Devils this season as captains. The trio are undisputed leaders both on and off the mat and their work ethic is second to none. Both Finesilvers are multiple-time NCAA qualifiers, while Schenk aims to garner a bid in his final season.

FINESILVER FOUR

► Duke features an NCAA first with four brothers in the starting lineup. The quartet of Finesilver brothers, all of whom qualified for the NCAA Championships in 2018, wrestle for the Blue Devils, ranging from 141 to 174 pounds. Last season marked the first time in NCAA history one school had four brothers advance to the NCAA Championships.

► Josh and Matt Finesilver are twin brothers and earned the starting nod as rookies at 141 and 174, respectively.

► The older set of twins, Mitch and Zach, are redshirt seniors and wrestle at the respective 149 and 165 weights. Mitch is a three-time NCAA qualifier, while Zach has advanced twice.

► All four were stellar high school wrestlers for Cherry Creek High School, combining for 14 State Championship tournament appearances and four state titles.
