## Men's Basketball Postgame Notes

*March 24, 2019 - vs. UCF (NCAA Tournament Second Round)*

- Head coach **Mike Krzyzewski**'s record at Duke is now 1,058-284 in his 39<sup>th</sup> season. His overall record is 1,131-343 in this, his 44<sup>th</sup> season.
- In the NCAA Tournament, Duke is now 113-37 all-time. Under Coach K, Duke's NCAA Tournament record is now 96-29.
- Duke's 113 wins are third-most in NCAA Tournament history, while its .753 winning percentage is the best.
- In East Region NCAA Tournament games, Duke is now 57-15.
- Duke advances to the Sweet 16 for the 27<sup>th</sup> time in the program's history - the second-most in NCAA history behind North Carolina's 29.
- This will be Duke's 25<sup>th</sup> Sweet 16 appearance under Coach K - the most by a coach in NCAA history.
- Since 1998, this will be Duke's 17<sup>th</sup> Sweet 16 appearance - the most nationally over that span.
- The game was just the 11<sup>th</sup> one-point margin in Duke's NCAA Tournament history and first since a 71-70 win over Belmont in the First Round in 2008. Duke is 7-4 in one-point games in the NCAA Tournament.
- Duke is 3-0 in one-point games this season and 37-22 under Coach K.
- As the No. 1-seed, Duke is now 53-9 overall. Duke is now 5-1 all-time versus the No. 9-seed, including 5-0 when playing as the No. 1-seed versus the No. 9-seed.
- The game was the first meeting all-time between Duke and UCF.
- Duke had four freshmen score double-digit points for the ninth time this season. It last occurred in the ACC Championship Game win over Florida State.
- Duke had three players - **Zion Williamson**, **RJ Barrett** and **Tre Jones** - each with four assists in the game.
- Duke is now 976-221 when playing as a ranked team under Coach K, including 573-105 when playing as a ranked AP top five team under Coach K.
- Duke was outscored 40-33 in the second half, just the ninth time this season the Blue Devils were outscored in the second half of a game.
- Under Coach K, Duke is now 213-31 all-time when playing as the AP No. 1-ranked team.
- Duke extended its streak of at least one made three-pointer in a game to 1,057. It is the nation's third-longest active streak.

### PLAYER NOTES

- Freshman **Zion Williamson** scored 32 points with 11 rebounds for his 13<sup>th</sup> double-double this season, and second in as many NCAA Tournament games.
- His 32 points are tied for the fourth-most by a Blue Devil in the NCAA Tournament, and the most since **Jason Williams** scored 34 versus UCLA in 2001. His performance also set the Duke freshman record for points in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Williamson had four assists, to mark the first 25-10-4 game for the Blue Devils in NCAA Tournament history.
- Williamson posted just the third 30-10 game in Duke's NCAA Tournament history and the first since **Danny Ferry** had 34 points and 10 boards versus Seton Hall in 1989. **Jeff Mullins** (43-12) had the other for Duke in 1964 versus Villanova.
- Williamson now has 16 25-point games this season, the second-most in a season under Coach K. The record is 22 held by **J.J. Redick** in 2005-06.
- Freshman **RJ Barrett** scored 16 points with eight rebounds and four assists, moving into fourth place on Duke's single-season scoring list with 821 points this season. He surpassed **Johnny Dawkins** (809 in 1986) in the game.
- Junior **Javin DeLaurier** matched his career high with three steals.
